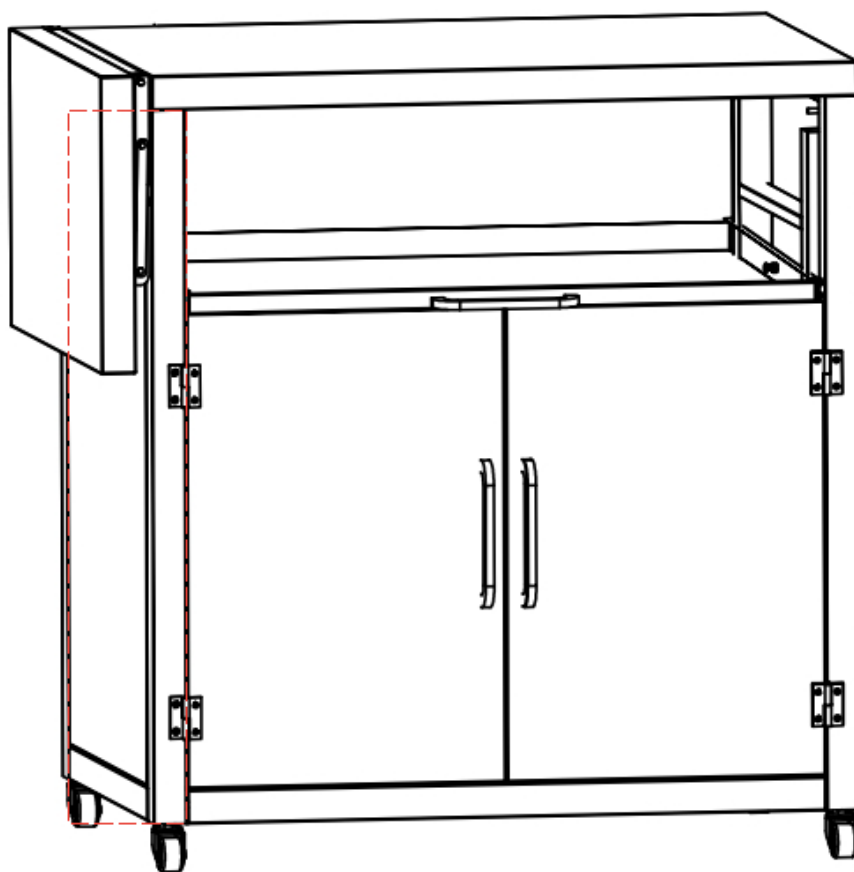

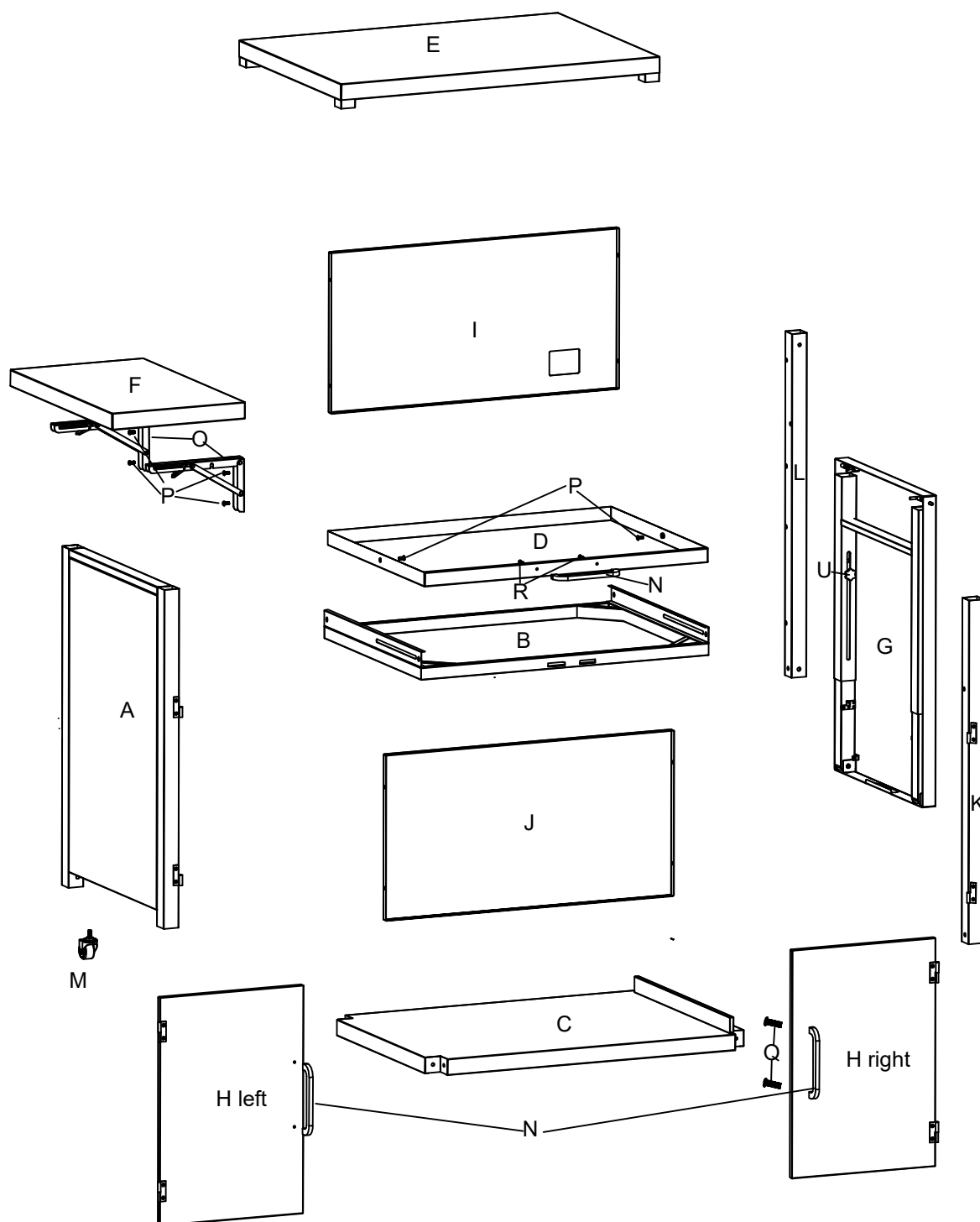

Care & Maintenance

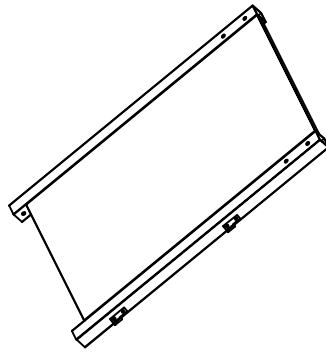
- ⊘  • Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- ⊘  • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- ⊘  • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
- ⊘  • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- ⊘  • Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
- ⊘  • Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- ✓  • Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

Please look in Mobile folding table for hardware packs and legs.
Sets often ship in multiple boxes and may arrive a day or two apart.

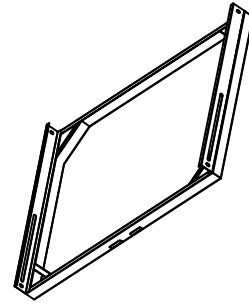

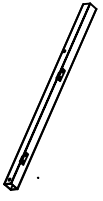
Step 1: Install the base plate

As shown in picture1: First, put (A) and (C) together, use screw (P) to pass through (C) and the holes in (A), connect (C) to (A), and then tighten the screws, Using the (S) allen wrench.

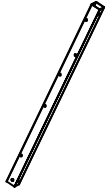
Note: All the corresponding hole positions and the screws must be concentric.

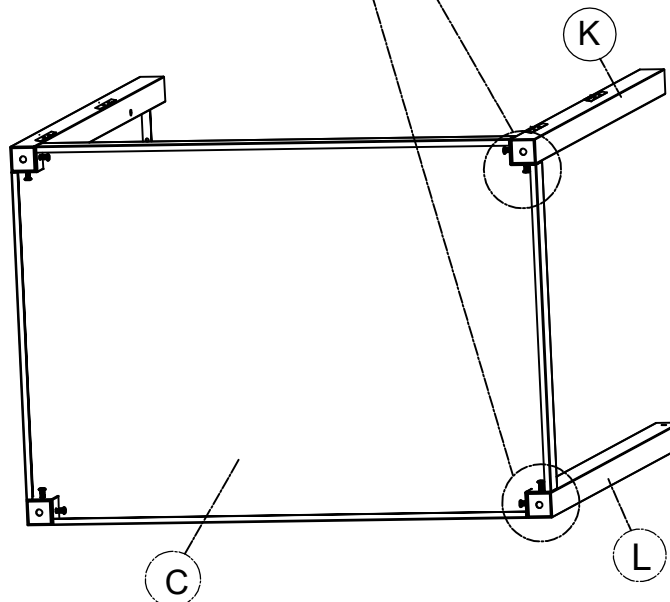
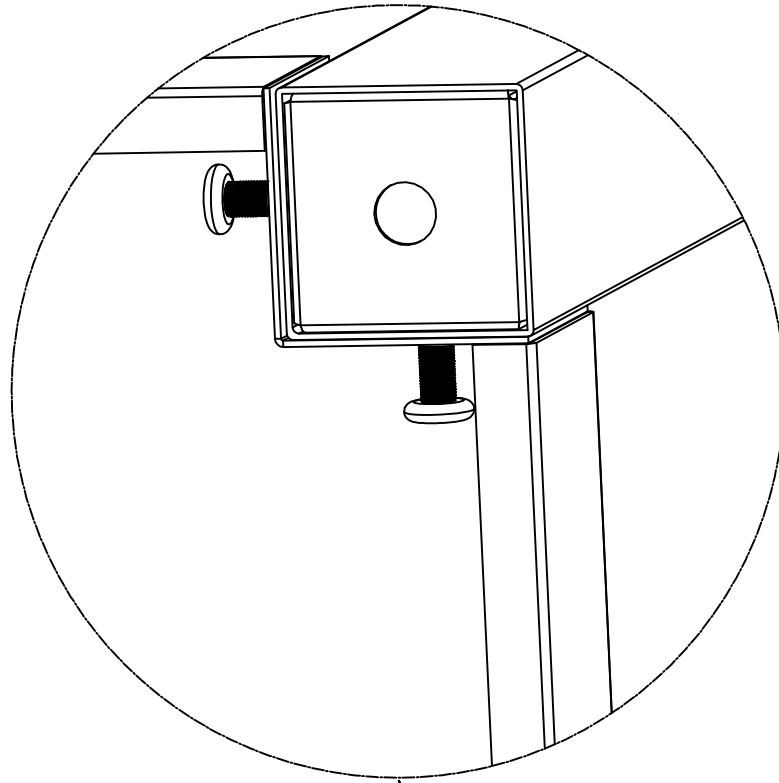

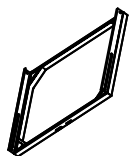

Step 2: Install the legs of the right side

As shown in picture2: First, put (K) and (C) together, use screw (P) to pass through (C) and the holes in (K), connect (K) to (C), and then tighten the screws, Using the allen wrench .Using the same method,you can connect (L) to (C).

Note: All the corresponding hole positions and the screws must be concentric.

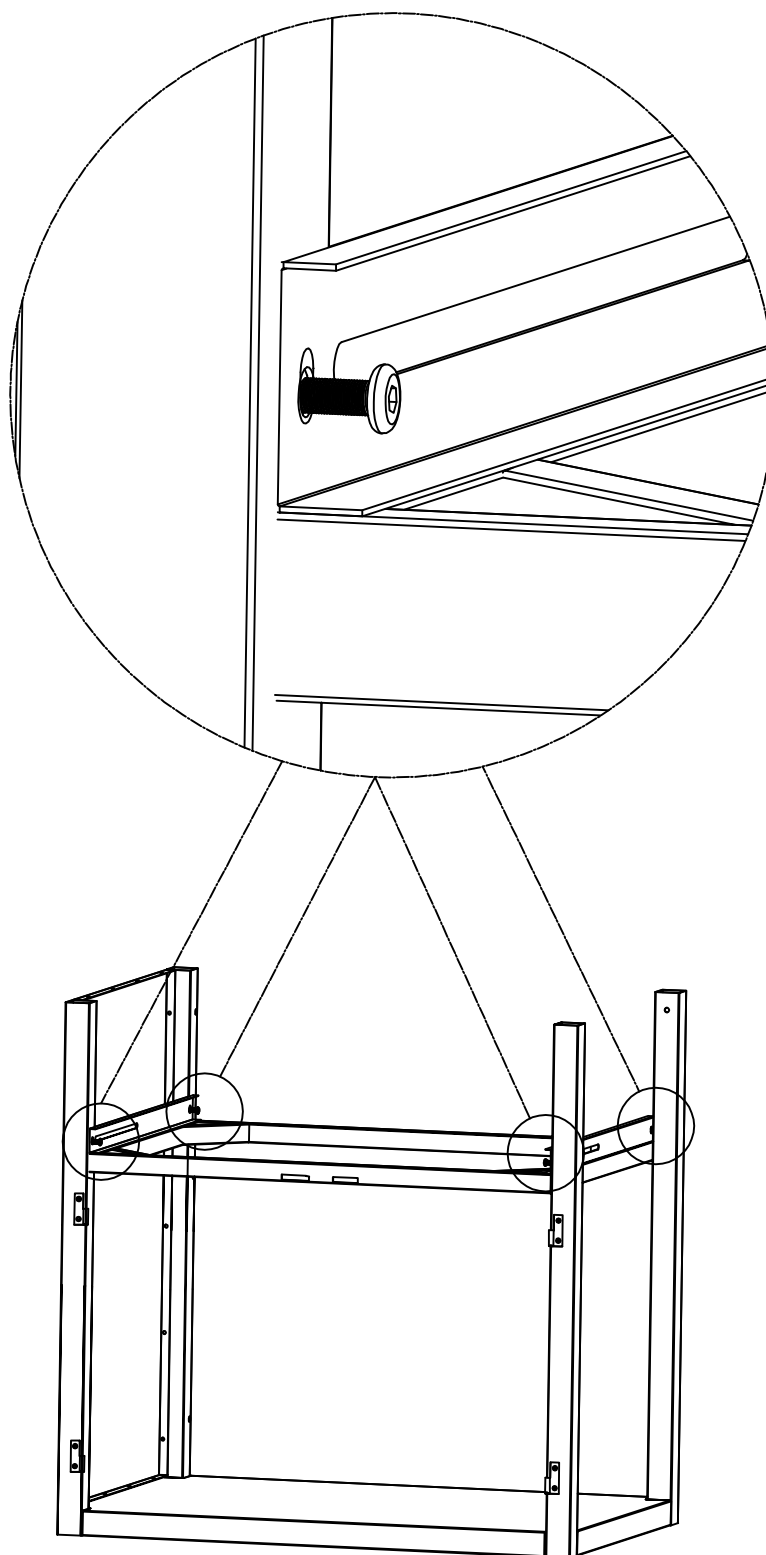

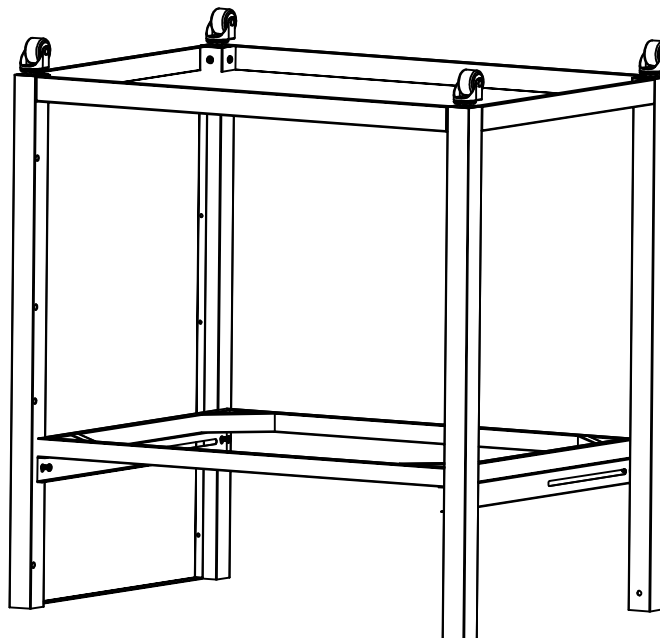
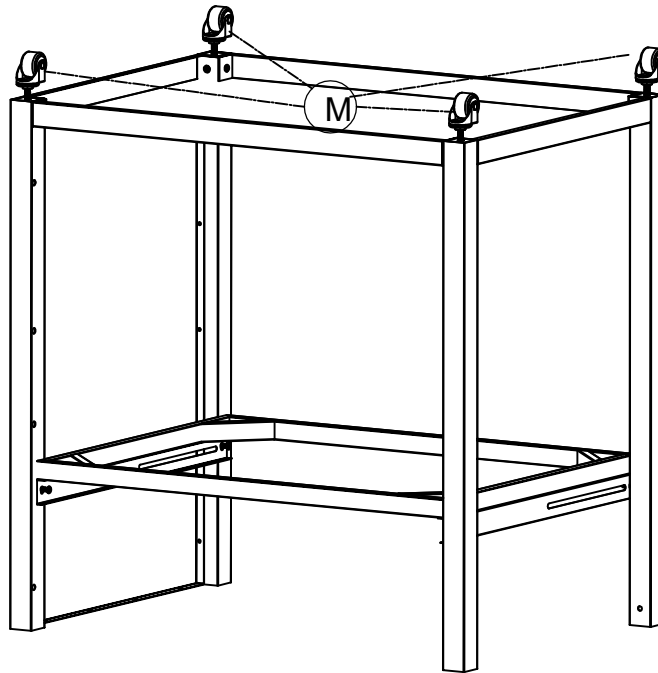
Step 3 : Install Ⓑ part

As shown in the picture 8 to picture 9: and then tighten all the screws .

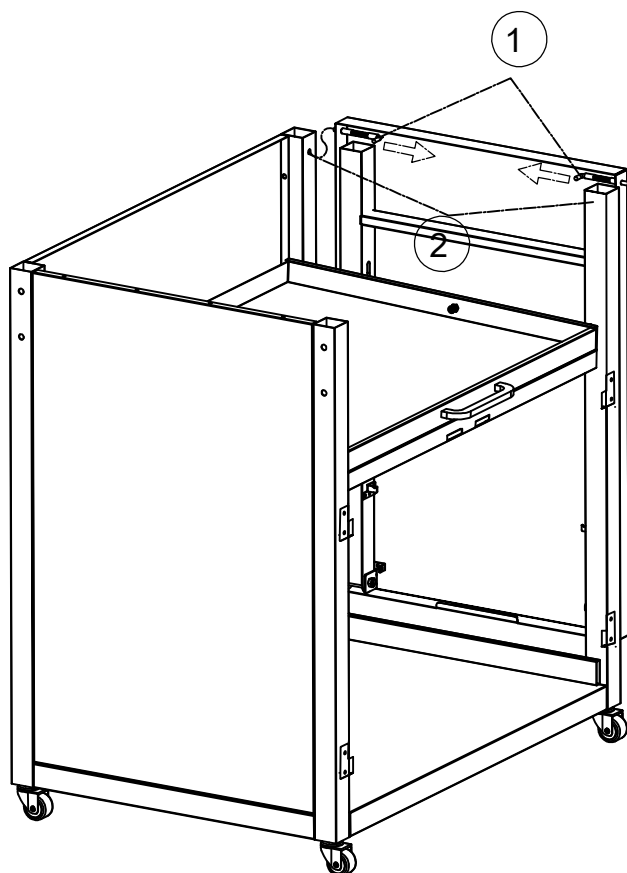

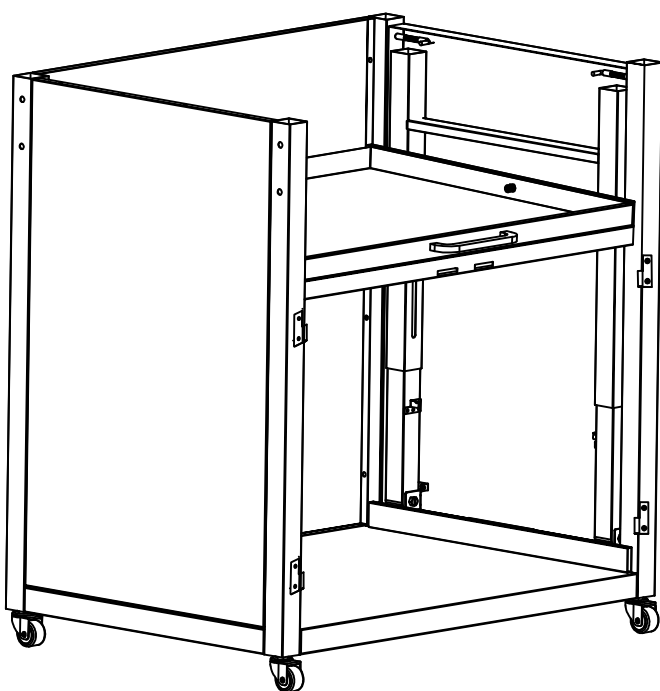

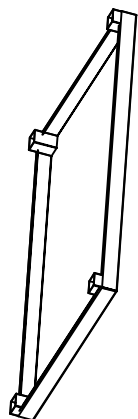


Step 8: Install the folding table on the right side

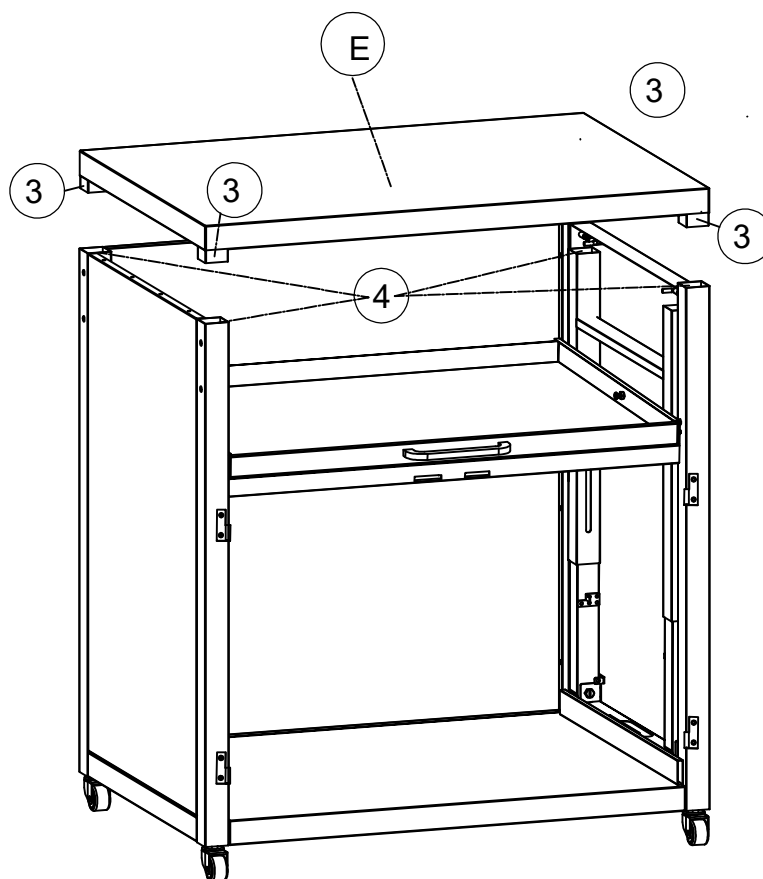

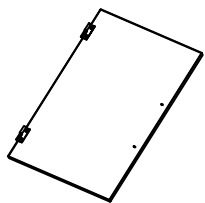
Step 11: Install the folding table on the left side

As shown in the picture 18 to picture 19: First, pull plugs ① inside, and make 1 and the holes ② on the legs are concentric, using your hands. Then release hands.

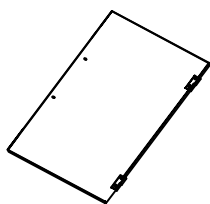

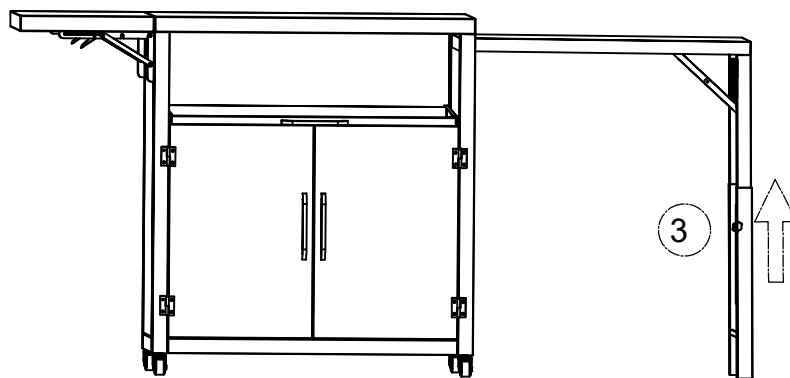
Step 14: How to use the mobile folding table

1.How to expand the mobile folding table:

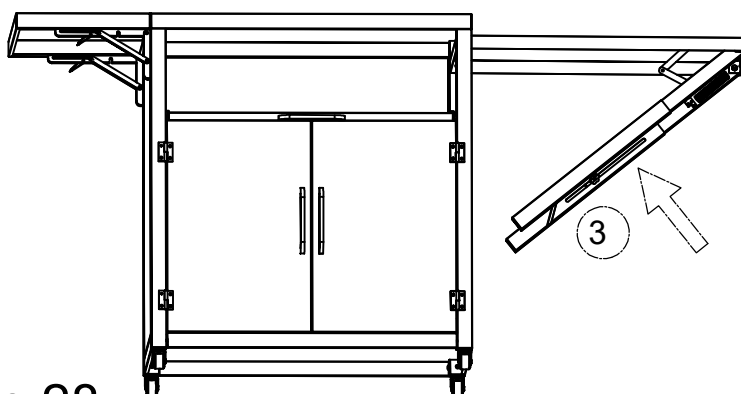
As shown in the picture24 to picture 26: First start the folding table on the left side, until the desktop is level.Then start the folding table on the right side,Release the screw 3 first turn the folding legs outside,and put them down,until the desktop is level.and then tighten the screws to prevent the desktop falling down.

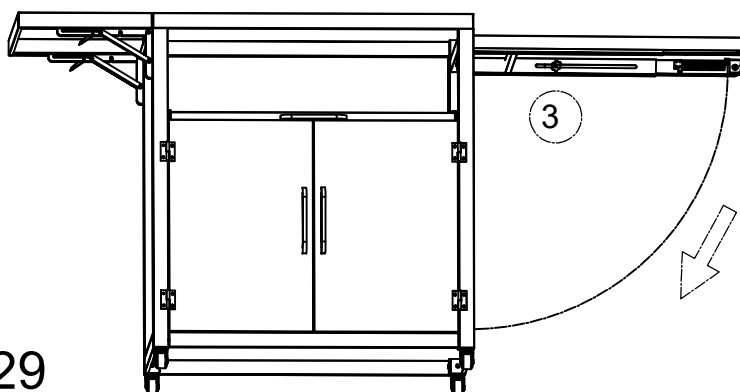

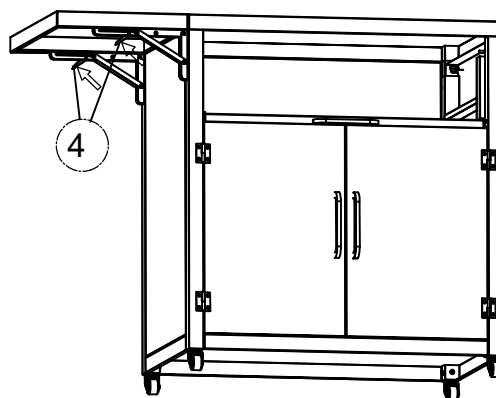
Step 14: How to use the mobile folding table

2.How to retract the mobile folding table:

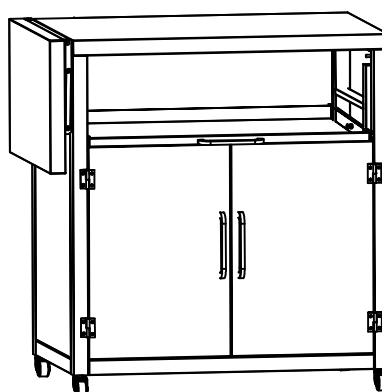

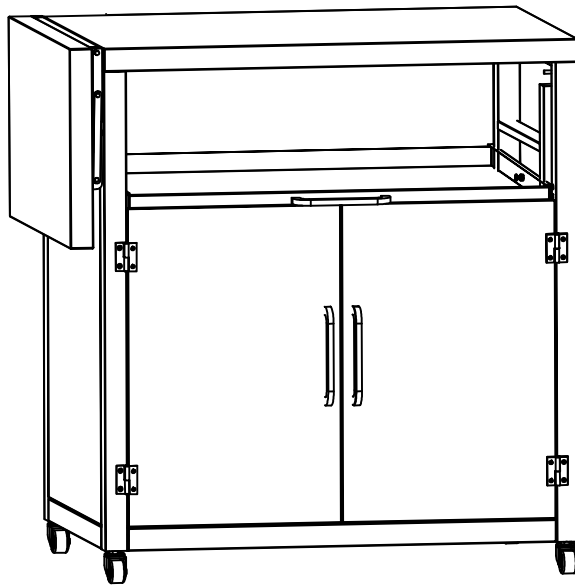
Step 15: How to use the mobile folding table

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
