# ELECTRICAL SAFETY

- For your safety, this product must be installed in accordance with local Building Regulations and conform to current IEE regulation.
- Before commencing any work ensure the supply is switched off at the mains. Either by switching off the main switch at the consumer unit or by removing the appropriate fuse.
- To prevent a fire hazard always use the cable of correct rating, size and type for application.
- This is a Class II product
- Do not modify or alter any product before or after installation. This will invalidate your warranty and may render the product un-safe.
- Before inserting and replacing bulb(s) make sure that the power is switched off and the bulb(s) have cooled down.

# POSITION:

- For indoor use only
- Ensure there is a sufficient power supply and access to the fitting to enable safe maintenance

# ASSEMBLY AND SET-UP:

- Unpack all components onto a flat surface that will not damage them or allow them to become dirty.
- Working from the bottom upwards, screw 4 wooden stems to the bottom section using 4 of the screws provided. (DIA.1)
- Repeat the steps to build the shelving unit. (DIA 2)
- Insert the four pegs in the lamp holder section. Secure the lamp holder section in place, aligning the section holes over the screws. (DIA.3)
- Build the remainder of the shelving unit, using the four short wooden stems, and then adding the top (open section) in place. (DIA.4)
- Carefully fit the decorative shade. Insert the bulb not supplied), do not exceed the wattage stated on the lamp holder, also suitable for use with energy saving bulbs and LED bulbs. (DIA.5)
- Insert plug into mains and switch on using floor switch to power on.

# AFTERCARE AND MAINTANENCE:

- Always disconnect power supply when servicing or cleaning.
- Clean only with a dry or slightly damp cloth.
- The external flexible cable/cord cannot be replaced; if damaged the luminaire should be destroyed.
