

Installation and use instructions

Assembly Instruction: Please take note and keep it for later use!

Congratulations on the purchase of your quality pavilion. To help you enjoy this product for a long time, please read the following information carefully.

1. The pavilion should be anchored with the nails included in the delivery.. When used on solid surface, we recommend to fix the pavilion at the floor area and on all supports with screws (screws not included). If the pavilion is exposed to increased wind, an additional action in form of stronger pegs or additional attachment in the ground may be necessary (Mounting hardware not included). Damage caused by inadequate anchoring of the pavilion is NOT a liability.
2. Please do not leave the pavilion unattended for a long time. In rising wind, the roof cover and side panels may have to be removed so that the wind has no attack surface and it can not damage the pavilion. Watersacks or snow loads must also be removed from the roof immediately to prevent damage to the linkage or covers. We recommend dismantling the pavilion in winter. NO warranty exists for all weather-related damage, such as wind and stormy winds, storms, heavy rain, snow loads or ice formation. The pavilion is NOT stormproof and NOT winterproof. Likewise, no liability can be accepted for damage caused by other external influences on covers and poles (tearing, pulling, etc.).
3. Cleaning and care of the covers: Do not wash with alkaline or acidic cleaner! Please only use neutral detergent and a cloth or a soft brush. In no case may a high-pressure cleaner be used. The PVC coating on the underside must not be damaged during cleaning
4. The frame is made of sheet steel. In places where the coating is damaged (e.g., screw or plug locations) and where the coating is particularly thin (welds, corners and edges), surface rust may form over time. These areas should be immediately repaired with a suitable metal paint or some dabbing paint to prevent the surface rust from spreading. In general, rust on pavilions made of sheet steel is unavoidable and does not constitute a reason for complaint.
5. Never use open fire near or in the pavilion.
6. The roof cover is a wear part. Especially darker covers become brighter over time due to UV exposure. Normal wear is not subject to the warranty.

If you follow all the instructions above, you will enjoy your pavilion!
