










## (1/2) Left Side Corner Sofa



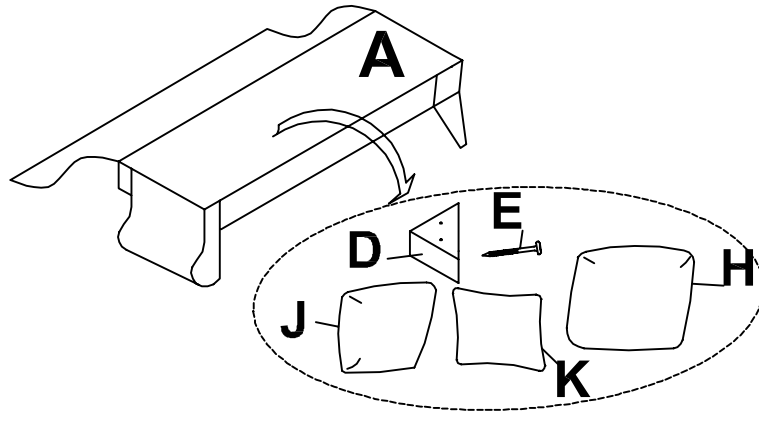
Legs & hardware are stored at the bottom of sofa, please take out the legs and hardware for assembly.

Note: Do not use power tools for assembly. Power tools increase the risk of over tightening which lead to splitting or cracking the wood.

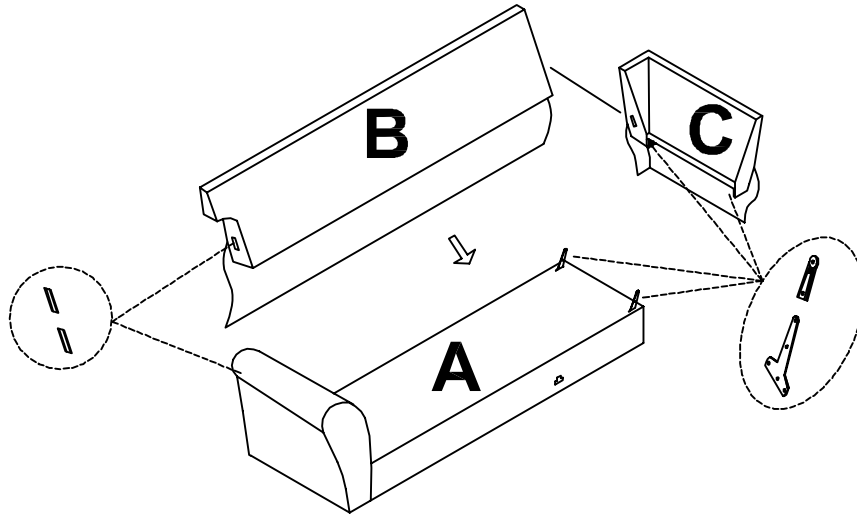











## (2/2) Right Side Sofa with Reversible Chaise



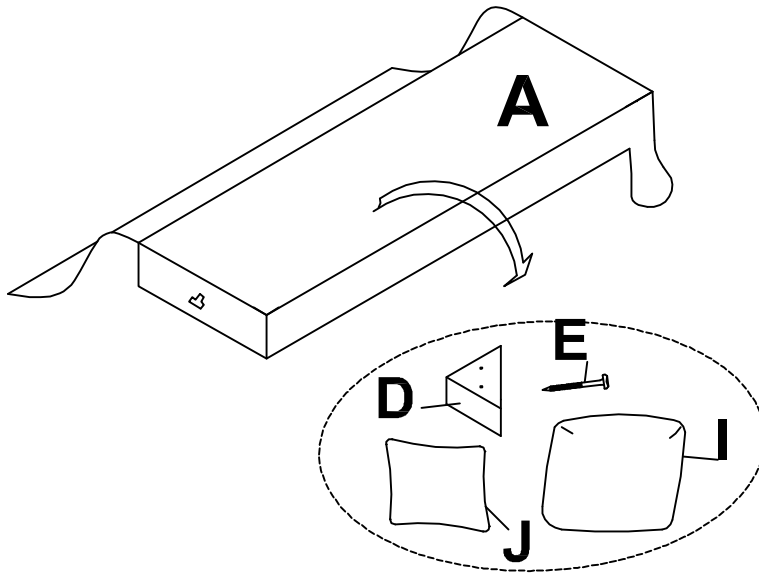
