How to install plastic lawn edging

1. Clean the surrounding of the garden bed where you plan to install the edging. Remove any large rocks, stones, dirt or anything else that may be in the way where you plan to install. You may need to remove the old edging if installed before.
2. Try inserting a piece of edging into the ground. If the soil is too dry and hard for installation, you'll need to dampen the soil first by watering it.
3. When the soil is ready, lightly insert a piece of edging 1/3 way into the ground.
4. Latch the rest of edging piece by piece to each other and insert them 1/3 way into the ground.
5. After all pieces are connected together and inserted into the ground, use a hammer to tap each piece deep into the ground until the stake part is totally buried under ground.
6. Check to see that the edging feels sturdy in all places. You can stomp along the curves of the edge with your feet to flatten the soil to make it compact.
