

## INSTRUCTIONS:

### Noted:

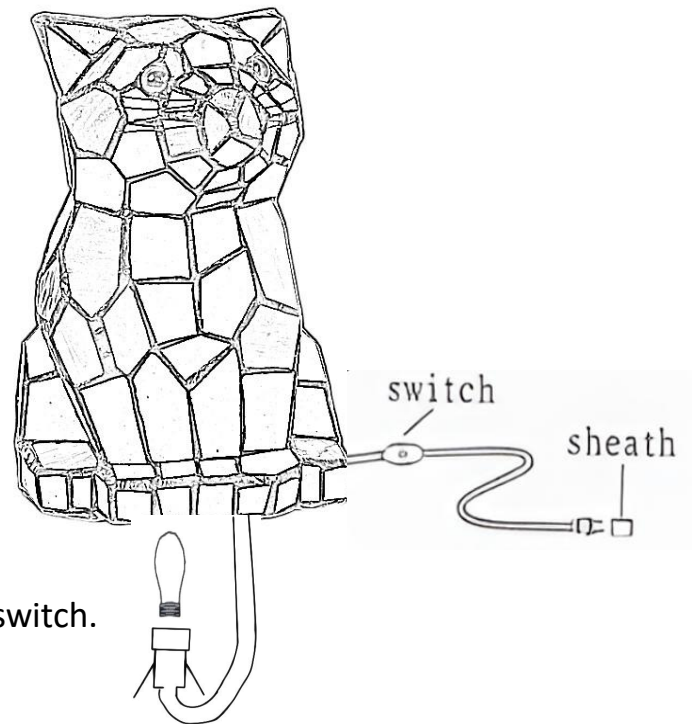
Please note that due to the nature of stained glass, each piece of glass in your shade will vary in color and texture, "This is part of the appeal of Tiffany style lamps-each one is unique-a one-of-a-kind Piece of art to be treasured for a lifetime.

### Prior to use:

Upon removing your Lamp from its packaging, you may find a coat of oil on the shade (oil is used in the final stage of production to protect the soldering). To remove the oil, place the Lamp on a soft, flat surface (be sure to place a towel on any furniture to prevent scratching). Using a paper towel, gently buff the shade, turning the towel frequently, Do not use chemical cleansers, as they may harm the finish of the soldering.

### Assembly:

- (1) Make sure that your lamp is not plugged into the electrical outlet.
- (2) Install a light bulb into the socket.
- (3) insert the two spring clips by hand to fit inside the shade.
- (4) Plug the lamp and turn on the light with the line-switch.



### Cleaning & Care:

To clean the shade, remove dust with either a paper towel or a duster-no household cleaners are needed. Occasionally, a white powder may appear on the soldering, as a result of Oxidation. To restore the soldering to its original condition, apply a small amount of Lemon or Mineral Oil to the affected area. Remove the oil with a paper towel, as described above. Do not use chemical cleansers, as they may ham the finish of the soldering.

### Warning:

1. Do not use the lamp if the cable is damaged, Take the lamp to a certified electrical repair shop for repair.
2. 'The lamp shade will become hot after being turned on. Allow the shade to cool before touching it.
3. Keep this lamp away from small children. It is not a toy.
4. Always unplug the electrical cord before cleaning or handling parts.
5. For indoor use only.
