

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

READ AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING! SHUT POWER OFF AT FUSE OR CIRCUIT BREAKER.

MOUNTING THE FIXTURE (Fig. 1)

1. Shut off power at the fuse box or circuit breaker box and remove the old fixture including the mounting hardware
2. Carefully unpack your new fixture and lay out all the parts in a clear area. Take care not to misplace any small parts necessary for installation.
3. Attach the mounting plate (C) to the junction box using the mounting screws (B). The side of the mounting plate marked "GND" must face out.

FIXTURE INSTALLATION (Fig. 1)

4. Put the shade (G) onto the fixture (H). Determine the overall desired length of the fixture. Assemble the stems (F) one at a time onto the shade (G) and the fixture (H). Tape the end of the leads to a stiff wire (coat hanger) to aid in pulling them through the stems (F).
5. Secure the canopy (D) onto the top stem section.

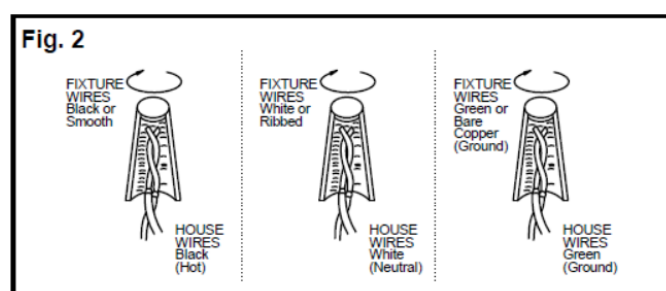
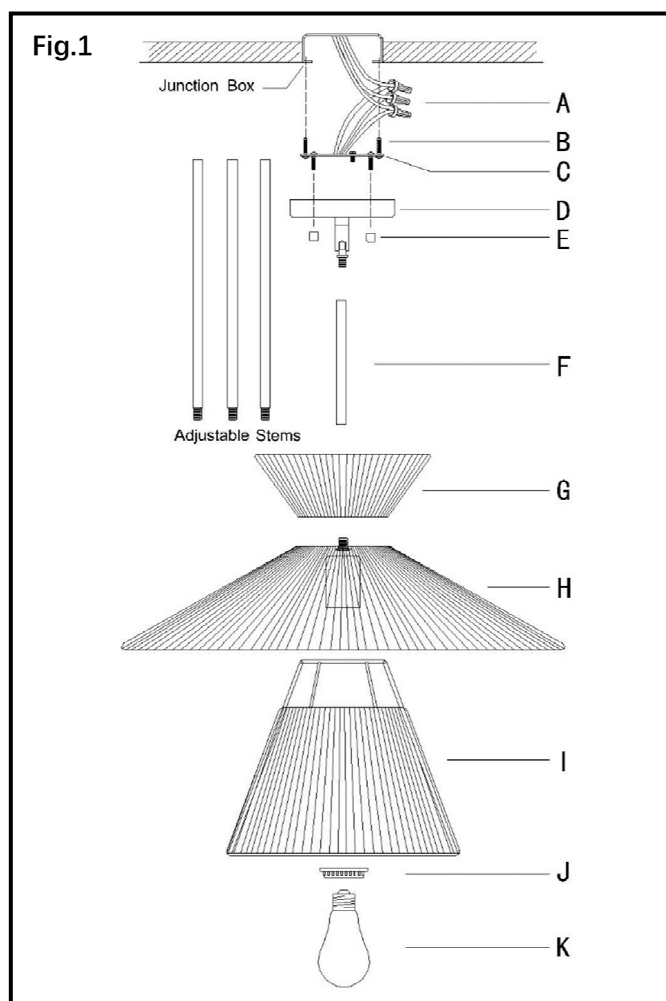
CONNECTION THE WIRES (Fig. 2)

6. At this point, connect the electrical wires as shown in Fig. 2, making sure that all wire connectors (A) are secured. If your outlet box has a ground wire (green or bare copper), connect the fixture's ground wire to it. Otherwise, connect the fixture's ground wire directly to the mounting plate (C) using the green screw provided. After the wires are connected, tuck them carefully inside the junction box.

FINISHING THE INSTALLATION (Fig. 1)

7. Place the canopy (D) over the mounting plate (C), and secure with nuts (E).
8. Place the shade (I) onto the socket, and secure with the ring (J).
9. Install one Med. base (E26) bulb (K) up to 60 watts each or CFL or LED equivalent (not included) in accordance with the fixture specification. **DO NOT EXCEED THE MAXIMUM WATTAGE RATING! (NE PAS DEPASSER LA PUISSANCE NOMINALE MAXIMALE!)**

Note: Illustration (Fig.1) on this manual is for installation purposes only. It may or may not be identical to the fixture purchased.



Care & Cleaning Instructions

ALWAYS turn off and/or unplug fixtures prior to cleaning.

Finishes: To avoid damage to the finish do not use polish, abrasive cleaners, or harsh chemicals.

Shade: Shades can be gently dusted with a dry, clean, soft-bristle brush. Remember to clean the inside of shade as well.

Using any advised against cleaning methods will void the product's warranty.
