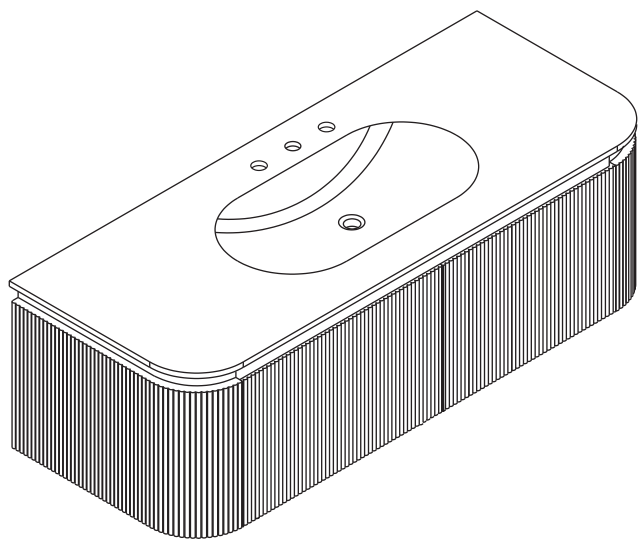

Notice:

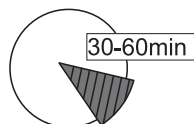
1. Follow the installation instructions. Please confirm all accessories are preset before installation.

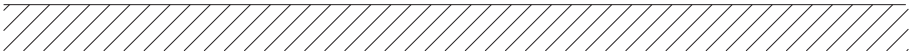
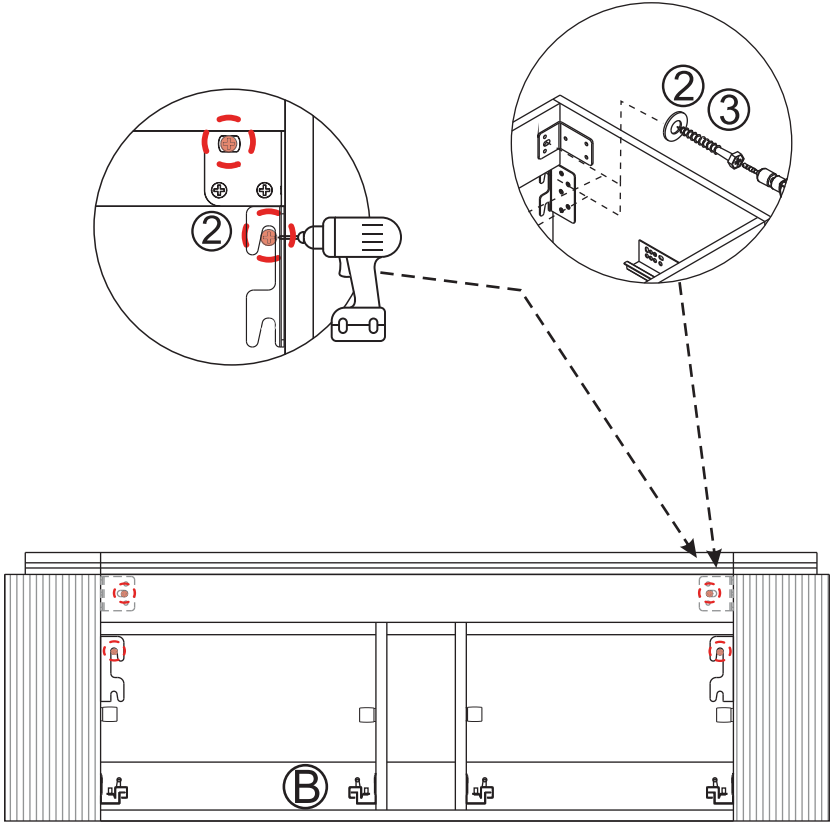


WARNING: To prevent falling down this product must be used with the wall attachment device provided.

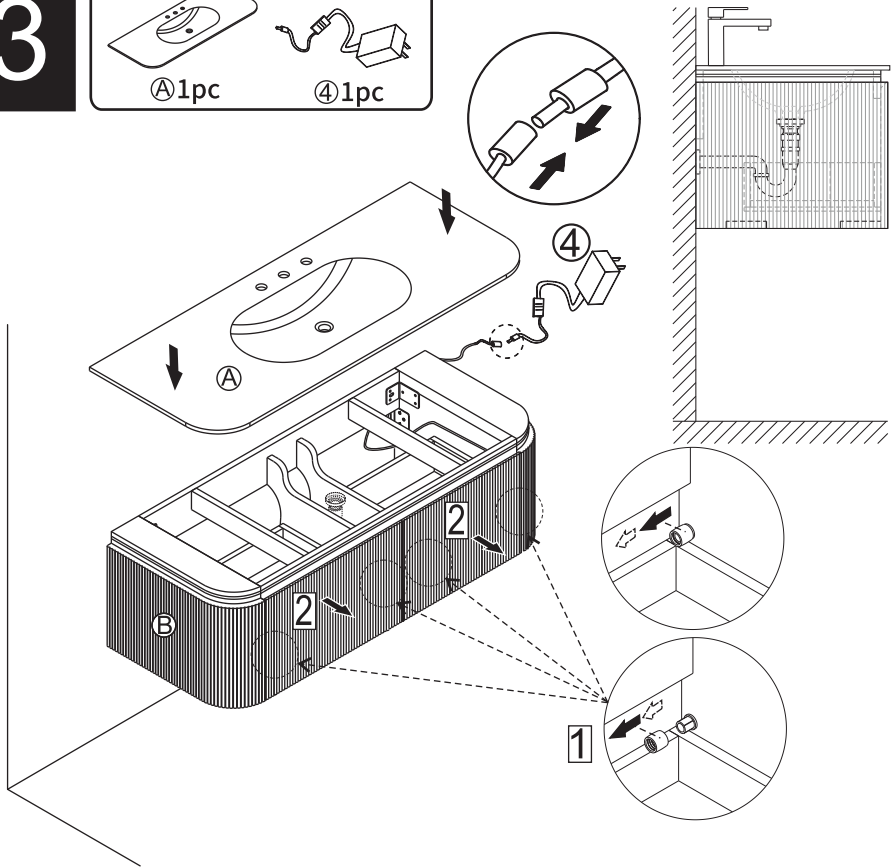
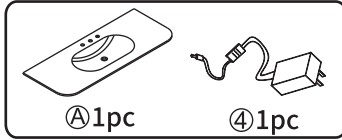

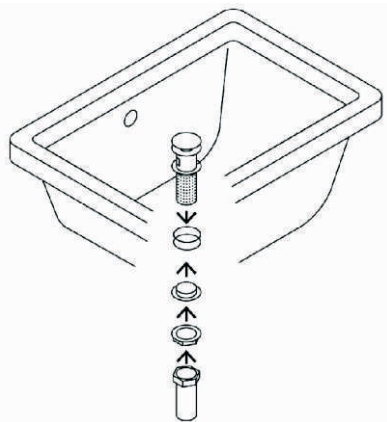

STEP 2

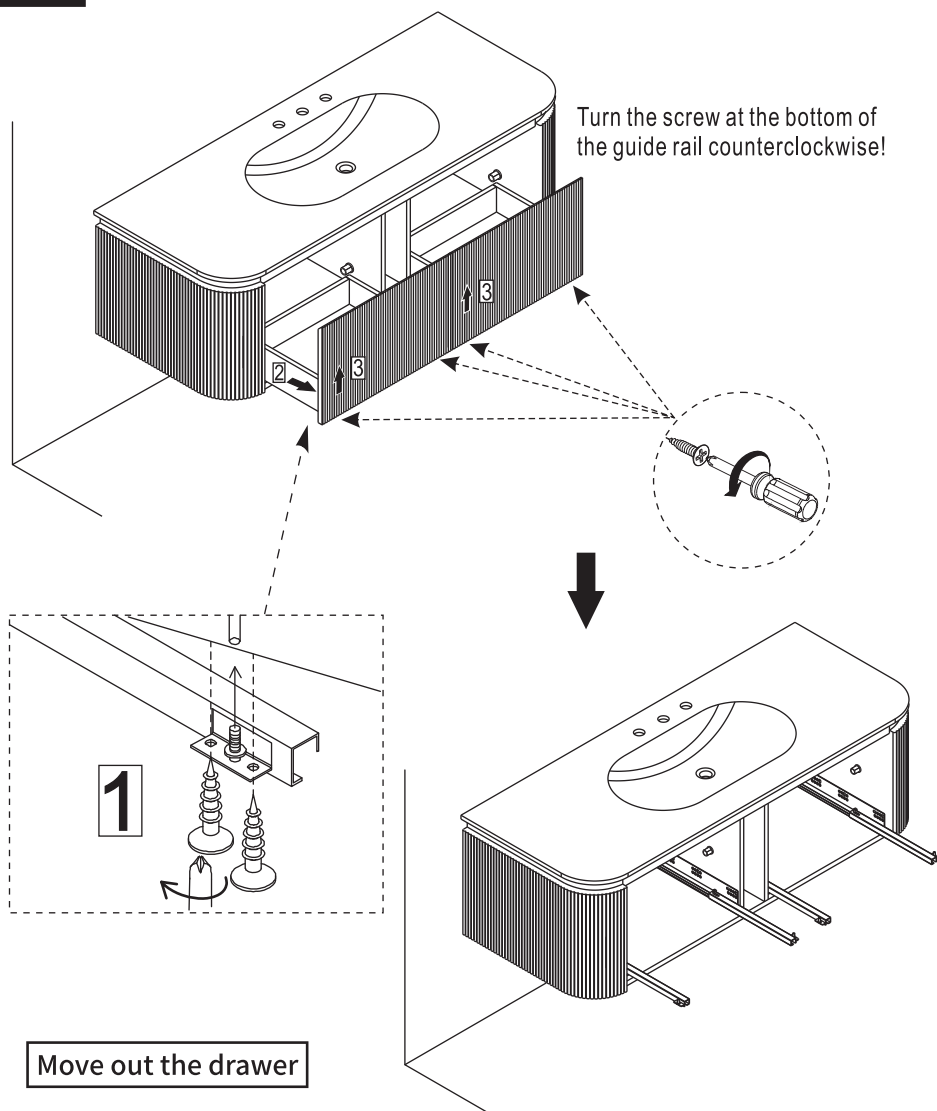
Connect the drain pipe.

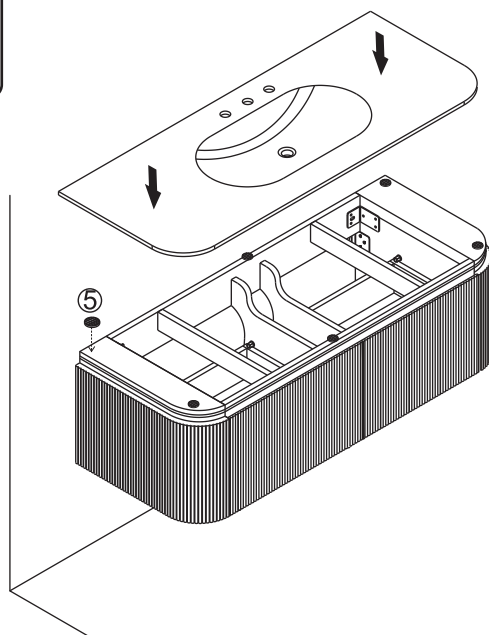

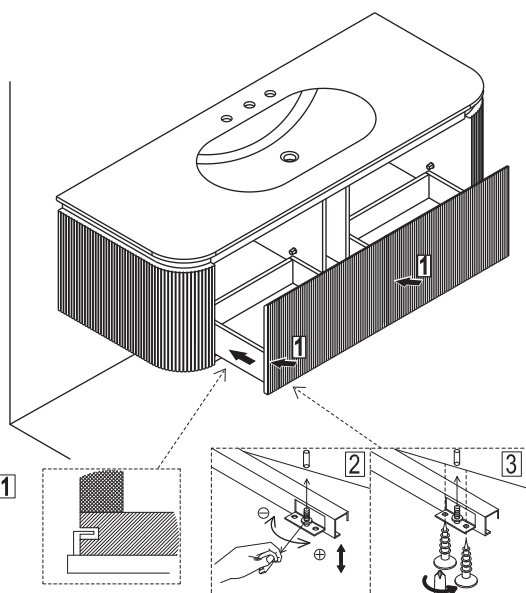
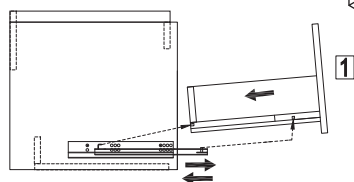
