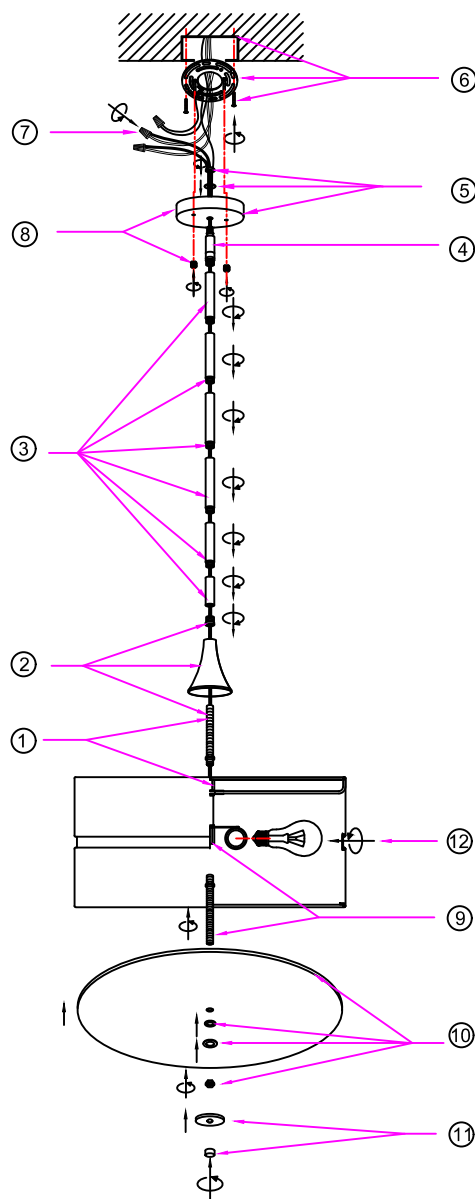


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

1. Thread the power cord through the conduit pipe, adjust the pipe length, then secure the pipe to the lamp fitting with a locknut.
 2. Pass the power cord through the horn cover and pipe fitting, then secure the horn cover to the lamp body with a pipe fitting.
 3. Adjust the suspension rod length as needed and secure it to the lamp fitting.
 4. Thread the power cord through the suspension rod.
 5. Pass the power cord through the ceiling plate, washer, and locknut, then secure the locknut to the ceiling plate.
 6. Use mounting screws to secure the mounting plate to the electrical box.
 7. Use wire connectors to connect the incoming and outgoing wires. (Note: Connect the black wire to the black wire (hot), the white wire to the white wire (neutral), and the grounding wire to the grounding terminal. Ensure wires are not exposed during connection.)
 8. Use the iron bead to secure the ceiling plate to the mounting plate.
 9. Adjust the conduit pipe length and secure it to the lamp fitting with a locknut.
 10. Place the glass washer and iron washer onto the conduit pipe, then secure the pipe with a locknut.
 11. Place the flat washer onto the conduit pipe and secure it with a locknut.
 12. Screw the bulb into the lamp fitting.
 13. Turn on the power to test if the bulb works properly.
- Installation complete.

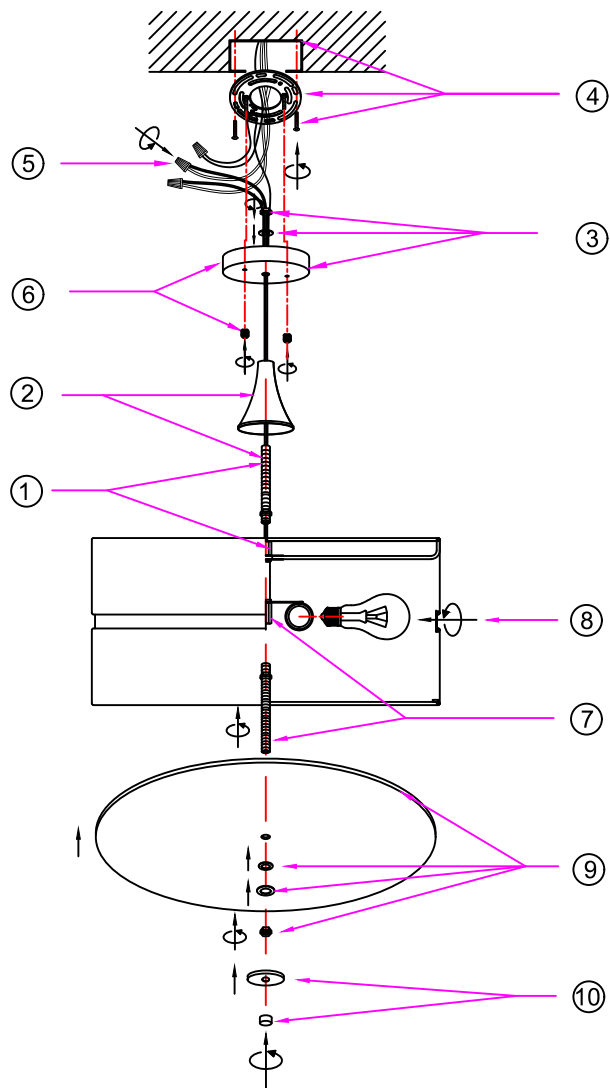
Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock, be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.

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Step-by-Step Installation:

- 1.Thread the power cord through the conduit pipe, adjust the pipe length as needed, and secure the pipe to the lamp fitting.
 - 2.Pass the power cord through the horn cover and secure the horn cover onto the conduit pipe.
 - 3.Thread the power cord through the ceiling plate, washer, and nut, then tighten the nut to secure the ceiling plate.
 - 4.Use mounting screws to secure the mounting plate to the electrical box.
 - 5.Use wire connectors to connect the incoming and outgoing wires. (Note: Connect the black wire to the black wire (hot), the white wire to the white wire (neutral), and the grounding wire to the grounding terminal. Ensure wires are not exposed during connection.)
 - 6.Use the iron bean to secure the ceiling plate to the mounting plate.
 - 7.Adjust the conduit pipe length and secure it to the lamp fitting.
 - 8.Screw the bulb into the lamp fitting.
 - 9.Place the glass washer and iron washer onto the conduit pipe, then secure the pipe with a nut.
 - 10.Place the flat washer onto the conduit pipe and secure it with a locknut.
 - 11.Turn on the power to test if the bulb works properly.
