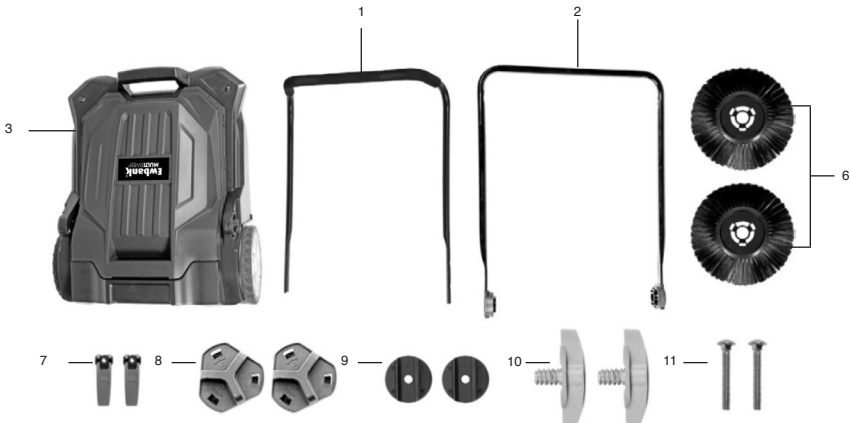

Safety precautions must be followed to prevent injury and damage. Please read and follow all the instructions even if you feel you are familiar with the product and find a safe place to keep this manual handy for future reference.

- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
- This product is designed for sweeping flat, dry surfaces, such as driveways, patios, concrete floors etc.
- Do not operate the product if damaged or defective in any way.
- This product should only be used for its intended use. Damage caused by improper use or repairs will invalidate the warranty.
- This product is not designed for commercial or industrial use.
- Use only accessories and genuine spare parts authorised by the manufacturer.
- Keep all packaging materials and small parts away from children as there is a risk of suffocation.
- Never clean the product with solvents.
- Store the product in a dry room.
- Do not leave the product unattended. Children should not play with the appliance and should be supervised.
- Do not use the product to pick up objects that are hot, harmful, flammable or explosive.
- Do not use the product to pick up liquids.
- Gloves should be worn to remove any sharp, metal or glass objects from the waste collection container.

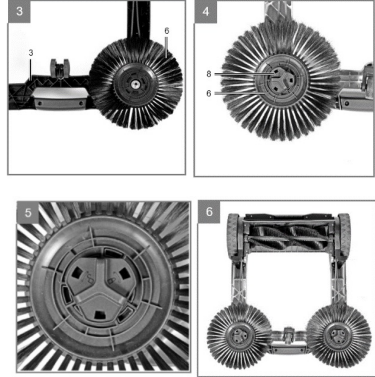

Open the package and remove all packaging materials. Check that all parts are present and inspect for any damage. Do not use the product if it is damaged or incomplete in any way. Contact our Customer Service Department.

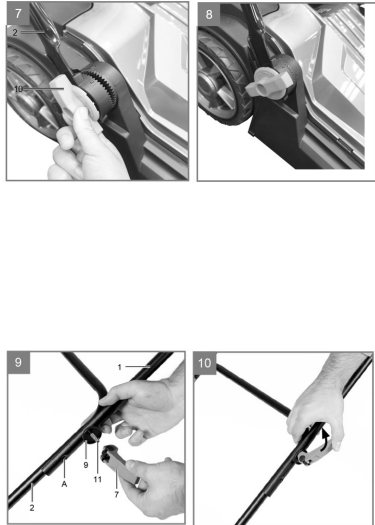
Installing the Feeder Brushes

1. Position the feeder brush (6) onto the underneath of the sweeper chassis (3), as shown in figure 3.
2. To secure the feeder brush in place insert the feeder brush cap (8) into the grooves on the base (fig 4).
3. Turn the feeder brush cap as indicated to lock in place (fig 5).
4. Repeat on the other side (fig 6).
5. To remove the brushes, turn the brush caps in the opposite direction to unlock and remove, lift off the brushes.



Installing the Push Bar

1. To secure the lower push bar (2), lift the bar to the desired angle and then turn the lower push bar locking mechanisms (10) until the teeth are fully interlocked (fig 7 and 8).
2. To attach the upper push bar (1) align the holes on each side with the holes in the lower push bar (2). To increase the height of the push bar, select the highest set of mounting holes on the lower push bar (2).
3. Thread the push bar screws (11) through the holes in the push bars and then screw on the upper push bar support discs (9), the ridged side should be facing towards the push bar (fig 9).
4. Screw the upper push bar release handles (7) onto the push bar screws (11), leaving enough space so that that handle can be pushed up to secure (fig 10).



Using the Push Sweeper

Push the sweeper forward to propel the feeder brushes (6). The feeder brushes will rotate to sweep any debris/waste underneath the push sweeper. The roller brush underneath the sweeper will then push the debris into the waste collection container (5).

Depending on the type of debris to be cleared, install the most suitable set of feeder brushes.

- The thinner bristled set: best for finer debris such as dust and sand.
- The thicker bristled set: better for larger debris such as leaves and garden waste.

Emptying the Waste Collection Container

To empty the waste collection container, lift the container (5) upwards from the sweeper chassis (3) using the handle (fig 11). Tip slowly to empty into a waste container. Replace back into the sweeper chassis, making sure the container is properly in place.

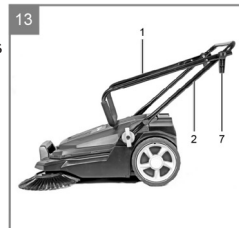
WARNING: Dust can be hazardous to health, wear a dust mask when emptying the waste collection container.



Collapsing for Storage

The push sweeper handle can be folded in the below ways to suit your space available.

1. To fold the lower push bar, loosen the lower push bar locking mechanisms (10) unlocking the teeth, so that the push bar can be lowered (fig 12). Re tighten the lower push bar locking mechanisms to secure in the folded position.
2. The upper push bar can also be folded in this position. To do this lift the upper push bar release handles (7) and fold the upper push bar over the sweeper chassis.
3. Alternatively, leave the lower push bar (2) locked in the upright position and just fold down the upper push bar (1) by lifting the upper push bar release handles (7) and then folding down the upper push bar (fig 13).



- Empty the waste collection container after each use.
- Keep the guards and air vents as clear from dust and dirt as possible.
- Clean the appliance regularly with a damp cloth and soap.
- It is recommended to clean the appliance after every use.

WARNING: Do not use detergents or solvents to clean the appliance as they could damage the plastic parts. Take care to make sure that no water gets inside the appliance.

Storage

It is recommended to store the sweeper in its original packaging. Store the sweeper in a dark, dry, frost-free place. The temperature should be between 5-30°C.

If you experience difficulties with the appliance, please check the suggestions below before contacting customer services on 01473 271272:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Pushing the appliance is not easy and the rotation of the wheels is not smooth.	Lift the appliance to check the wheels and chassis for obstruction.	Remove any debris from around the wheel.
The feeder brush is not turning properly when pushed.	Lift the appliance to check for large debris.	Remove any large debris that cannot be swept up.
When the appliance is pushed the wheels do not rotate they slide.	The ground is flat or smooth or there is water on the ground. The wheels need friction to turn.	The appliance cannot work on surfaces that are too smooth or damp.
