

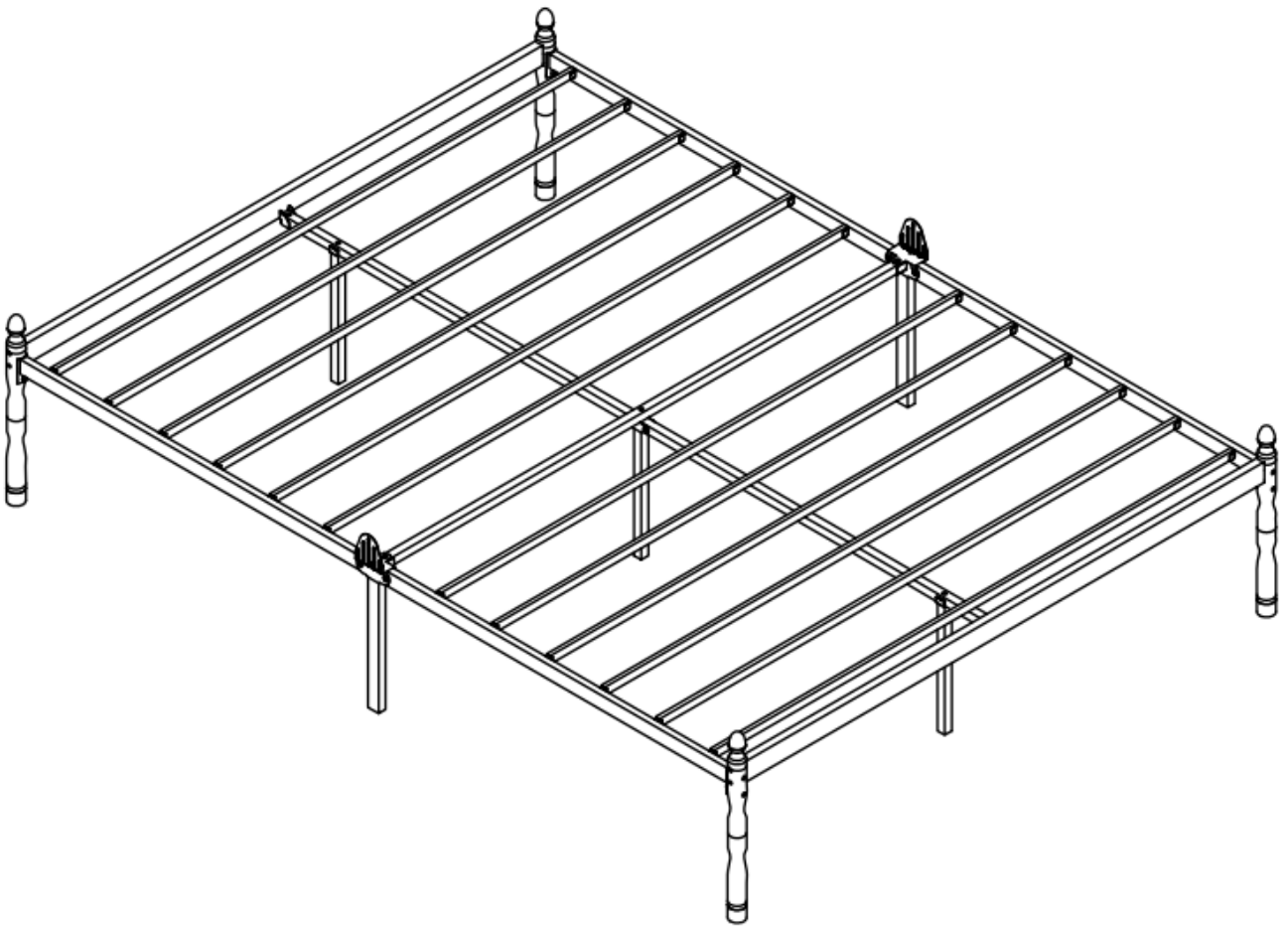

****Warranty Information****

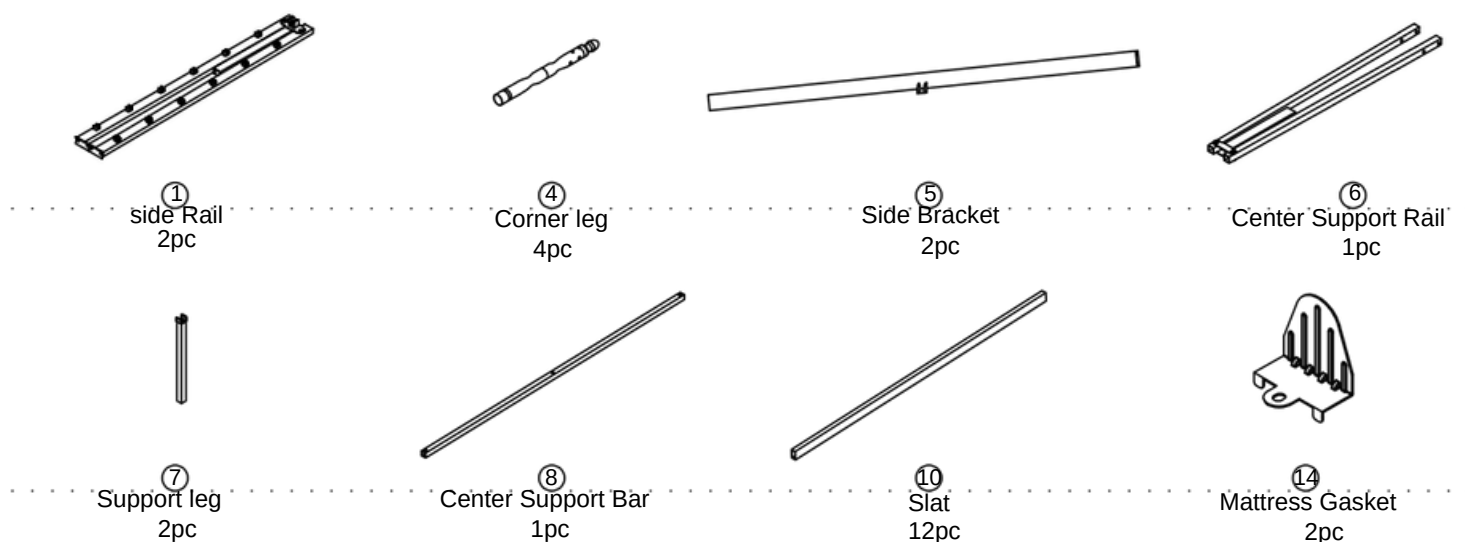
1. We warrant this product to be free from defects in materials and workmanship for three years from the date of original purchase. Proof of purchase is required for all warranty claims.

****Read Before Beginning Assembly****

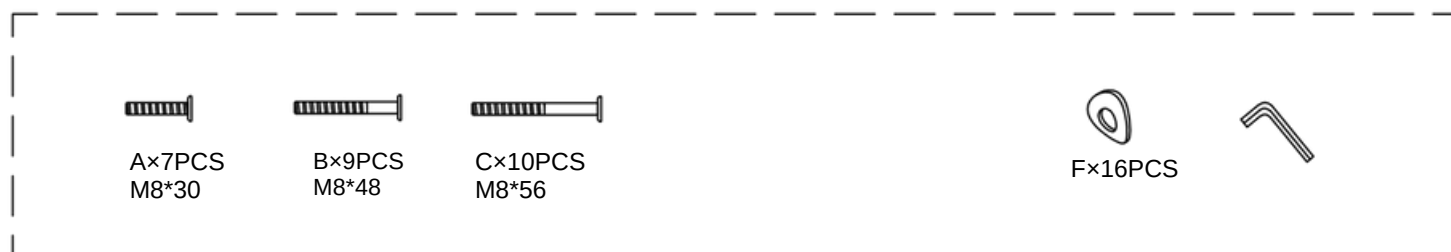
1. Clear the area: Assemble in a spacious area near the product's final location, preferably on a carpet or protected surface (like the product's cardboard packaging) to safeguard both your floor and the product.
2. Recommended Assembly Team: It is recommended that at least two people assemble this product. Having an extra hand can make the process easier. Estimated assembly time is 1 hour.
3. Check for all parts: Most parts are labeled or stamped on the raw edge. Ensure all parts are included before starting.
4. Read each step carefully: Follow the assembly steps in the correct order. Skipping steps or changing the sequence can lead to difficulties.

*** *Caution****

1. CHOKING HAZARD - Small Parts: This product contains small parts. Keep out of reach of children.
2. DO NOT USE POWER TOOLS: Power tools can strip or damage parts and void the warranty.
3. IMPORTANT: Do not fully tighten any bolts until the entire unit is assembled. This will allow for proper alignment and adjustment during the assembly process.

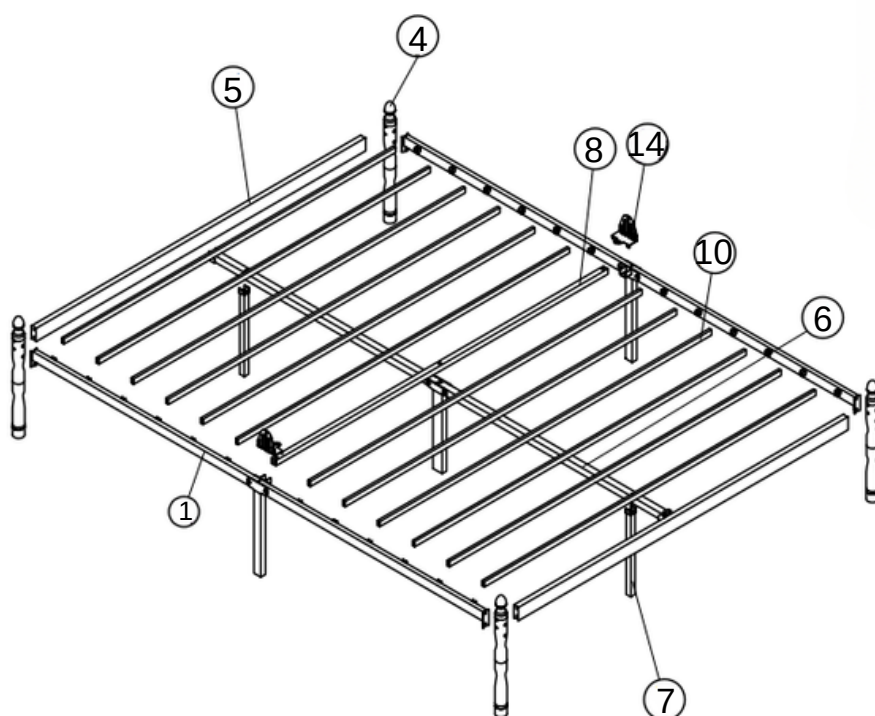

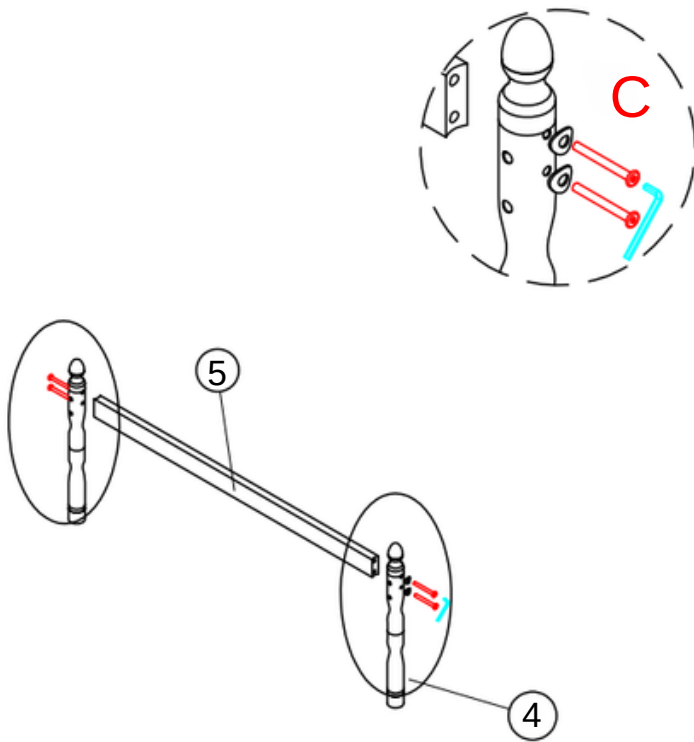

Step 1

Footboard Assembly

Position the footboard rail (5) between the two footboard posts (4). Insert the bolts (C) and washers (F) through the pre-drilled holes as shown in the diagram and hand-tighten all bolts first to ensure proper alignment.

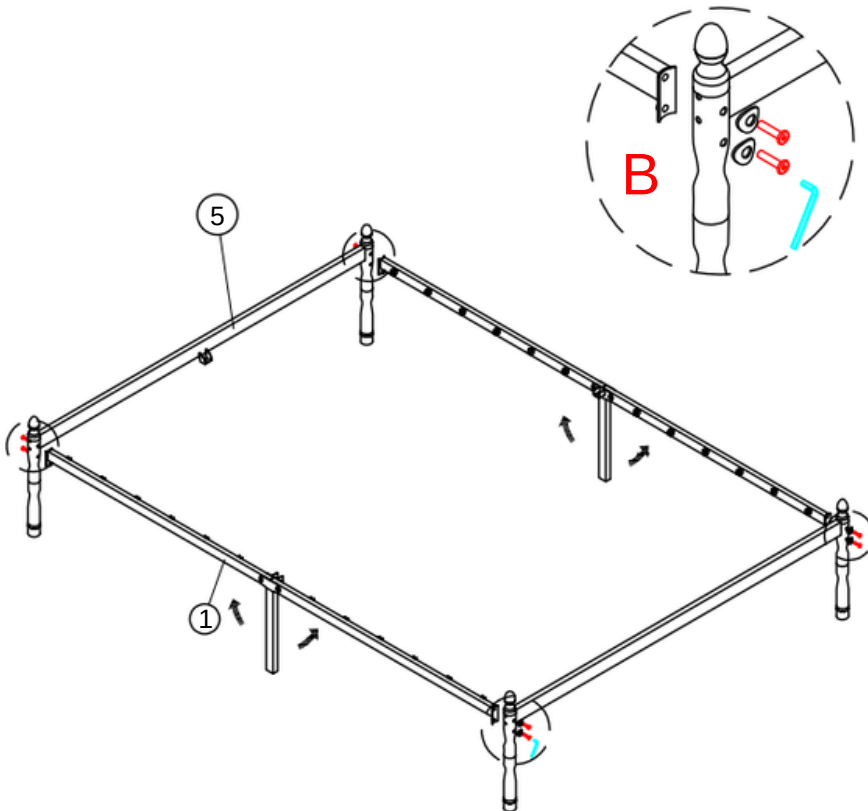

Step 2

Assemble the Bed Frame

Open the side rail ① and align the mounting bracket with the appropriate holes on the corner legs. After the bolts (B) and washers (F) are in place, use the provided Allen wrench to completely tighten each bolt.

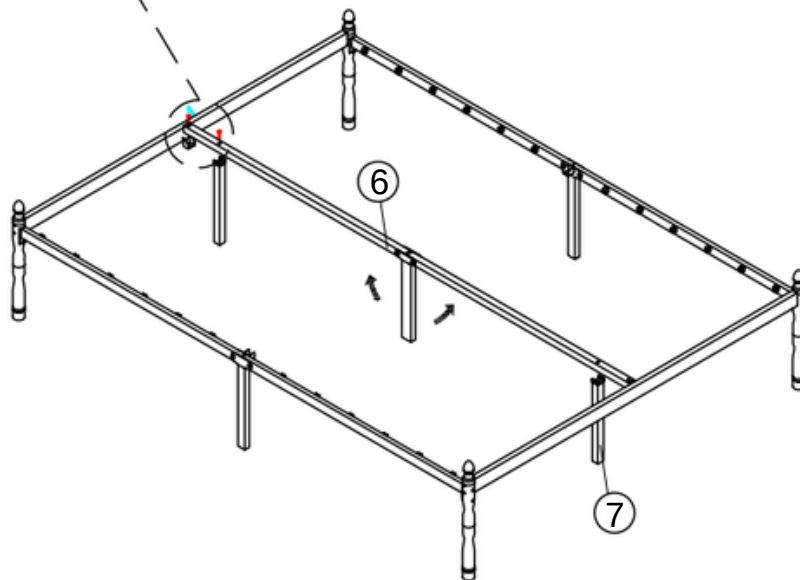
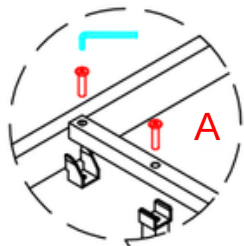

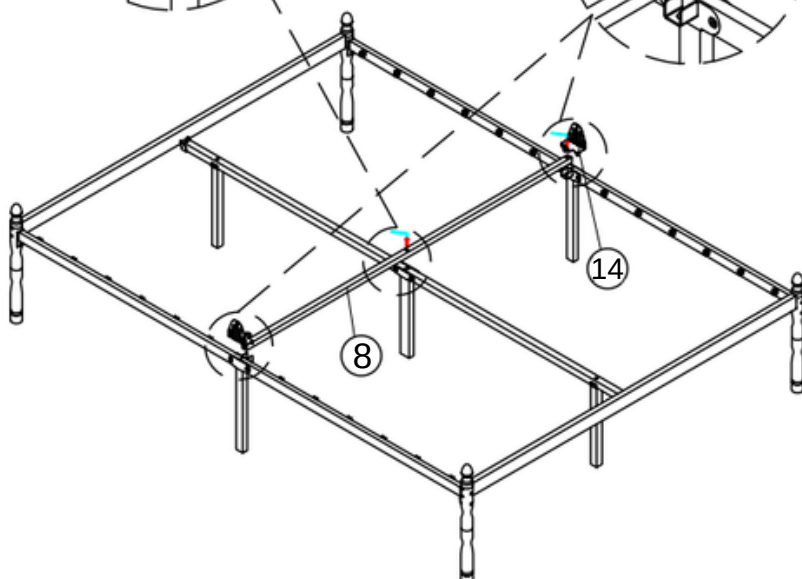
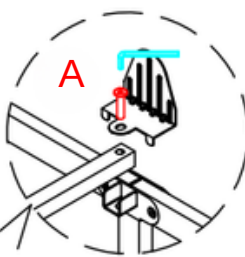
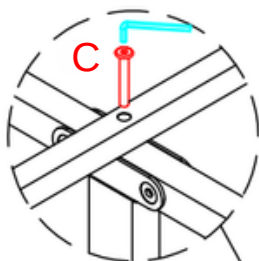
-- Note: Make sure each beam is fully seated for maximum stability

Step 3

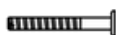
Install center support bar

Place the center support rail (6) at the corresponding positions at both ends of the bed frame.

Tighten these completely with A bolt (A) with the support leg (7).

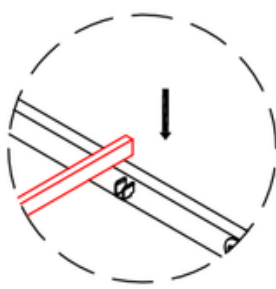

Step 4

Install center support bar

Locate the middle transverse tube and attach it to the center rod using bolt C.

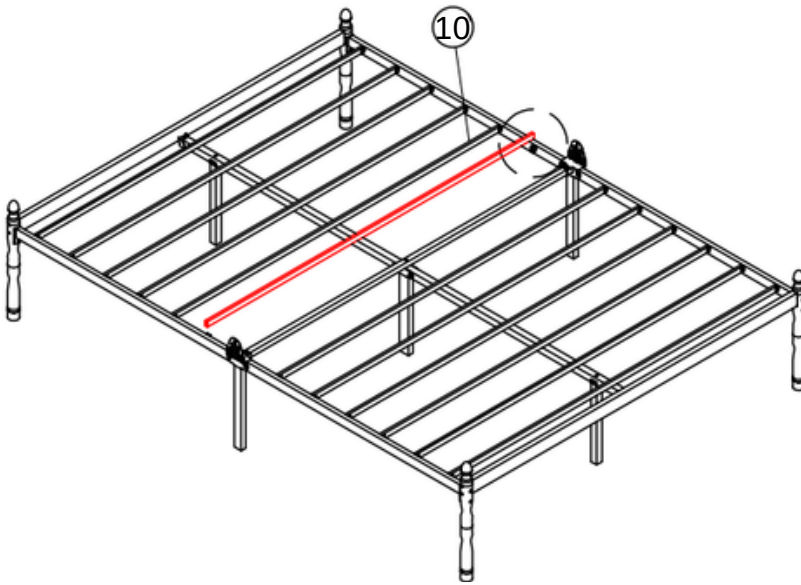
Secure the middle transverse tube using bolt A through the Mattress Gasket (14)



Step 5

Installing the Bed Slats

Place all bed slats across the side rails as shown in the diagram. Each slat should be securely positioned in the designated slots.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Weight Limit: The maximum combined weight on the bed should not exceed 1000 lbs. This includes the weight of the bed itself, mattresses, bedding, and people. 4. Do not drag or push the bed frame: Always use two people to lift and reposition the bed frame to avoid damage to the frame or the floor.

****Cleaning & Care****

1. Cleaning Method: Use a dry or slightly damp soft cloth for cleaning. Avoid abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish. 2. Hardware Maintenance: Over time, hardware can loosen. Regularly check and tighten all connections to maintain the bed's stability and prevent damage.
