IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: RISK OF ELECTRICALSHOCK

- Turn off electrical power at fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring fixture to the power supply.
- Turn off the power when you perform any maintenance.
- Verify that supply voltage is correct by comparing it with the luminaire label information.
- Make all electrical and grounded connections in accordancewith the National Electrical Code and any applicable local code requirements.
- All wiring connections should be capped with UL approved wire connectors.

CAUTION: RISK OF INJURY

- · Wear gloves and safety glasses at all times when removing luminaire from carton, installing, servicing or performing maintenance.
- Avoid direct eye exposure to the light source while it is on.
- · Account for small parts and destroy packing material, as these may be hazardous to children.

WARNING: RISK OF BURN

- Allow fixture to cool before handling. Do not touch enclosure or light source.
- Do not exceed maximum wattage marked on luminaire label.
- · Follow all lamp manufacturer's warnings, recommendations and restrictions for: driver type, burning position, mounting locations/methods, replacement, and recycling.

CAUTION: RISK OF FIRE

Keep combustible and other materials that can burn away from luminaire and lamp/lens.

At main fuse box (or circuit breaker box) Before removing the old fixture



REQUIRES 2 PEOPLE

Assistance will be required to support the fixture during installation

- 1 Remove the CROSS BAR which was pre-insatlled to the CANOPY, then install it to the junction box by using two mounting screws.
- Thread the fixture wire from the fixture through the LOWER ROD, and then secure the LOWER ROD onto fixture using the THREADED PIPE. Thread the FIXTURE WIRES through the RODS and the CANOPY, and then secure the ROD assembly to the set nipple of the CANOPY.

Note: Length adjustable from 11" to 46". Use fewer rods if shorter length is desired.

- 3 Place the CAGE onto the SHADE, and then attach assembly canopy to the top center pipe nipple of the SHADE, by turning it clockwise until tight.
- 4 Pull out the source wires from the junction box. Make wire connections using wire nuts as follows:
 - a. Connect the black wire from the fixture to the black wire from the junction box.
 - b. Connect the white wire from the fixture to the white wire from the junction box.
 - c. Attach the fixture grounding wire to the CROSS BAR with the green grounding screw, and then connect it to the house grounding wire with a wire nut.

Carefully put the wires back into the junction box.

- Attach the CANOPY to the CROSS BAR by inserting it through the mounting screws which was pre-insatlled on the CROSS BAR, then secure it with the two ball nuts.
- 6 Install the bulbs (not included). Check relamping label at socket area or packaging for maximum allowed wattage.
- 7 Screw the THREADED PIPE into the coupling at the bottom of the fxture, then secure it with HEX NUT A.
- Screw the HEX NUT B into the THREADED PIPE. Place the GLASS DIFFUSER, RUBBER RING (A,B), and WASHER (A,B) onto the THREADED PIPE, then secure with HEX NUT C. Place the CAP onto the THREADED PIPE, Tighten with CAP NUT.



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
