 Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



Do not place furniture outside. For indoor use only.



 Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



 Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.


Please look in carton for hardware packs and legs. Sets often ship in multiple boxes and may arrive a day or two apart.

Assembly Preparation

Before Beginning Assembly:

Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-




Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



Save all packaging until finished-


Assembly Steps



This Chair has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Chair, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Note: It is recommended that you have an adult partner to assist during the entire assembly process.


Step 1



Position the Chair Seat(A) on a clean, non-marring surface as shown.

Carefully take out the Legs(E) and Hardware from the bottom of the Chair Seat(A).

Step 2




Install each of the Leg(E) to the bottom of the chair using Bolts() with Allen Wrench() as pictured above.

Tighten the Bolts fully in a sequential manner.

DO NOT fully tighten a Bolt in one go and then move on to the next.

Step 3




Turn the assembled Chair Seat (A) over.

With the assistance from your partner, lift the Backrest (B) up, align the Connector on the Backrest (B) with the Holed Bracket on the Chair Seat(A).

Insert the Connector head into the Hole (large side).


Note: Please push the Backrest(B) towards the Chair Seat a little when inserting connector.





Push down the Backrest (B) until the Connector move into the Hole (small side) and touch the Hole's upside edge.

Note: Make sure Step 3 is correctly acted, then do this step.




Turn the assembled Chair lying on Backrest (B) as picture shown.

Attach Backrest(B) to Chair Seat(A) using Bolts($\,$), Spring Washers($\,$ 3), and Washers($\,$ 4) with the Allen Wrench ($\,$ 4) as pictured above.

DO NOT fully tighten a Bolt in one go and then move on to the next.

Rather, In a sequential manner, gradually tighten each Bolt until all Bolts are evenly secured.



Place the Seat Cushion(C) and the Pillow (D) onto the Chair. Your Chair is ready for use.

This Chair can only be used on a flat, level surface.
