Instruction

Product introduction:

No need of any other tools to install. Batteries operated. Simple operation will provide your home with a beautiful decorative string light.

- 1. Take the product out of the box.
- 2. Pull off the battery compartment cover and insert 3 "AA" alkaline batteries (not included) into the battery compartment.
- 3. Turn switch to "ON" to be able to activate functions.
- 4. This unit includes Timer Control function, Whenever you turn the switch to "ON", the lights will automatically light up for 6 hours then turn off for 18 hours.
- 5. To deactivate turn switch to "OFF"
- 6. Only suitable for indoor use.
- 7. Bulbs cannot be replaced.
- 8. Do not connect this light set electrically to another one.
- 9. Avoid any damage to the isolation of the wiring
