

Creative Fengshui Fish Tank for Living Room

– User Manual

Initiate a New Era of Lazy Fish KeepingPlease read this instruction manual carefully before use

Preface

Thank you for purchasing our acrylic aquarium. Please read this manual carefully before use and follow the instructions according to the purchased model.

1. After purchasing the aquarium, first select a suitable placement location, generally avoiding areas against walls with direct sunlight exposure.

2. Fill the aquarium with water completely to check for water leakage (All tanks have undergone a 24-hour water leakage test before leaving the factory). Let it stand for about half a day, then wipe and disinfect the exterior of the fish tank thoroughly. Turn on the filtration system and run it for 5 to 7 days before adding fish.

3. After filling with water, check if the light, submersible pump and air pump are working properly.

Notes

1. The aquarium must be placed on a flat surface when filling with water. Before filling, place the pre-configured reinforcing bars of each tank on the designated positions of the tank body to prevent damage caused by increased weight after water injection.

2. The temperature of the water for filling shall not exceed 50° C,

otherwise the tank body will be damaged by high temperature.

3. Reserve a certain water level margin when filling with water, and top up the water after putting fish in to avoid overflow due to overfilling after fish stocking.

4. The submersible pump must be completely submerged in water, otherwise it will overheat and be damaged.

5. Check if the air outlet pipe of the air pump is properly connected and if the air volume regulating valve is closed or too loose during operation.

6. The sockets inside the cover are marked with the corresponding appliances to be connected; do not plug in the wrong ones. The power of electrical appliances connected to the spare socket shall not exceed 500W.

7. This product is strictly prohibited from contacting objects with a temperature higher than 60° C and corrosive chemical solutions.

8. Do not wipe the surface with hard objects or rags with sand powder when cleaning to prevent scratches on the tank surface.

Tank Initialization Knowledge

Dear customer, after installing the equipment, to keep the water in the fish tank clear and the fish healthy, please fill the tank with water after receiving it, turn on the water pump and air pump, and let them run for more than 7 to 10 days to cultivate a stable nitrifying bacteria system in the tank. Only put fish in when the pH value is stable. Fish will be in an acclimation period right after being put into the tank, and it is normal for them to sink to the bottom. Do not feed them for the first 3

days, then feed them once every 2 to 3 days with a small amount—ensure the feed is eaten up within one minute. If there is any leftover feed, reduce the amount at the next feeding. Try to turn on the tank light as little as possible in the first month after stocking fish, because prolonged light exposure will easily cause moss to grow on the tank walls. Thank you for your cooperation and wish you a pleasant fish-keeping experience!

Signs of Fish Illness

Your fish is ill if it shows the following symptoms, and you need to treat it in a timely manner:

- Sinking to the bottom, head down or lying on its side
- Slow swimming, hiding in a corner of the tank
- Physical injuries, scale loss
- White hair or white spots on the body
- Swollen, cloudy caudal fin with severe blood streaks
- Cloudy eyes
- Dull body color and solitary behavior
