- Adult supervision recommended.

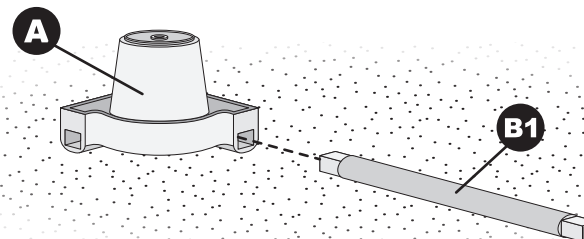

1 Connect a Short Pole into a Cot Corner

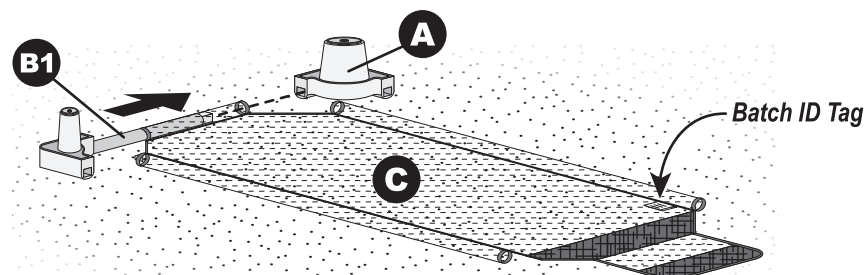
Insert the squared end of one **Short Pole (B1)** in the square receiver of a **Cot Corner (A)** as shown, until it is fully seated in the receiver.



2 Insert Short Pole through Cot Netting

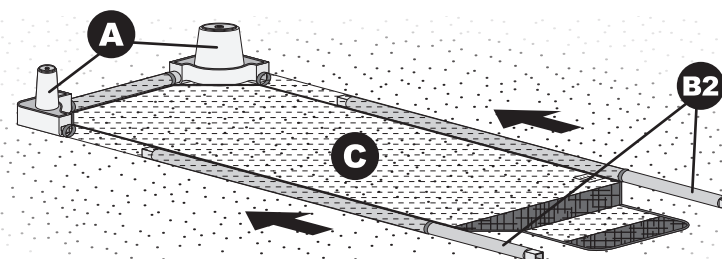
With the **Cot Netting (C)** upside down (*Hook & Loop facing up*), insert the open end of the **Short Pole (B1)** through the short pocket at the end of the **Cot Netting (C)**.

Insert the squared end of another **Short Pole (B1)** in the square receiver of a **Cot Corner (A)** as shown, until it is fully seated in the receiver.



3 Insert Long Poles through Cot Netting

Insert the **Long Poles (B2)** through the long pockets on the sides of the **Cot Netting (C)** until they are fully seated in the square receivers of **Cot Corners (A)**.

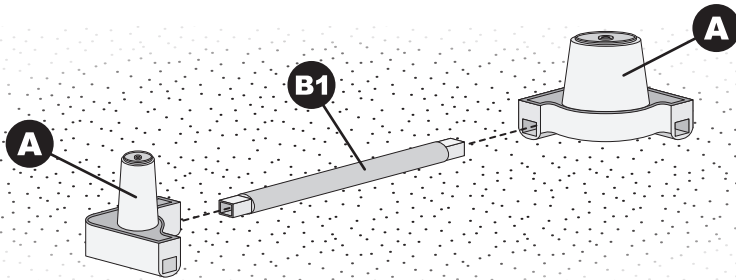

Connect the other Short Pole/Corners

Insert the squared end of another **Short Pole (B1)** in the square receivers of two **Cot Corners (A)** as shown, until it is fully seated in the receiver.

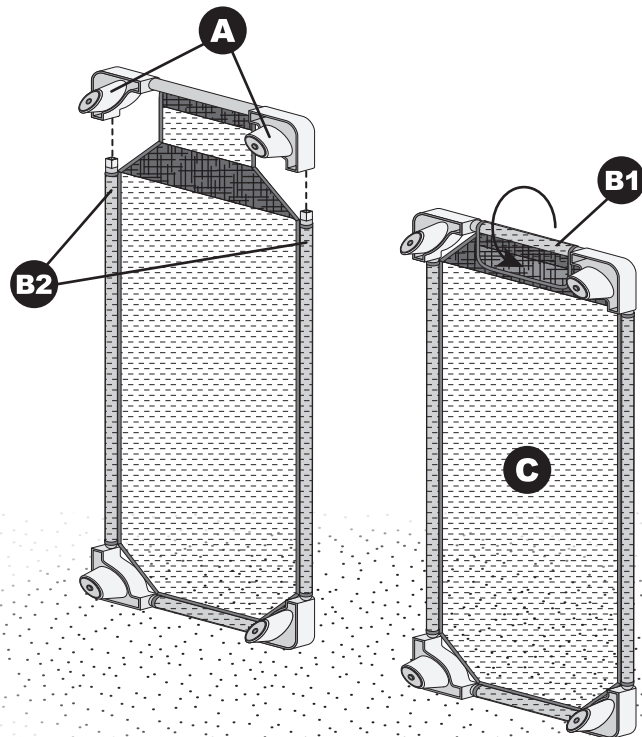

Insert the Short End & Secure Flap

Insert the square receivers of two **Cot Corners (A)** onto the squared ends of the **Long Poles (B2)** as shown, until it is fully seated in the receiver.

Pull the **Cot Netting (C)** taught up over the **Short Pole (B1)**, then secure the Hook & Loop Flap to the Hook & Loop section on the underside of the **Cot Netting (C)**.

Care and Cleaning

Clean unit with a damp cloth or sponge using warm water and mild soap. Wipe dry.

Do not launder in Washing Machine or Dryer. Do not use cleaners with ammonia or abrasives as this may cause damage.

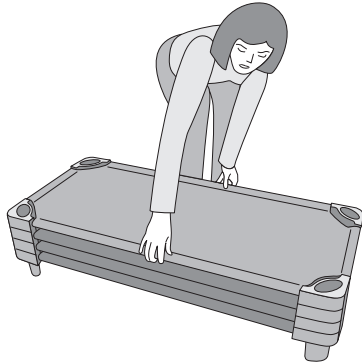

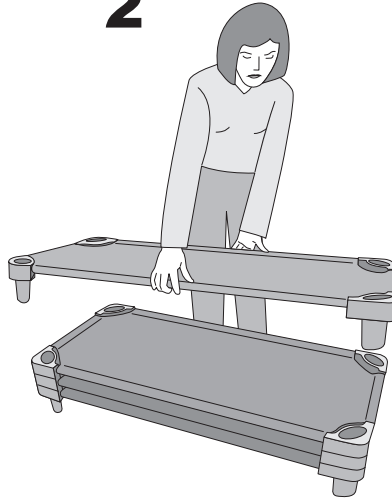
Cot Handling Instructions

Cots are designed to be un-stacked by lifting with 2-hands, from the center of the COT, in a vertical motion. By following this stacking and un-stacking procedure, you will ensure many years of use for your cots.

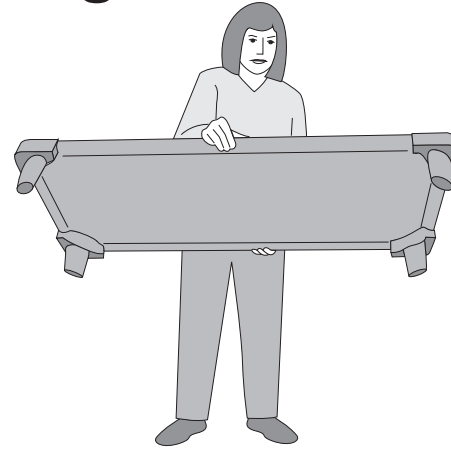

Lifting the cot from the ends or sides creates an un-stable and un-safe condition for the person lifting and will put undue stress on the Cot Corners & Poles, which may cause them to break.
