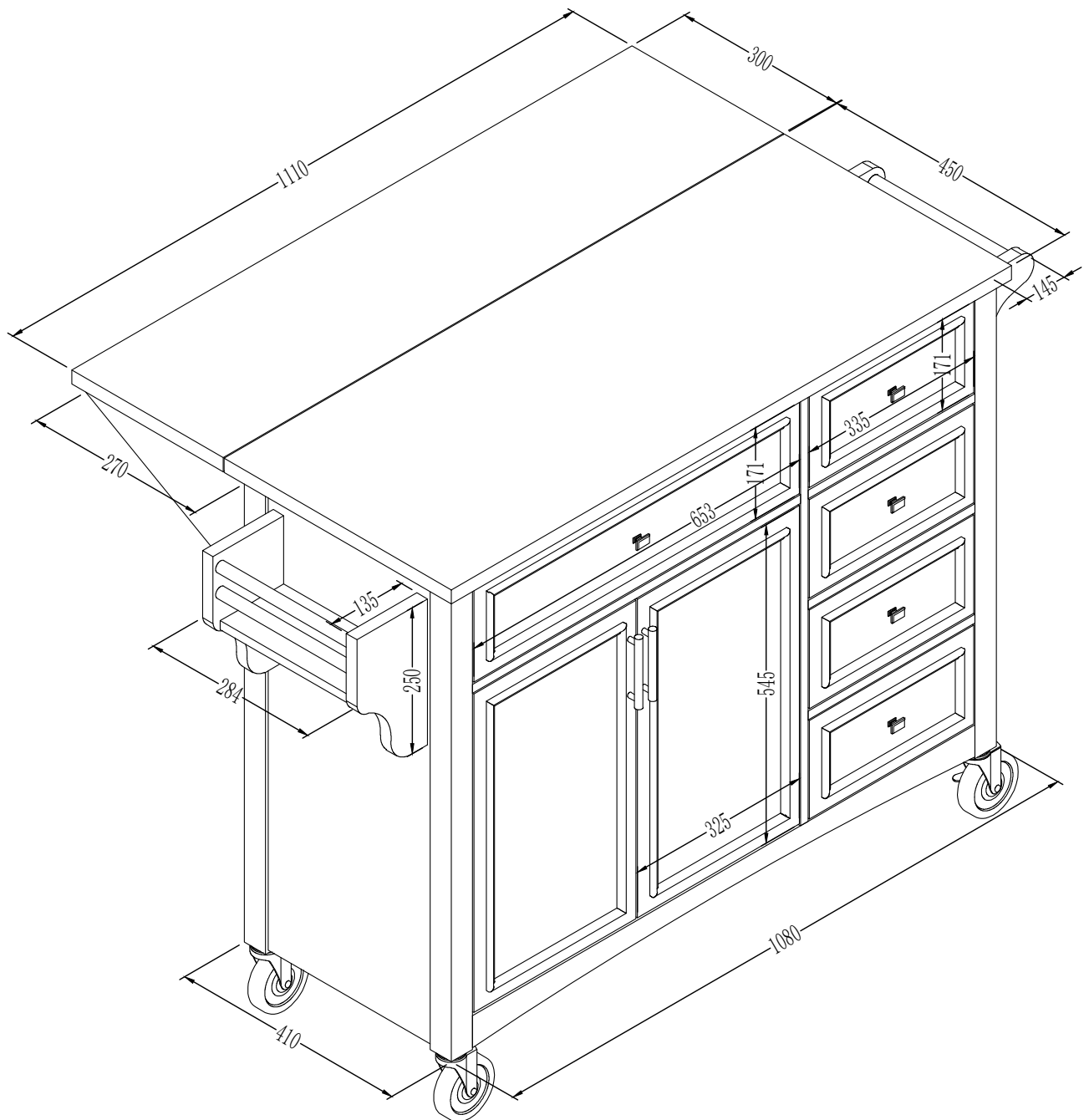

Safety and Care Advice

Important – Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.

Handy Hints

- Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts
- Regularly check and ensure That all bolts and fittings are tightened properly.

WARNING In order to help prevent overturning – please follow these instructions

To help prevent product toppling over please follow the below steps:-

Use the anti tip strap or wall fixing method provided (if applicable)
Do not allow children to climb or hang on the furniture
Do not open more than one drawer at a time
Do not place heavy items in the top drawers
Do not place heavy items on top of the furniture, unless the furniture has been designed for this purpose

Please note that only the anti tip strap is provided.

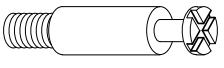
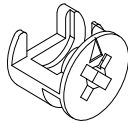
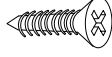
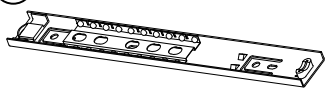
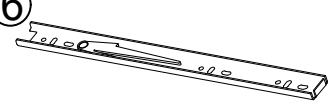
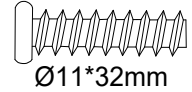
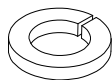
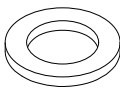
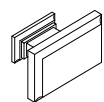
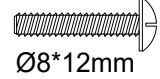
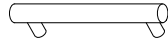
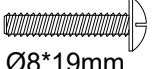
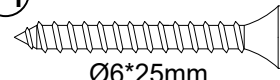
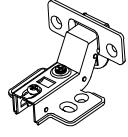
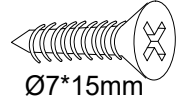
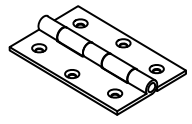
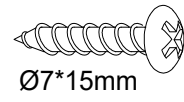
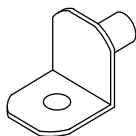
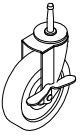
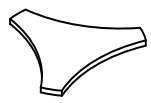
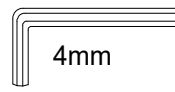
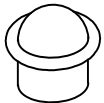

Tools required



Screwdrivers can be converted to Phillips and Slotted.

Ruler - Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws



The screws length is measured from the head to the point (35mm screw shown).

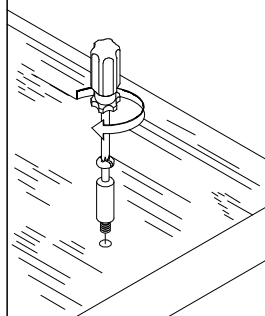
Using Camlocks

Step 1

Connect the male camlock as directed in the assembly instructions using a screwdriver.

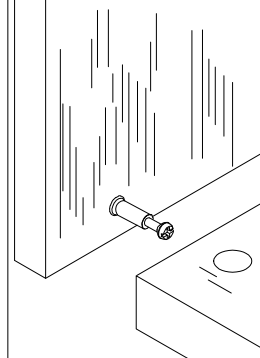
DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN.

Push the male camlock into the entry hole.

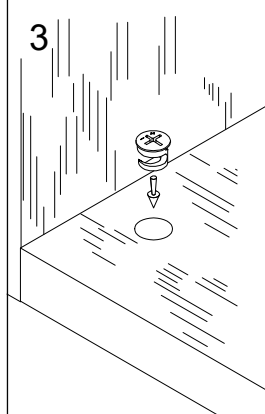


Step 3

Insert the female camlock as shown in the instruction.

Note: ensure that the arrow on the top of the camlock points towards the entry hole for the male camlock.

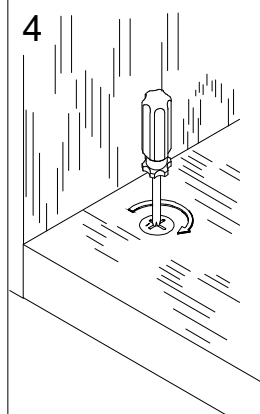
Step 4

Turn the female camlock clockwise with a screwdriver.

You should feel a click when the camlock is locked in place.

The joint is now secure.

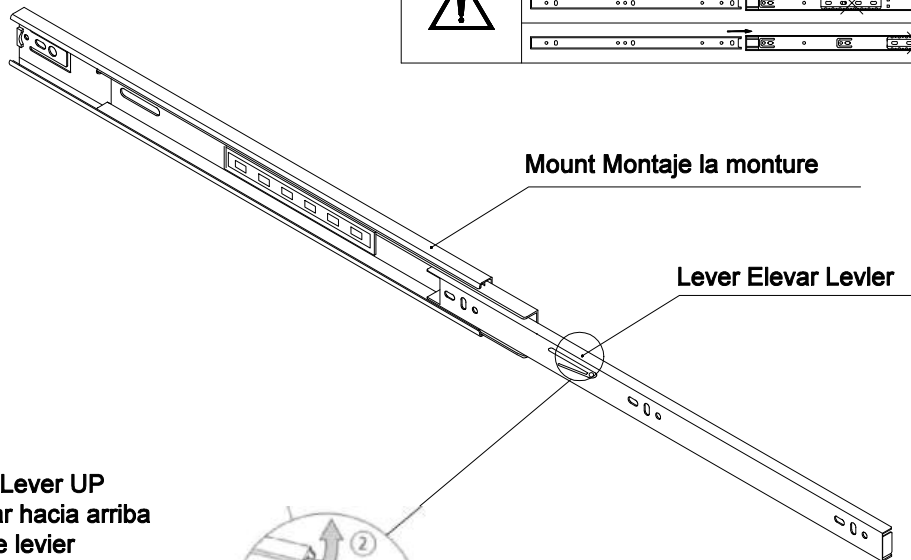
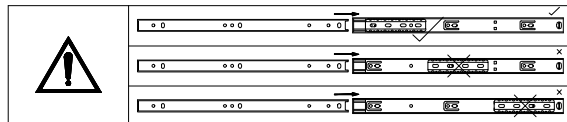
Slides Must Be Separated Before Assembly.

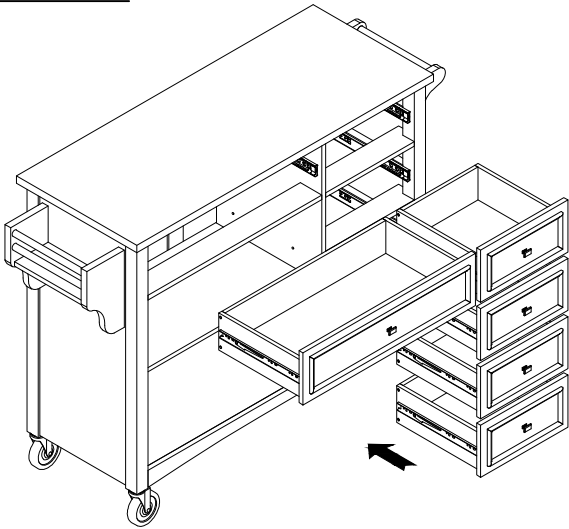
Diagram illustrating the assembly of a back panel (W) to the side panel (U) using screws (14). The back panel is also attached to the base frame (T) using screws (14).

Diagram illustrating the assembly of a back panel (V) to the base frame (T) using screws (2).

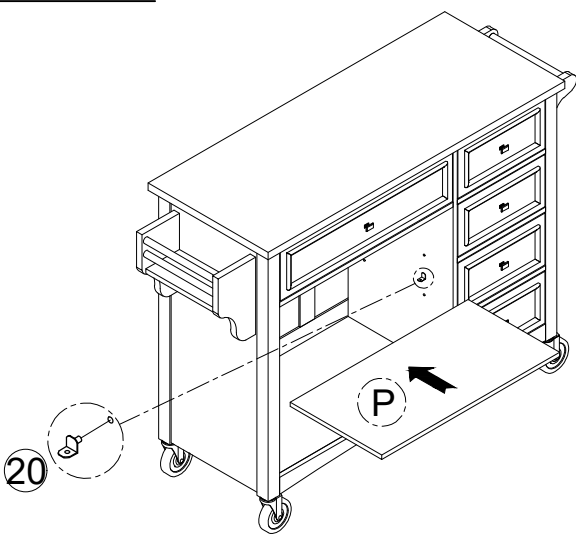

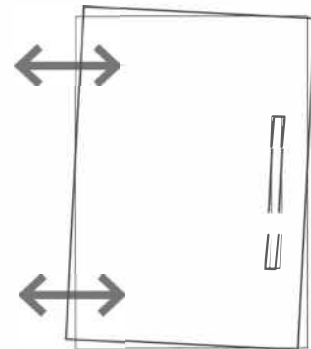


HINGE ADJUSTMENTS



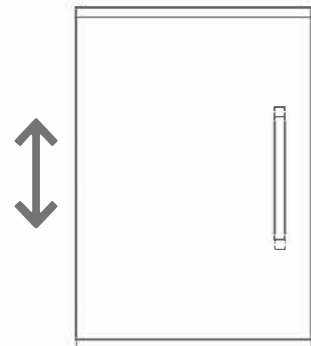
① Sideways / Tilt adjustment

Turn the screw
clockwise to move the door further away from
the side of the cabinet
anticlockwise to move the door closer to the
side of the cabinet



② ④ Height adjustment

While supporting the weight of the door, turn the
screws
clockwise to move the door up
anticlockwise to move the door down



③ Forward and back adjustment

If the gap between the back of the door and the
cabinet is too small, and the door may not close
fully. Turn the screw
clockwise to decrease the gap between the
door and the cabinet
anticlockwise to increase the gap between the
door and the cabinet
