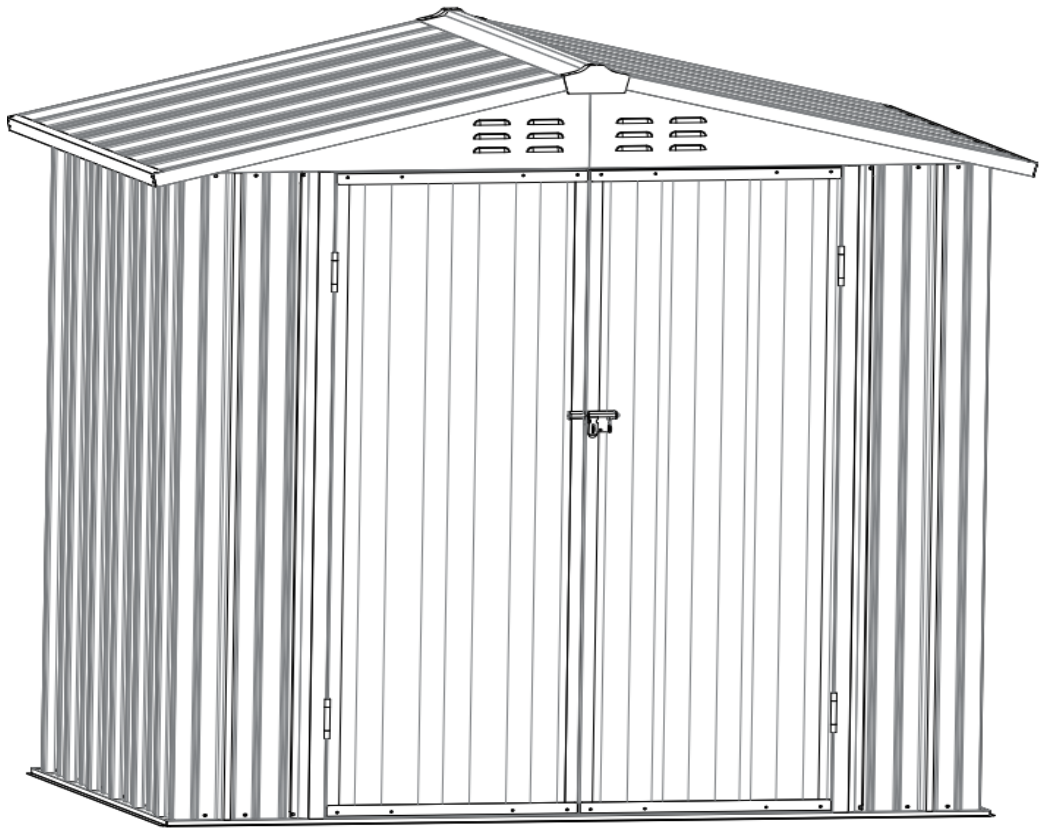

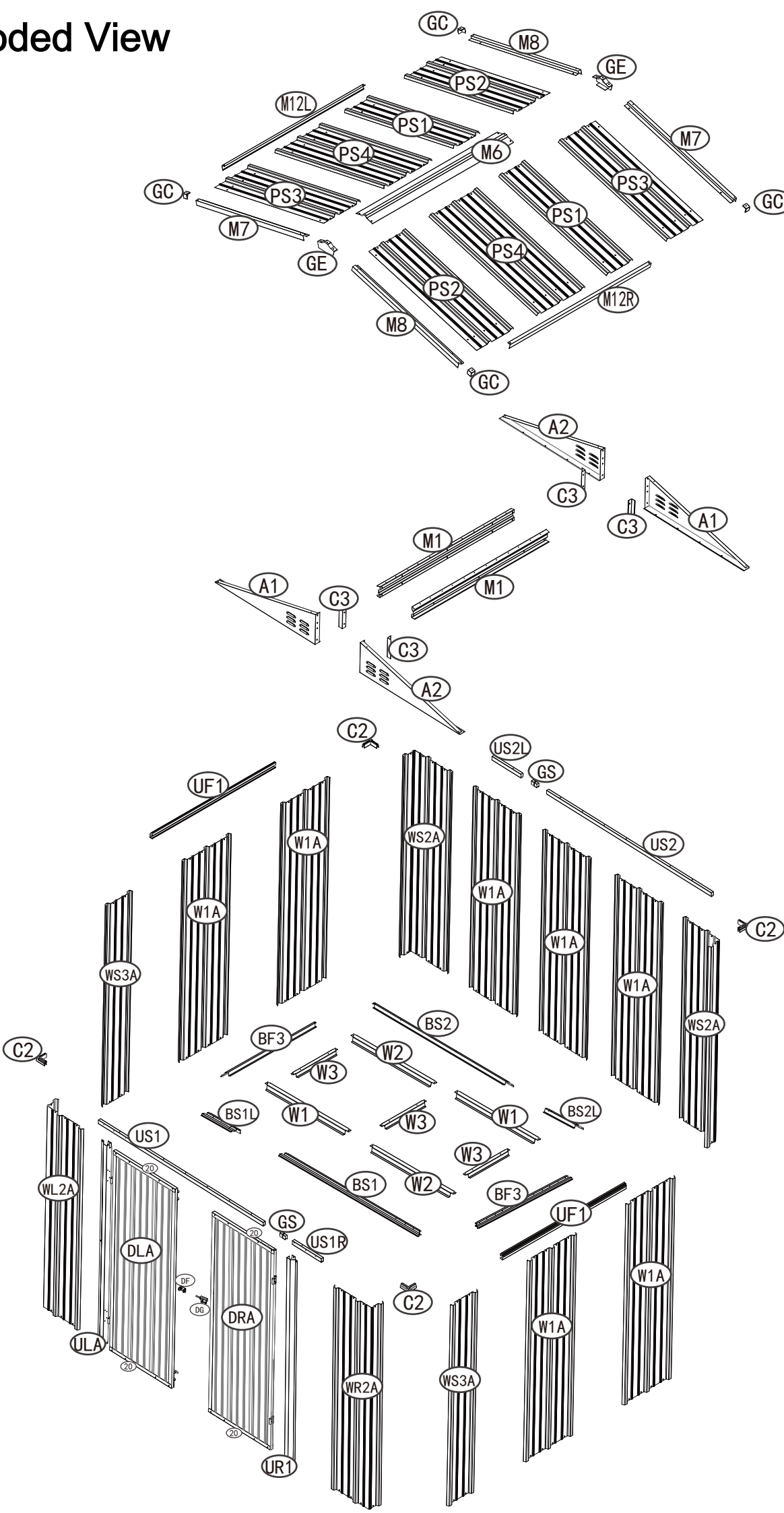

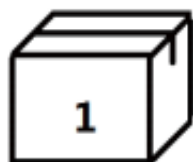

Exploded View



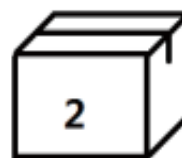

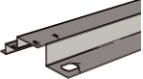
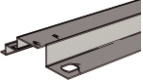
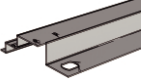
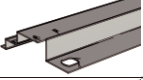
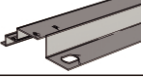
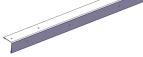
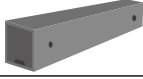
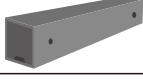
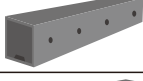
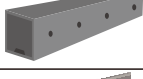


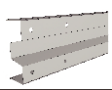
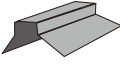
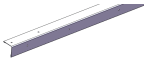
WARNING

- Remove all parts from the 2 boxes and sort them by number. Ensure all parts are present before assembly.
- Wear work gloves, long sleeves and safety goggles during assembly. Some components contain sharp edges that may cause damage.
- Set your drill's torque limit to prevent damage to the metal parts.
- Ensure ground stability is adequate when necessary to use a ladder. Never rest your entire weight on the roof or on any other part of the storage shed.
- Do not attempt to assemble the storage shed in strong windy conditions.
- Keep children and animals away from the assembly site.

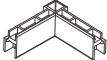

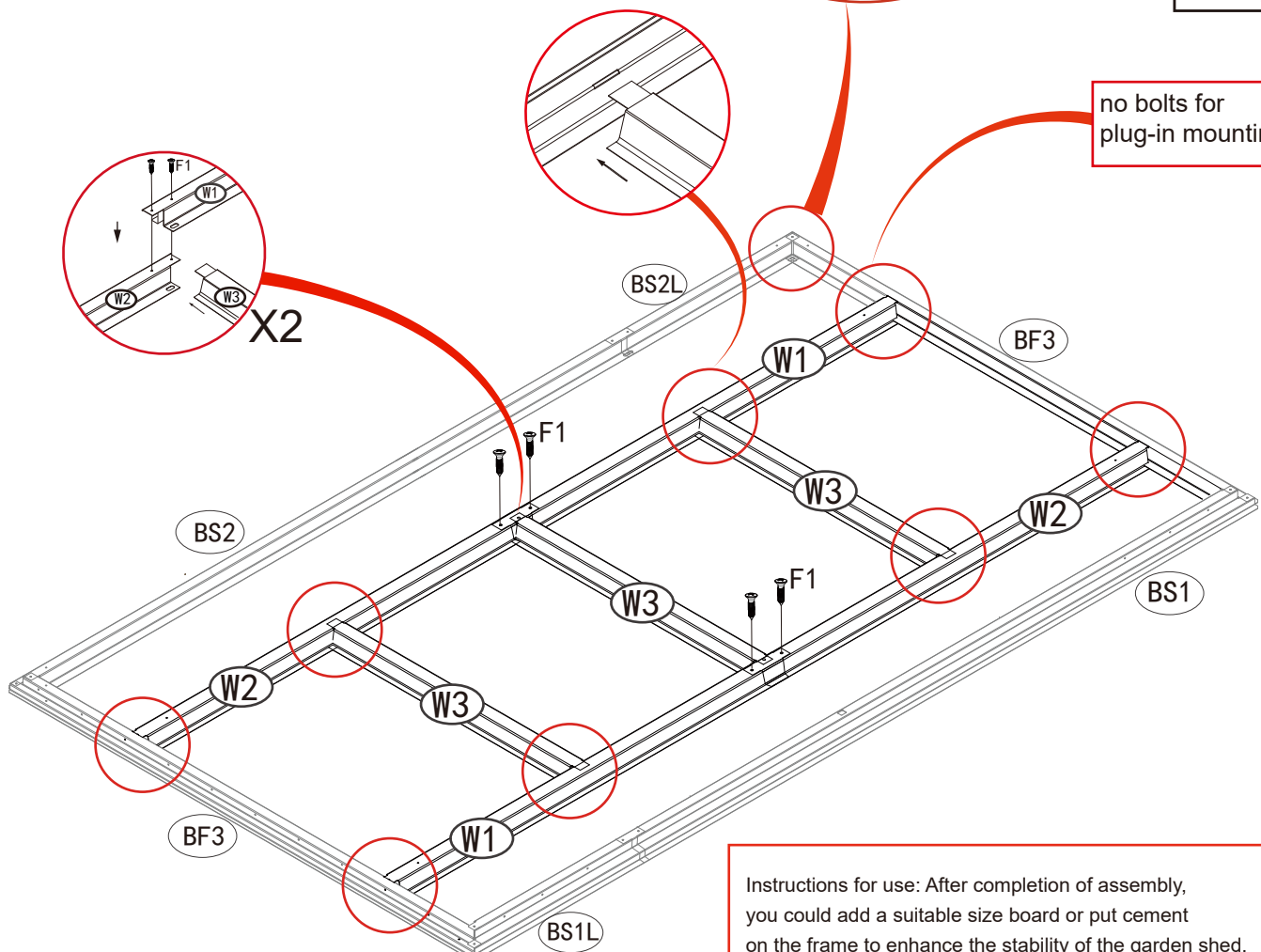
Side panels and roof are hidden for better visibility.
