ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT: READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE ATTEMPTING TO ASSEMBLE OR USE YOUR LYNX 3 DRAWER DRESSING TABLE.

PLEASE KEEP THESE INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE REFERENCE.

ASSEMBLY:

Assembly should be carried out with this item laying flat, not standing upright.

Assemble on a soft, clean surface to prevent damages.

To erase the numbers printed on the pieces, use the rubber into the accessories pack.

HEALTH & SAFETY:

DO NOT use this dressing table if any parts are missing, damaged or worn.

DO NOT use this dressing table unless all fixings are secured.

Always use on a level, even surface.

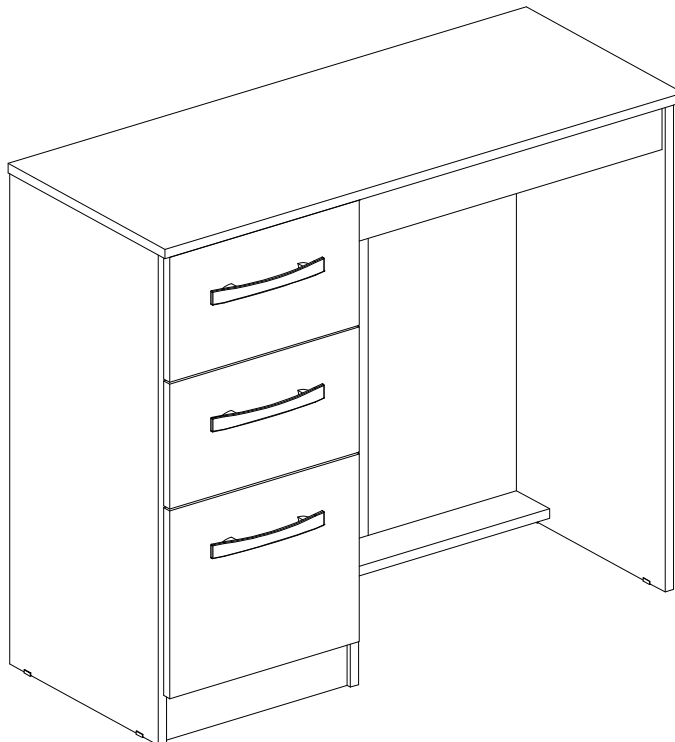
CARE & MAINTENANCE:

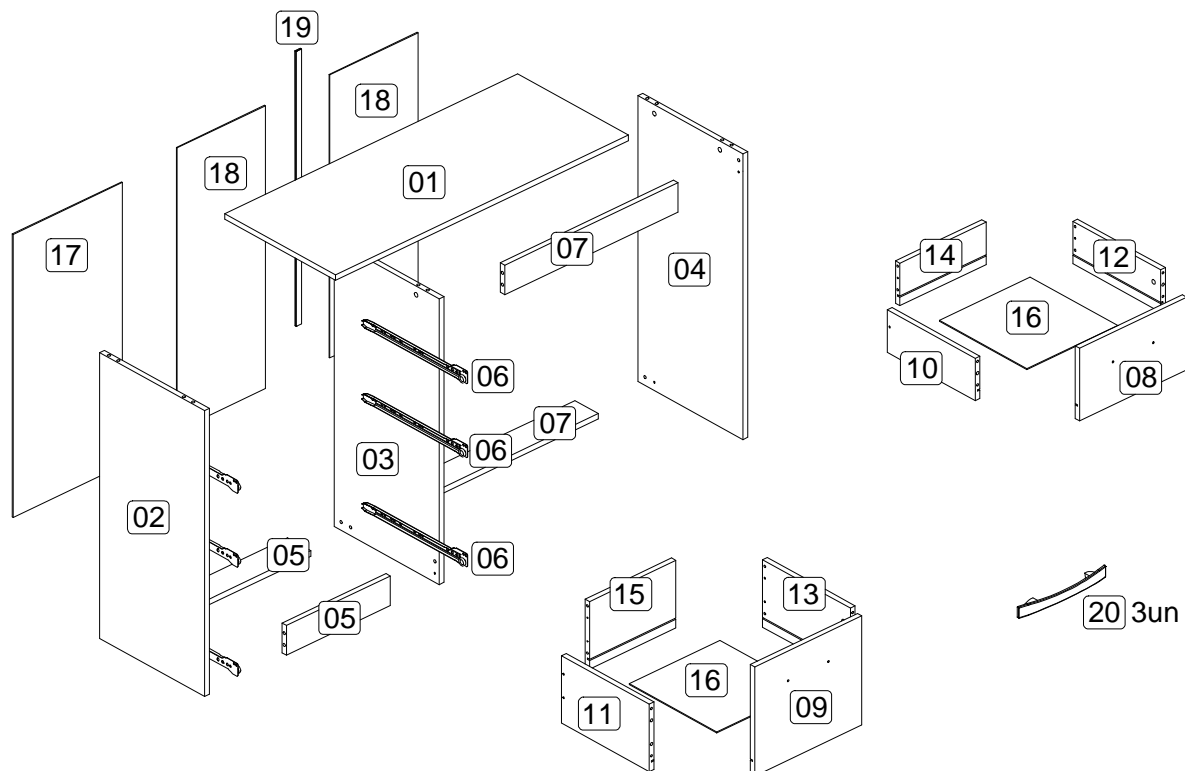
Periodically check all screws & fixings to ensure they are secure.

















DO NOT push the dressing table as this will damage base.

Always lift the dressing table with two people to reposition.

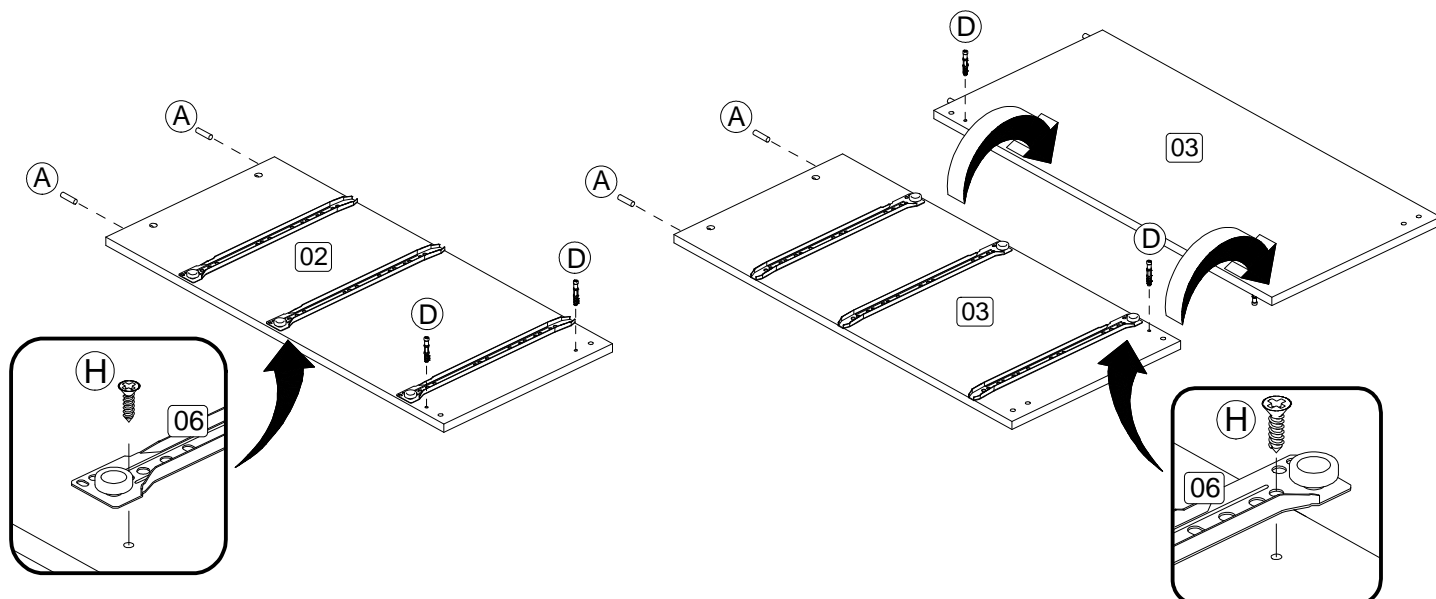
Keep any sharp objects away from the dressing table.





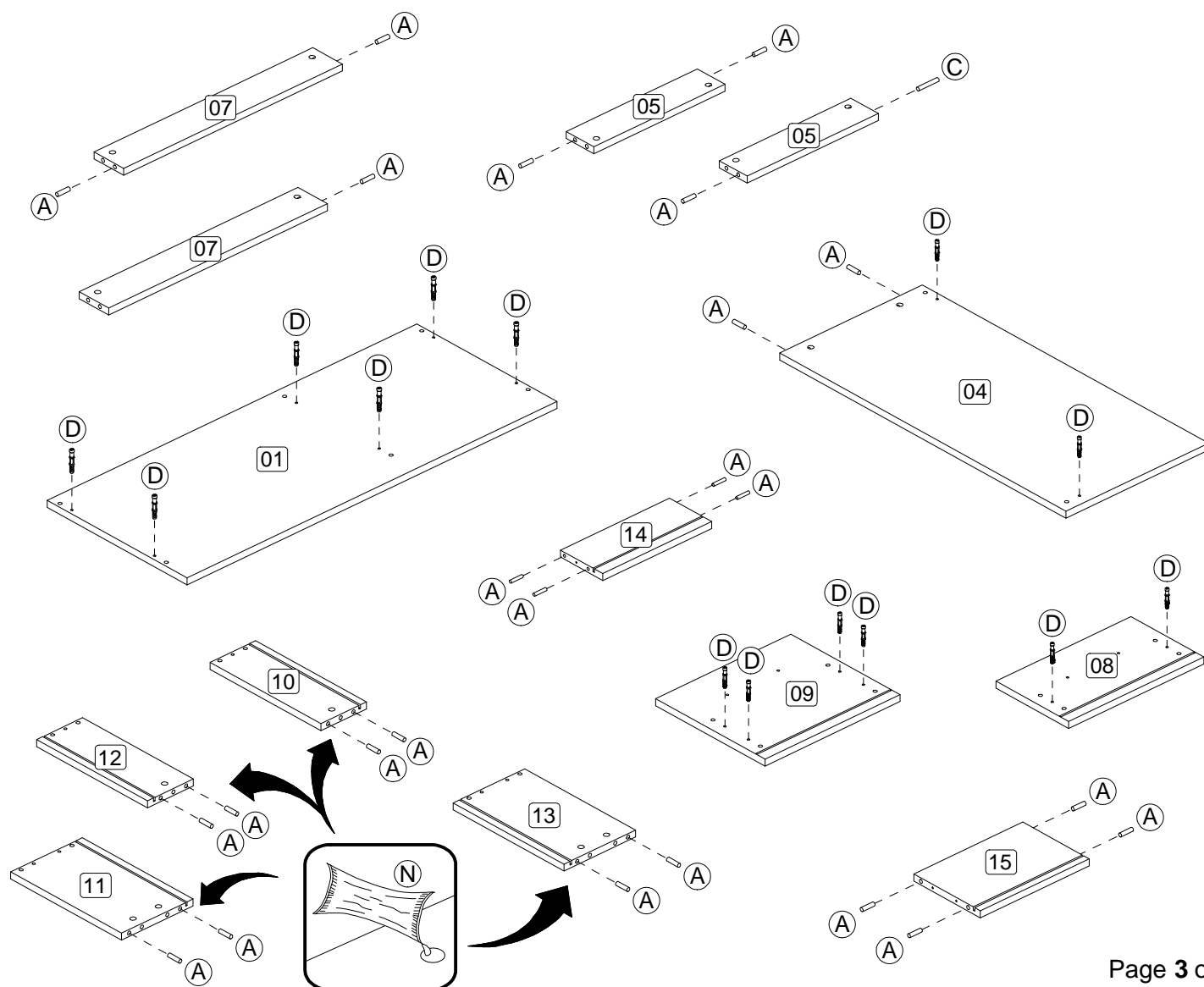

Step 1: Attach the drawer runners (6) to the left panel (2) and inside of the centre panel (3) using hardware part H. Insert hardware parts A and D into each panel using a small mallet and screwdriver (not provided). **DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.**

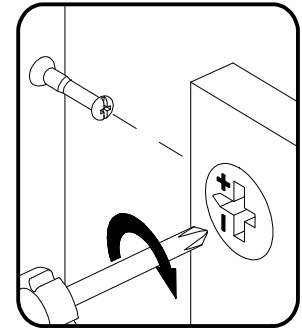
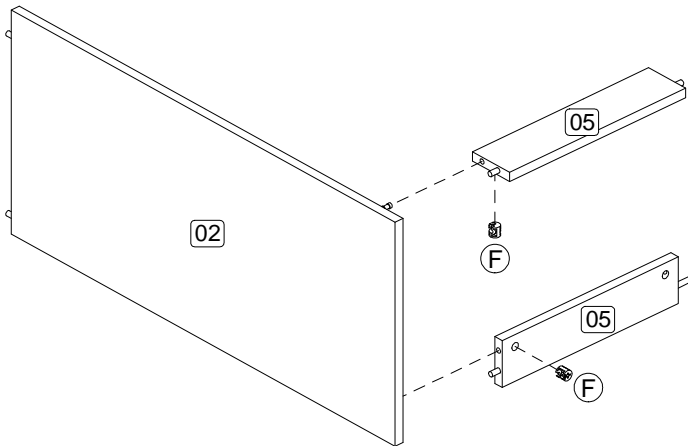


Step 2: Insert hardware parts A, C and D as shown using hardware part N, a small mallet and a screwdriver (not provided).

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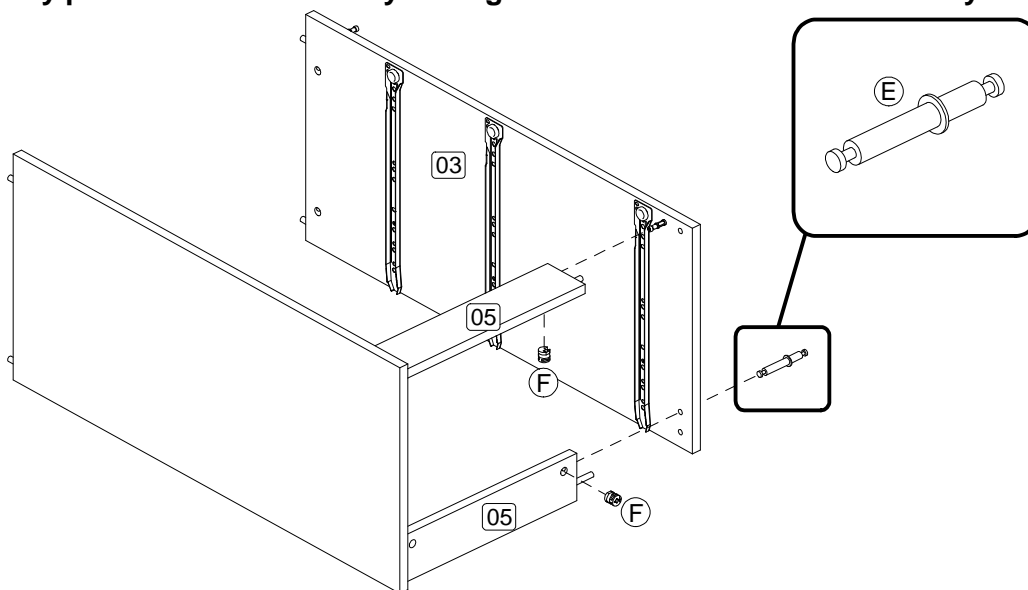


Step 3: Attach the plinths (5) to the left panel (2) using hardware parts D and F with a screwdriver (not provided).
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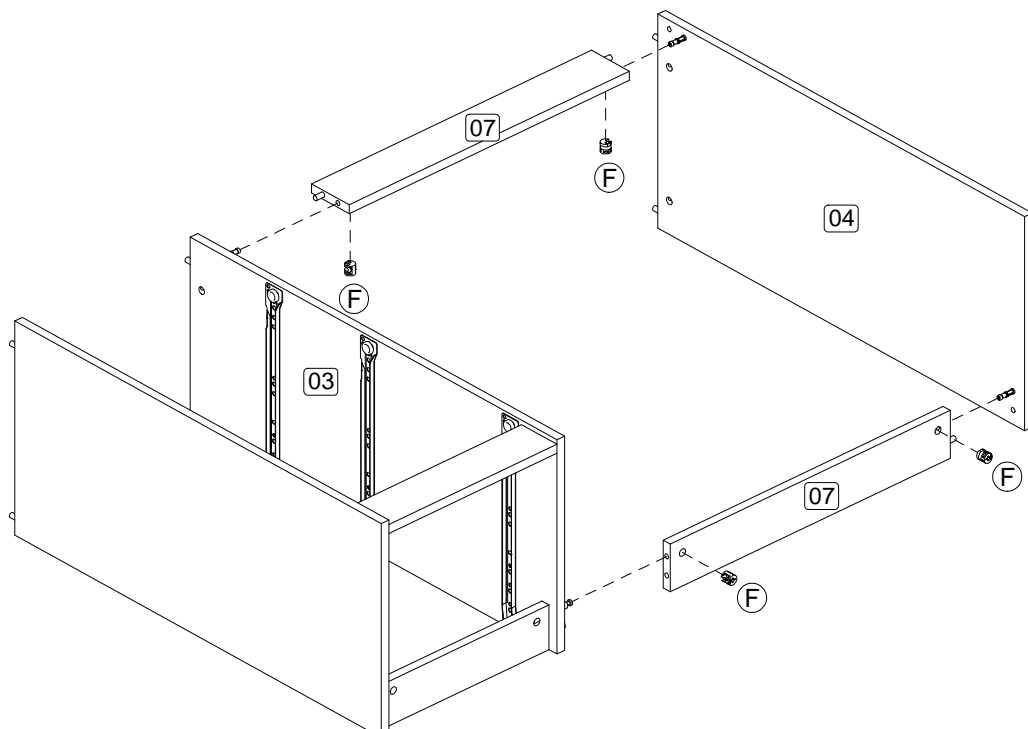
Step 4: Attach the centre panel (3) to the plinths (5) using hardware parts E and F with a screwdriver (not provided).

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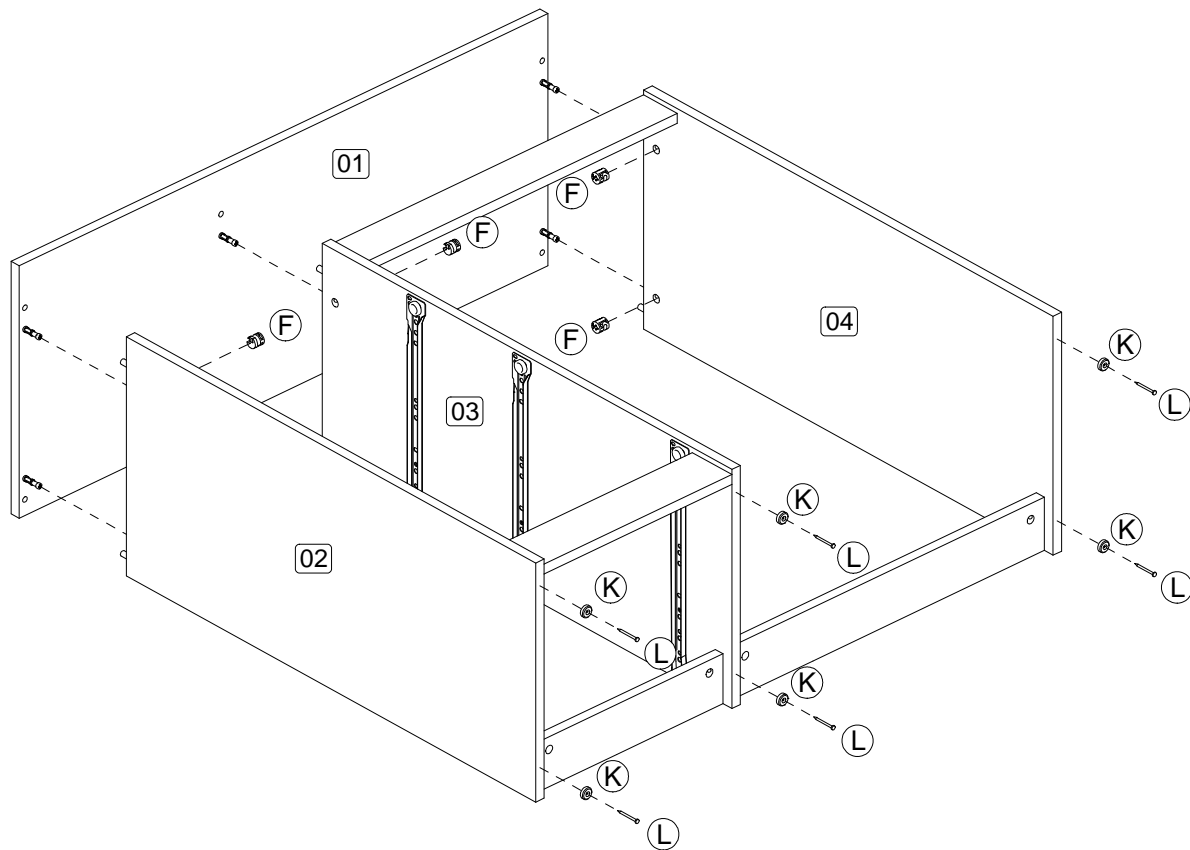
Step 5: Attach the supports (7) to the centre panel (3) then attach the right panel (4) using hardware part F and a screwdriver (not provided).

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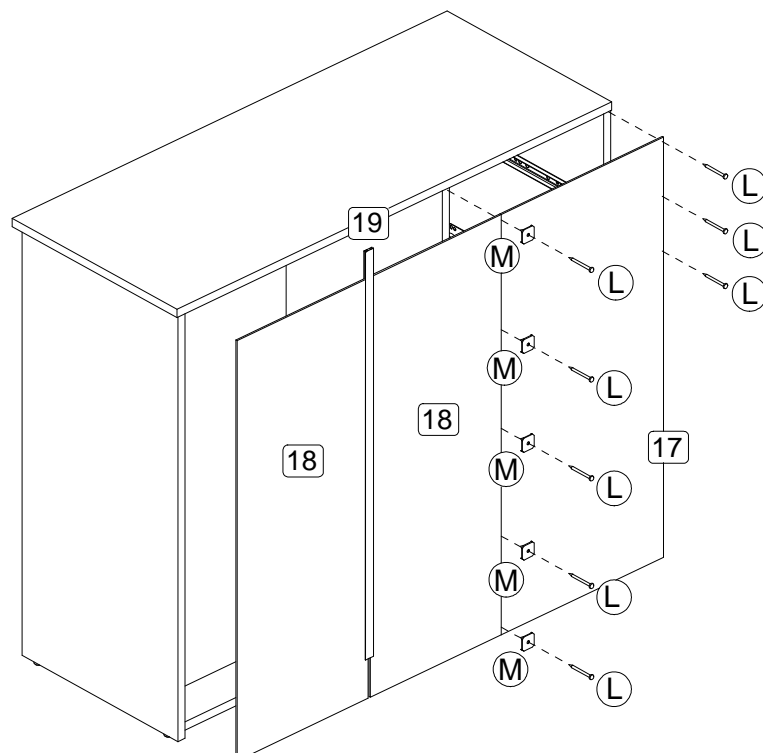
Step 6: Attach the top panel (1) using hardware part F, then attach hardware part K to the base using hardware part L. You will need to use a screwdriver (not provided).

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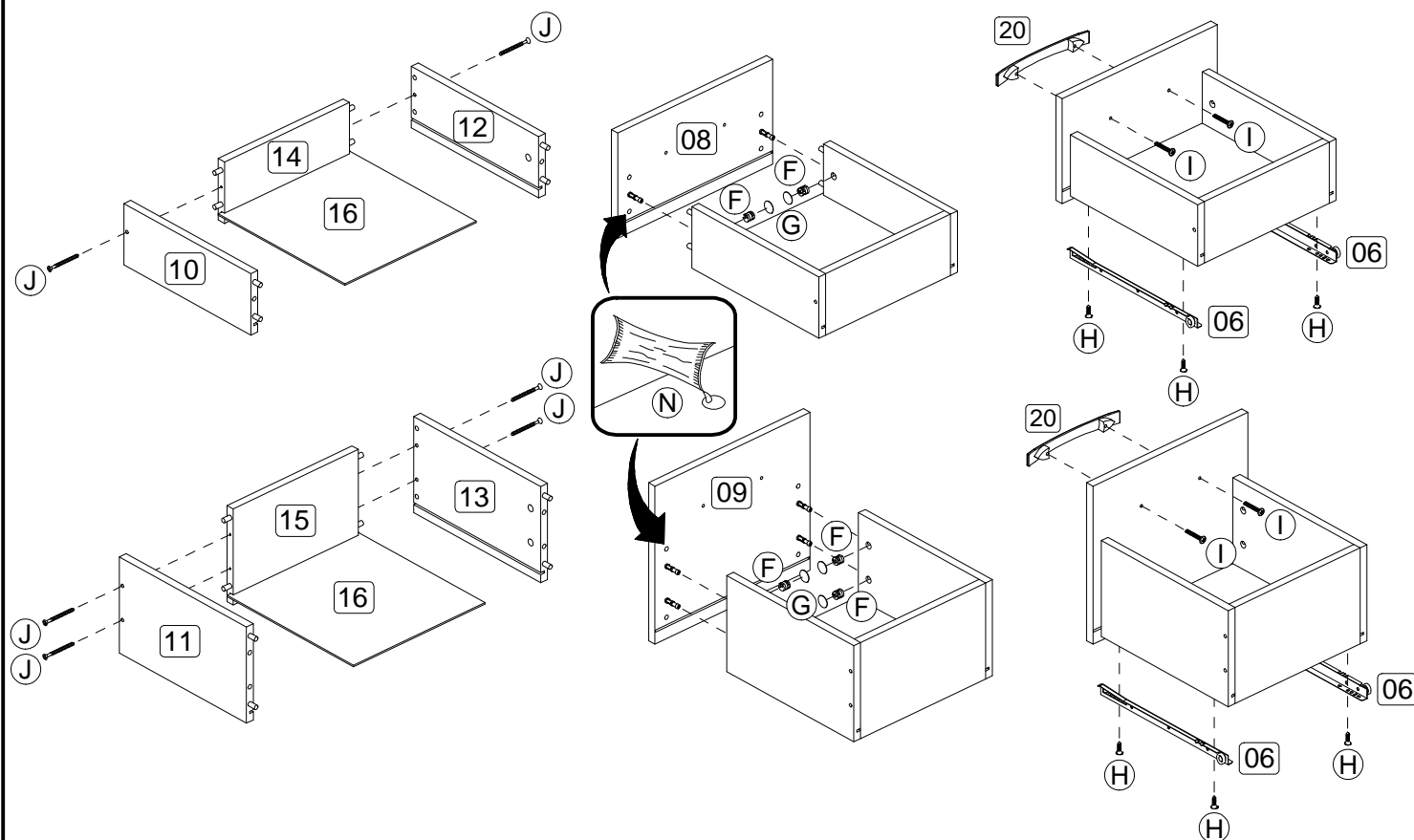
Step 7: Secure the back panel (17) using hardware part L, then connect the remaining back panels (18) using the spine (19) and secure using hardware parts L and M. You will need to use a screwdriver (not provided).

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Step 8: Assemble the drawer components using hardware parts F, G, H, I, J and N. You will need to use a screwdriver (not provided).

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Step 9: To secure the item to the wall use hardware parts O, P and Q using a screwdriver (not provided). Then attach hardware part H to the item with a screwdriver (not provided).
