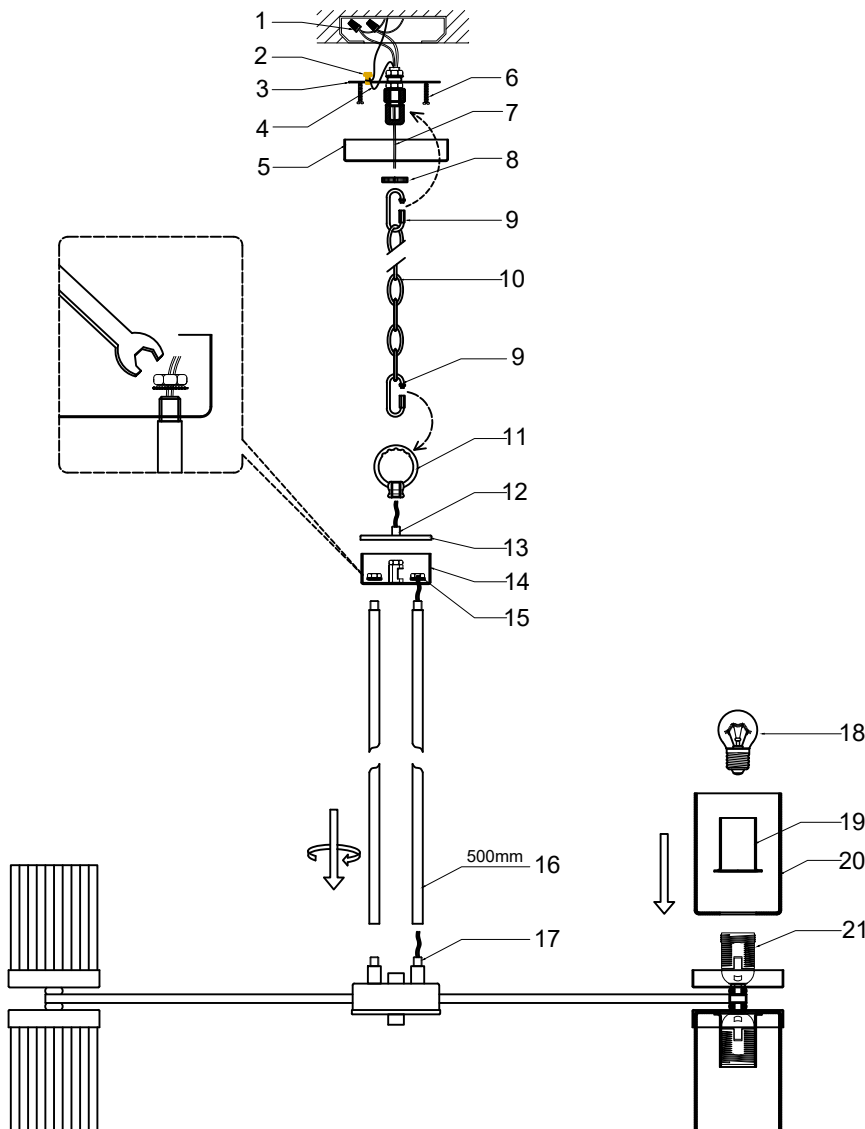


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

Step A: Secure the straight tubes (16) onto the threaded pipes (17) and tighten.

Step B: Loosen the suspension ring (11) by turning counterclockwise.

Step C: Secure the straight tube (16) to the fixture (14) using the nut (15).

Step D: Close the flat cover (13) and tighten the suspension ring (11) by turning clockwise.

Step E: Thread the main wire (7) and ground wire (4) through the suspension chain (10) and canopy (5).

Step F: Adjust the height of the suspension chain (10) as needed.

Step G: Secure the mounting plate (3) to the junction box using the junction screw (6).

Step H: Thread the main wire (7) and ground wire (4) through the threaded pipe of the mounting plate (3). Connect the upper and lower suspension rings using the swivel connector (9).

Step 1:

- Connect the positive main wire (marked text) to the positive power supply wire (+) using a wire connector (1).
- Similarly, connect the negative main wire (unmarked text) to the negative power supply wire (-) using a wire connector (1).

Notice: Ensure no bare wire is exposed to prevent electrical leakage.

- Secure the lamp body ground wire (4) and external ground wire to the mounting plate (3) using the green grounding screw (2).

Step J: Lift the large - hole canopy cover (5) to the ceiling and secure it using the crystal suspension ring (8).

Step K: Secure the lamp shade (20) to the socket (21) using the lamp head lock ring (19).

Step L: Screw the bulb (18) (not included) into the socket as indicated.

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
