



You may use a power screwdriver for easier assembly.



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


STEP 1


Lay WOOD TOP FRAME (A) on a clean surface to prevent scratching the top surface. Take LEFT HANDLE LEG (C) and orient it in proper position by aligning hole for mounting handle along long edge of WOOD TOP FRAME (A)

Place LEG SCREW (H) through hole in WOOD TOP FRAME (A) and tighten it with SCREWDRIVER (J) to top nut in LEFT HANDLE LEG (C).

Repeat for RIGHT HANDLE LEG (D).

Note: LEFT & RIGHT HANDLE LEG (C & D) have FOOT PAD on bottom.







ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


STEP 3

Lay kitchen cart on its side so it is leaning on side of WOOD TOP FRAME (A) and RIGHT HANDLE LEG (D). Orient SHELF (B) so flat surface faces WOOD TOP FRAME (A) and raised edge of 2 shelves are on same side. Place LEG SCREW (H) through hole in SHELF (B) and tighten it with SCREWDRIVER (J) to nut in RIGHT HANDLE LEG (D).

Repeat for LEFT HANDLE LEG (C) and for 2nd shelf.










STEP 4

Place LEG SCREW (H) through hole in WOOD TOP FRAME (A) or SHELF (B) and tighten it with SCREWDRIVER (J) to nut in CASTER LEG (E).

Repeat until all 6 LEG SCREWS (H) have been installed.








ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 5

Flip cart over and lay WOOD TOP FRAME (A) top surface on a clean surface again. Screw CASTER (G) into nut of CASTER LEG (E) bottom. Tighten CASTER (G) with WRENCH (K).

<u>Use provided caster wrench to tighten</u> <u>completely. Failure to do as instructed</u> <u>could result in caster stem breaking.</u>



STEP 6


Carefully flip completed cart right side up.

WARNINGS

- **2. Use the provided caster wrench to tighten completely.** Failure to do as instructed could result in the caster stem breaking thereby causing the kitchen cart to collapse.
- 3. The warnings, cautions, and instructions discussed in this manual cannot cover all possible conditions or situations that may occur. The user must always be aware of their environment and ensure that they use the product in a safe and responsible manner.
- **4. Do NOT modify the product in any way.** Unauthorized modification may impair the function and/or safety of the product, and may affect the life of the product. Any modifications will void product warranty.
- **5.** Check for damaged parts. Before using this product, carefully check that all parts are in good condition, and that the product will operate properly and perform its intended function. Check for damaged parts and any other conditions that may affect the operation of this product. Replace damaged or worn parts, and never use this product with a damaged part.
- 6. Do NOT overload the product.

- Do NOT allow children to climb or play around the product. Tipping may occur causing injury.
- **8.** Do NOT stand or lean on the product or use any part of this product as a step ladder. Tipping may occur causing injury.
- 9. Do NOT roll the product on an uneven surface. Only move the product on a smooth surface. Rolling over rough or uneven surfaces may cause casters to break or items on the product to fall, resulting in injury and / or damage. Wood and laminate flooring can be scratched or dented. Ensure your flooring can bear the weight of loaded product before rolling loaded product across your flooring.
- **10. Do NOT move a loaded cart.** Tilting of cart is needed to move it and items may fall causing damage or injury.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Avoid harsh, abrasive cleaners, and other corrosive chemicals.
- Clean up any spills immediately to prevent stains from forming on the wood surface.
- Do not put hot items directly on wood top or shelves to prevent damaging and discoloring wood surface.
- Wipe dry and keep out of direct sunlight.
- The product is designed for indoor use.

1 YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY
