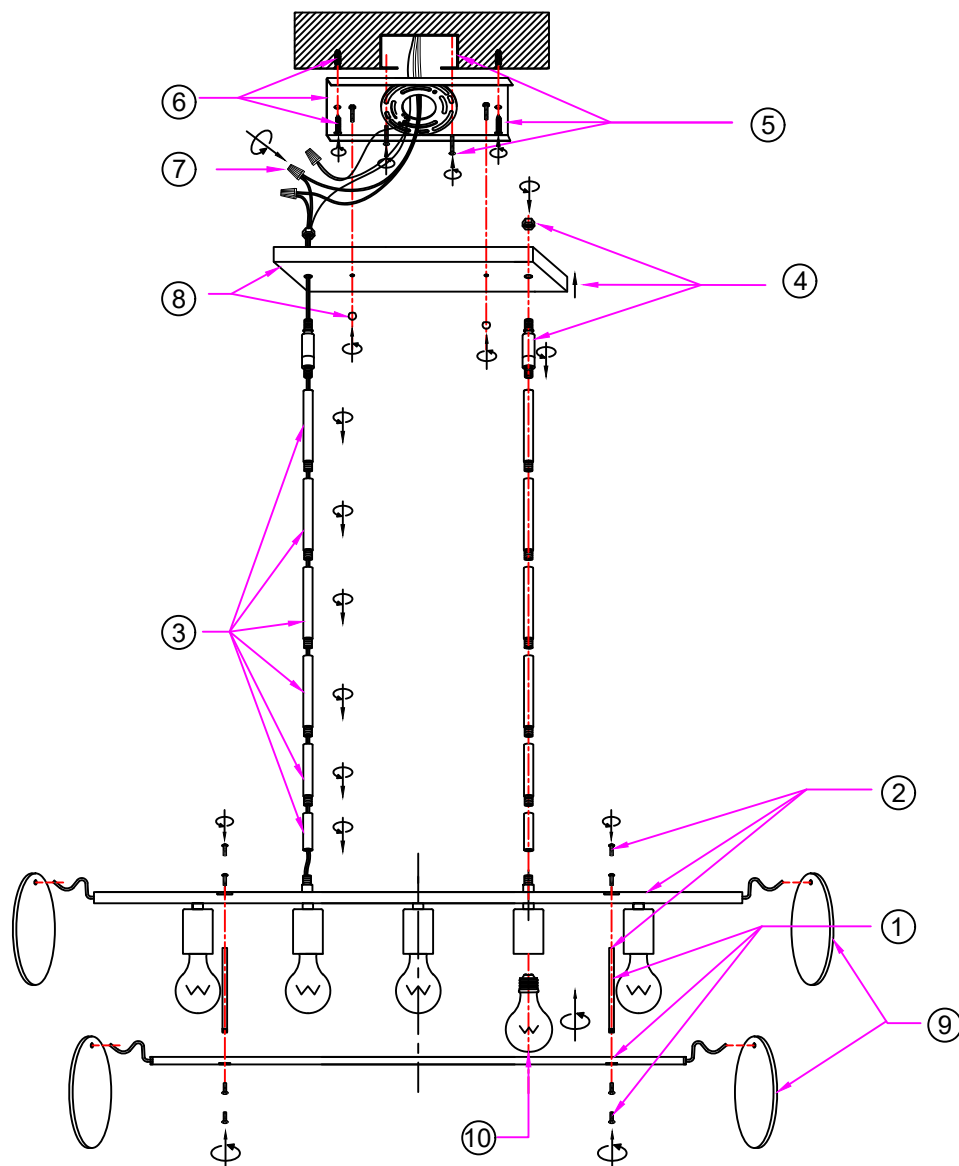


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

- Step 1: Align the four square rods with the holes on the lower small frame, and secure them with screws.
- Step 2: Align the holes on the upper large frame with the square rods and secure them with screws.
- Step 3: Thread the hanging rods onto the lamp body. Adjust the length as needed.
- Step 4: Attach two swivel connectors to the hanging rods, and then secure the canopy with lock nuts.
- Step 5: Secure the mounting plate to a UL-listed junction box using the provided screws.
- Step 6: Secure the mounting plate to the ceiling using the provided wood screws.
- Step 7: Connect the fixture wires to the supply wires using wire connectors.
- Note: Connect the black (hot) wire to the black wire, the white (neutral) wire to the white wire, and the ground wire to the grounding terminal.
- Ensure no exposed conductors remain outside wire connectors or outside the junction box.
- Step 8: Secure the canopy to the mounting plate in place using the provided locking collar.
- Step 9: Hang the glass panels onto the fixture frame.
- Step 10: Insert the bulbs into the lamp sockets. (Bulb Not Included)
- Step 11: Turn on the power and check if the bulbs are functioning properly.
- Installation is now complete.

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
