Special Notes for Wine or Beverage Refrigerator:

- 1. Plug the wine or beverage refrigerator into a grounded 3-prong outlet. Do not remove the grounding prong or use an adapter or extension cord

- 6. Upon arrival, please leave the unit upright and wait 24 hours before plugging it in

- 11. Ensure two or more people handle the moving and installation process to prevent injuries
- 12. Install the wine refrigerator in a well-ventilated area, away from heat sources, wind, rain, water spray, or drips, with temperatures between 60.8 ° F (16 ° C) and 89.6 ° F (32 ° C)
- 13. Follow state and local codes for electrical, water, and drain connections during installation
