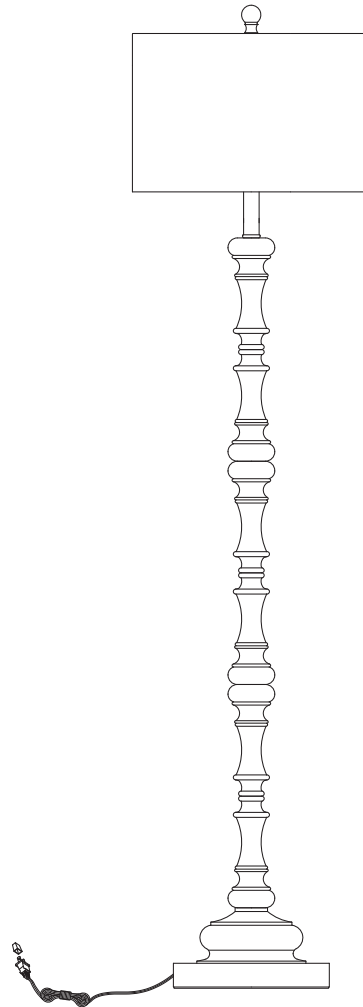


User Manual

Introduction

Product Features

1. Our product features a resin lamp pole and a linen lampshade, which give it a retro and traditional look suitable for all scenes;
2. Equipped with a 3-color temperature bulb(3000K, 4000K, 6000K), this lamp offers adjustable lighting options to suit your preference;
3. With a convenient rotary switch, you can easily switch the light;
4. Please avoid strong direct sunlight to preserve the color and shine of the lamp. Use a soft dry cloth or a slightly damp cloth to gently wipe the surface, and avoid using rough materials to prevent scratching the resin surface;
5. Please check whether the packing list is complete. If there are any missing or damaged accessories, contact us via email or through Customer Service for a replacement.

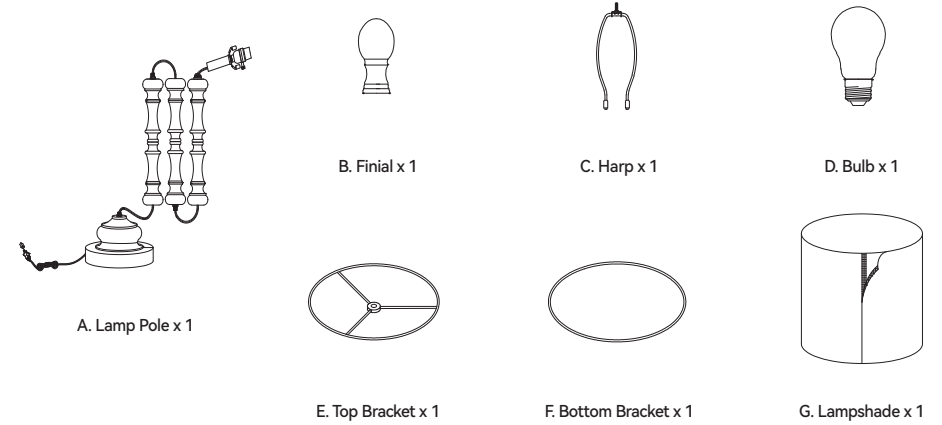
Cautions

Assembling

- ① Connect the lamp pole(B) to the base(A) first, then tighten the lamp pole(C.D) and lamp holder(E) successively.
- ② Fit the bottom of the harp(F) into the grooves on both sides of the lamp holder(E), then assemble the bulb(G) ;
- ③ Assemble the lampshade into the top/bottom brackets; then place it on the top of the harp(F) and fix it with the finial(I).
