Caution

- 1. BE SURE THE ELECTRICITY TO THE WIRES YOU ARE WORKING ON IS SHUT OFF; EITHER THE FUSE IS REMOVED OR THE CIRCUIT BREAKER IS TURNED OFF. TURNING THE POWER OFF USING THE LIGHT SWITCH IS NOT SUFFICIENT TO PREVENT ELECTRICAL SHOCK.
- 2. DO NOT INSTALL OR USE THE LIGHT FIXTURE IF ANY PART IS MISSING OR DAMAGED. CONTACT YOUR DEALER FOR REPLACEMENT OR MISSING PARTS.
- 3. SOME METAL PARTS IN THE LIGHT FIXTURE MAY HAVE SHARP EDGES, TO PREVENT CUTS OR SCRAPES, WEAR GLOVES BEFORE INSTALLATION.
- 4. TO PROTECT THE FINISH, WEAR GLOVES BEFORE INSTALLATION, DO NOT USE CLEANSERS OR ABRASIVES DURING MAINTENANCE.
- 5. TO AVOID POSSIBLE FIRE OR ELECTRICAL SHOCK, MAKE SURE NO BARE WIRE STRANDS ARE EXPOSED OUTSIDE WIRE CONNECTORS.
- 6. IF IN DOUBT ABOUT ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION, PLEASE CONSULT A LICENSED ELECTRICIAN.

Installation Steps

- A. Pull the wires out from the electrical box and mount the mounting plate using outlet box screws. Secure the mounting plate on the wall.
- B. Hold the fixture body. Connect the black supply wire to the black fixture wire using a wire nut. Connect the white supply wire to the white fixture wire using a wire nut. Re-attache the ground wire (green) to the mounting plate, secure the ground wire connection with a spacer and hexagon nut.
- C. Attach the fixture to the mounting plate and secure the fixture using 4 mounting screws.
- D. Enjoy the lighting fixture.
