
Outdoor Dining Table Manual



Product Description

Sturdy Structure: Made of high-quality materials and rigorously tested to ensure stability for long-term use.

Anti-slip Base: The exquisitely designed base increases friction, effectively prevents tilting or sliding, and ensures dining safety.

Wear-resistant surface: The specially treated surface is scratch-resistant and waterproof, easy to clean, and keeps the table beautiful as new

Easy to clean: The smooth surface makes cleaning easy, just wipe with a damp cloth to remove stains

Regular inspection/maintenance: Regularly check the joints of various parts of the table for wear and tear, and replace or repair as needed to ensure the safety and service life of the table.

Precautions

Flat ground: Make sure the table is placed on a flat, solid ground to avoid tilting or instability. Surrounding space: Leave enough space for people to walk around to avoid crowding around the table.

Even distribution: Make sure the tableware and food are evenly distributed on the table to avoid tilting due to excessive weight on one side.

Anti-skid mats: Use anti-skid mats or tablecloths to increase the stability of the tableware and prevent it from sliding.

Weight limit: Follow the weight limit provided by the manufacturer and do not place items on the table that exceed the recommended weight.

Proper distribution: Place heavy objects in a dispersed manner to avoid concentrating them in one place.

Regular inspection: Check the stability of the table regularly to ensure that all feet are in even contact with the ground.

Use of foot pads: If the ground is uneven, consider using adjustable foot pads to increase stability. Safety of sharp objects: Avoid placing sharp or unstable objects on the table to prevent accidental injuries.

Child safety: If there are children dining, ensure that they are safe at the table and avoid bumping into the corners of the table.

Away from fire: Make sure the table is kept a safe distance from flammable objects (such as candlesticks and barbecue equipment). Safety utensils: Use heat-resistant tableware and tablecloths to avoid damage caused by high temperatures.

Regular cleaning: Keep the table clean and remove food residues and liquids in time to avoid slipping or breeding bacteria.

Maintenance Matters

Light protection: Try to place the table in a place where it is not exposed to direct sunlight for a long time to prevent the material from fading and deformation.

Avoid scratches: Use a placemat or cutting board, and avoid cutting or placing hot pots directly on the tabletop to prevent scratches and burns.

Regular inspection: Check the joints of the table regularly to ensure that they are tight to avoid looseness and instability.


Adjust the foot pads: If you find that the table is tilted, check the foot pads and make necessary adjustments to ensure that they are stable.

Protective measures: When storing for a long time, you can cover the table with a dust cover to prevent dust accumulation

ASSEMBLY STEPS


- 1. Unpack the outdoor stainless steel dining table and make sure all parts are complete, including the tabletop, legs, connectors, and installation tools.
- 2. Lay the tabletop flat on the assembly site, make sure there is enough space to accommodate the entire table, and keep the surrounding environment clean.
- 3. Use a screwdriver or wrench to install the table legs to the reserved connection ports on the tabletop. Make sure the table legs are firmly connected to the tabletop to increase stability.
- 4. Follow the diagram in the instruction manual to install the connectors between the table legs and the tabletop, making sure all connectors are fastened in place.
- 5. After installation, check all parts to make sure they are installed correctly and not loose. Gently shake the table to confirm its stability. Re-tighten the screws or adjust the connections if necessary.




ASSEMBLY STEPS


Step 1: Screw the nut onto the pull rod, then place the gasket on the table frame and tighten it with a sleeve.




Step 2: Insert the foot tube. Note that there is a connecting piece in the foot tube, which needs to face upwards. After assembling the gasket and nut in sequence, tighten it with a sleeve and then knock on the foot pad.




Step 3: Unlock the switch at the bottom to pop out the iron core when you need to open it.




Step 4: Stretch the two sides of the table outward.




Step 5: Rotate the middle desktop 180° counterclockwise.




Step 6: Push both sides of the desktop inward, and then press the bottom switch upward to lock it.



Step 7: When you need to close it, unlock the switch at the bottom to eject the iron core.




Step 8: Rotate the middle desktop 180° clockwise.




Step 9: Rotate the middle desktop 180° clockwise.





Step 10: Stretch the sides of the table inward.





Step 11: Press the bottom switch up and lock it.

Guide to using outdoor stainless steel dining table

Choose a suitable location: Place the dining table in a flat, dry place, avoiding direct exposure to strong wind or rain.
