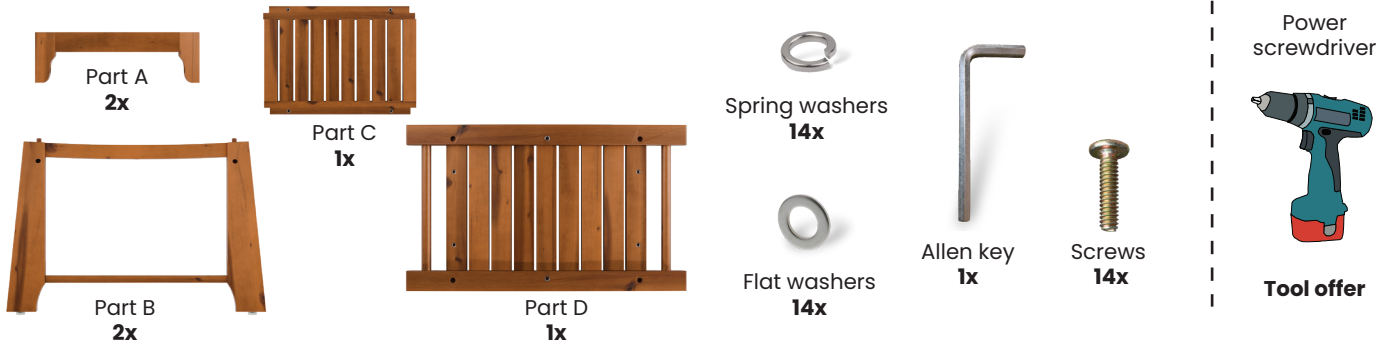


Rectangular Shower Bench

Assembly Instructions



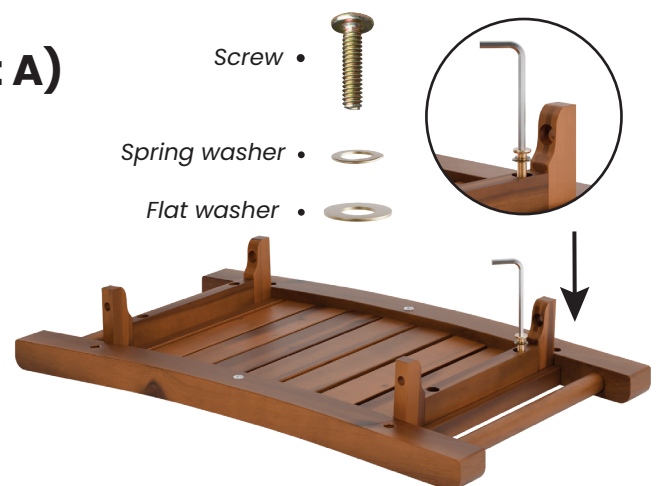
Note:

If you are using a **Power screwdriver**, set it to the lowest torque to avoid cracking the wood or stripping the threads.

Step 1: Install Support Bars (Part A)

Flip the seat panel (Part D) upside down and place it on a flat surface. Position both support bars (Part A) over the pre-drilled holes on the underside of Part D as shown. Insert the screws along with the spring and flat washers, then lightly tighten using the Allen key.

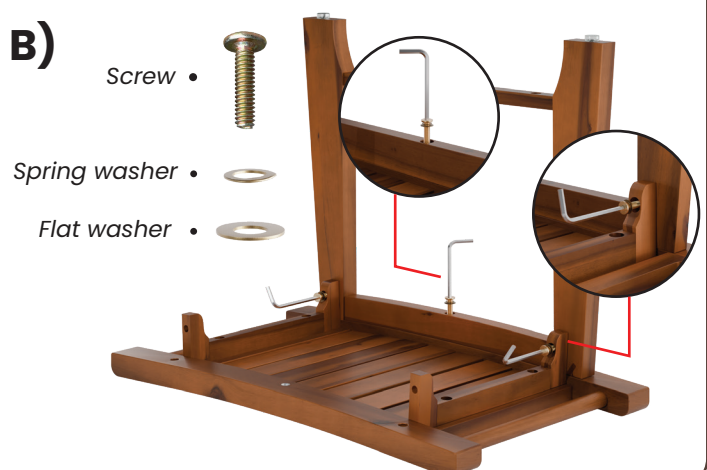
Do not fully tighten the screws at this stage.



Step 2: Attach Bench Legs (Part B)

Attach the bench legs (part B) to (part D), positioning them perpendicular as shown in the illustration. Secure the legs to the (part D) with screws. Continue securing (part B) to the bench legs (part D) at both points, and repeat the process for the remaining leg.

Do not fully tighten the screws at this stage.

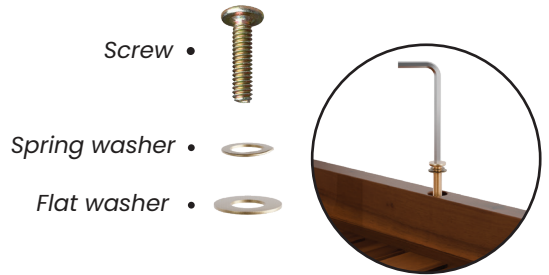


Rectangular Shower Bench

Step 3: Install the Bottom Shelf (Part C)

Insert the bottom shelf (Part C) by tilting the shelf slightly for easier alignment between the legs, ensuring the threaded holes face upwards, as shown in the illustration. Align the pre-drilled holes of (Part C) with (Part B). Tighten (Part C) to (Part B) using **four** screws, each with a spring washer and a flat washer.

Do not fully tighten the screws at this stage.



Step 4: Final Inspection & Safety Check

Verify that all screws are fully tightened. Inspect the entire shower bench to ensure all parts are fully secured and the bench stands evenly on a flat surface.

We recommend checking the tightness of the screws every month to ensure ongoing stability.
