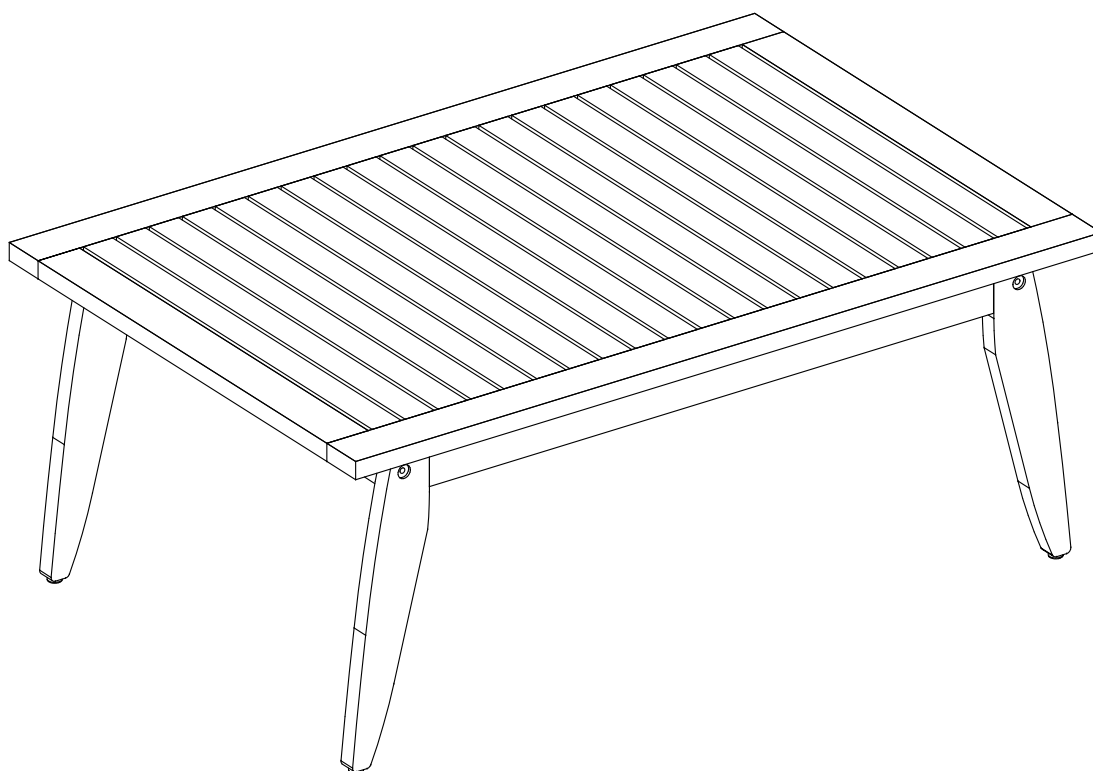

## Care & maintenance:

- ⊘  • Prolonged exposure to rain may cause rusting which can stain floors.

### Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface

### Step 2

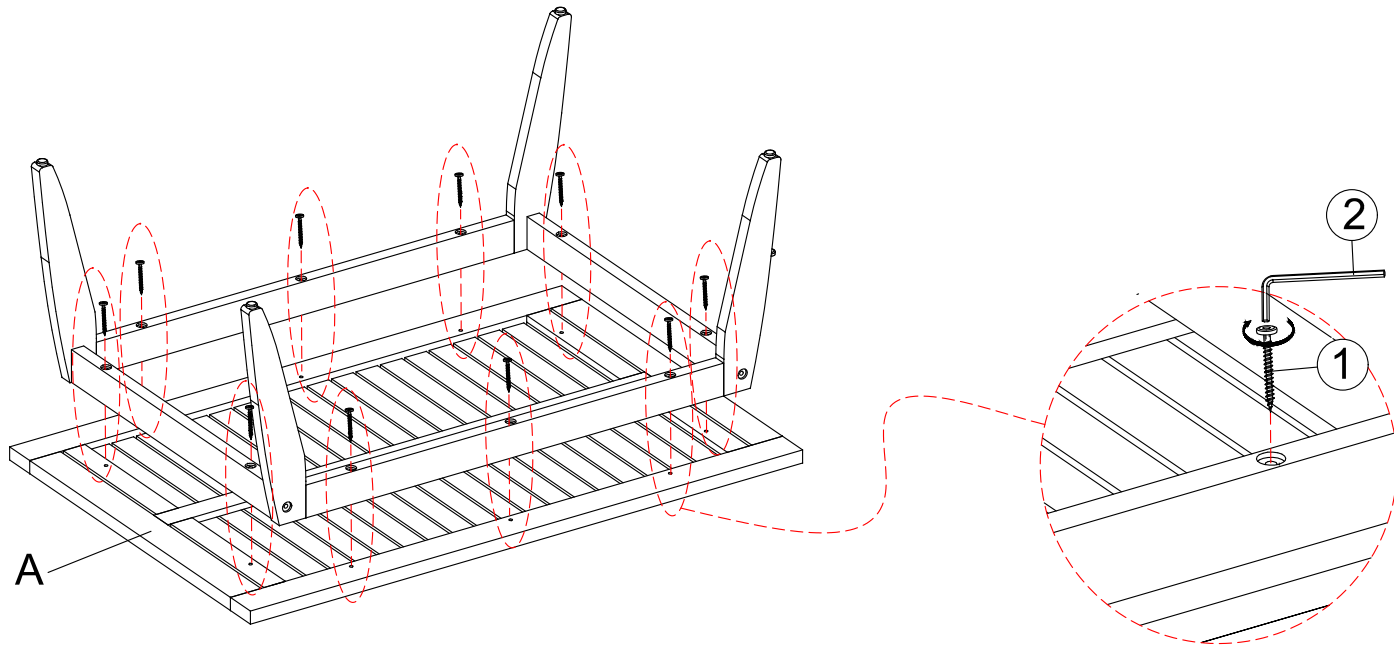


Place the Leg Panel (B) upright as shown in the picture above onto a clean, soft surface to avoid any scratches or damage to the product.

With assistance from your adult partner, attach the Leg Panel (B) to the Support Bar (C) by using 4pcs of Screws (①), and the Allen Wrench (②) as shown above.

**Do not fully tighten the Screws at this time.**

### Step 3

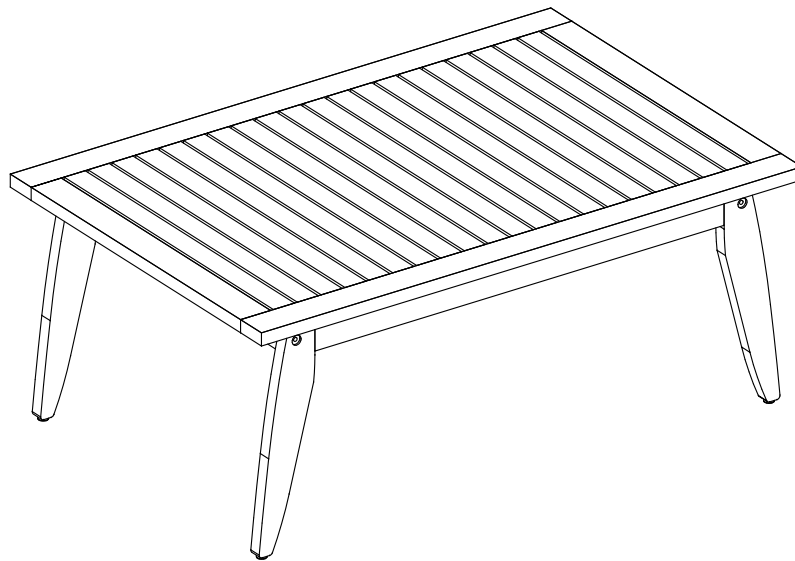


Place Table Top (A) face down as shown above.

With the help from your adult partner, place the assembled part in step 2 to Table Top(A) by using 10pcs of Screws (1) with Allen Wrench(2) as shown above.

**Do not fully tighten the Screws at this time.**

### Step 4



Turn the Table right side up

Place the Table on a flat, level surface to make sure it is balance.

Inspect the Table and make sure all parts are adequately connected. Then EXERT pressure, floorwards onto the Table with both hands. This pressure will help align all parts at all joints. Check for wobbles on a LEVEL surface.

If no wobbles are found proceed to tighten the Screws in a sequential manner, until evenly secured.

**CAUTION: When tightening these screws, tighten sequentially.**

**DO NOT tighten any screw fully and then towards the next one. This would cause the frame to warp.**

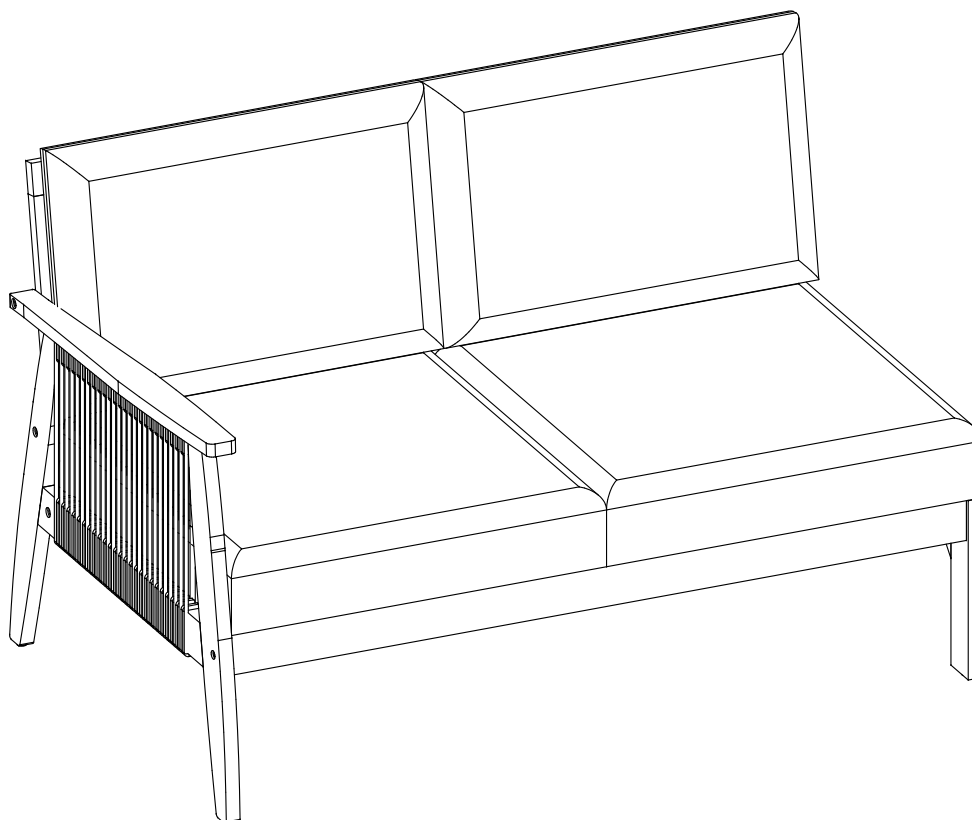

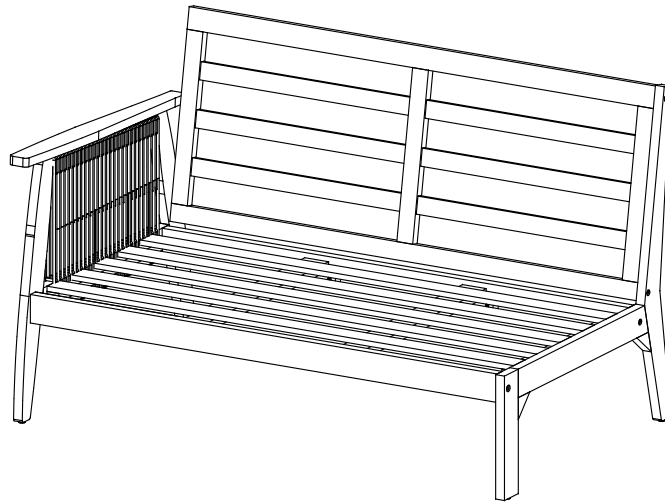


Step 5.1: Attach the Seat Panel (G) into the assembled parts in step 4 as shown above

Step 5.2: With assistance from your adult partner(s), flip it to one side and using 4pcs of Screws (1) & Screw Driver (not provided) (6) as shown above.

**Tighten fully all the Screws at this time.**

## Step 6



With the assistance from your adult partner, stand the Left Bench up. Inspect the Left Bench and make sure all parts are adequately connected. Then EXERT pressure, floorwards onto the Left Bench with both hands, carefully sit onto the Left Bench. This pressure will help align all parts at all joints. Check for wobbles on a LEVEL surface.

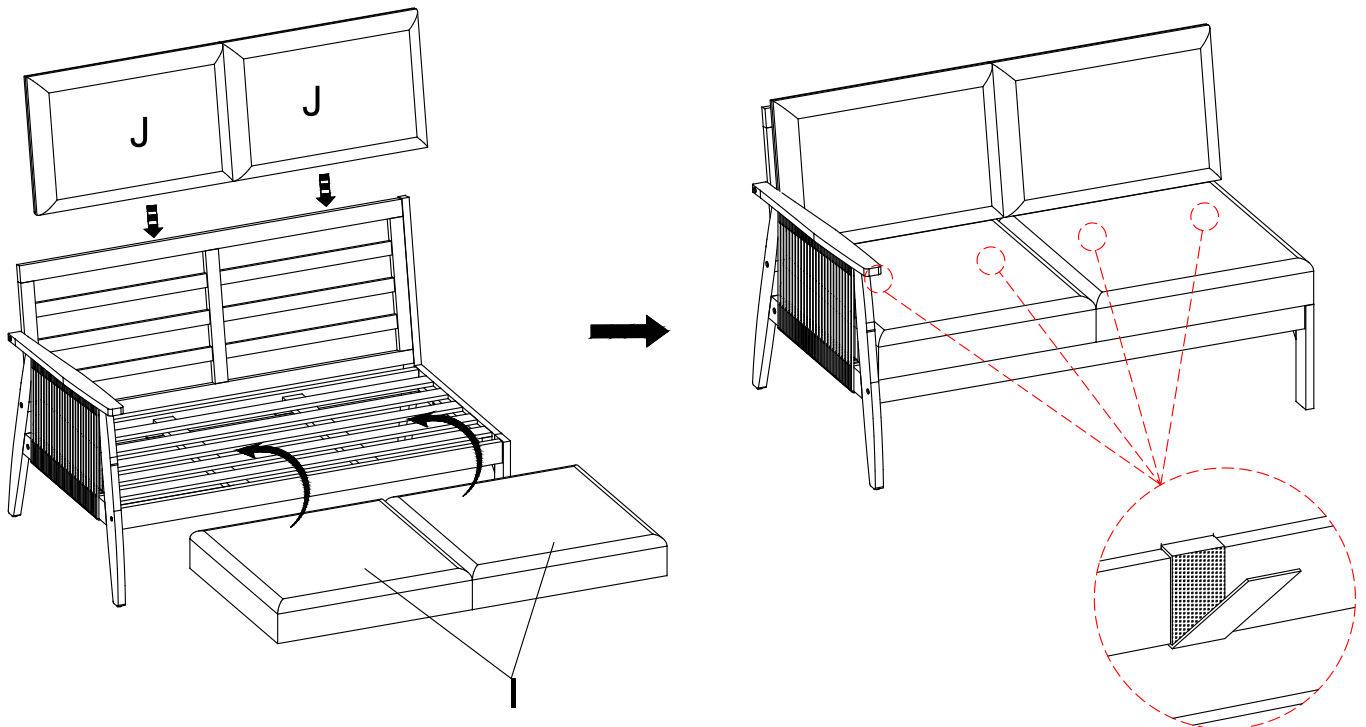

With assistance from your adult partner(s), attach the Right Backrest Panel (R) to the assembled parts in Step 5 by using 2pcs of Screws (1), 2pcs of Screws (2) and the Allen Wrench (6) as shown above. Inspect the Corner Chair and make sure all parts are adequately connected. Then EXERT pressure, floorwards onto the Corner Chair with both hands, carefully sit onto the Corner Chair. This pressure will help align all parts at all joints. Check for wobbles on a LEVEL surface.

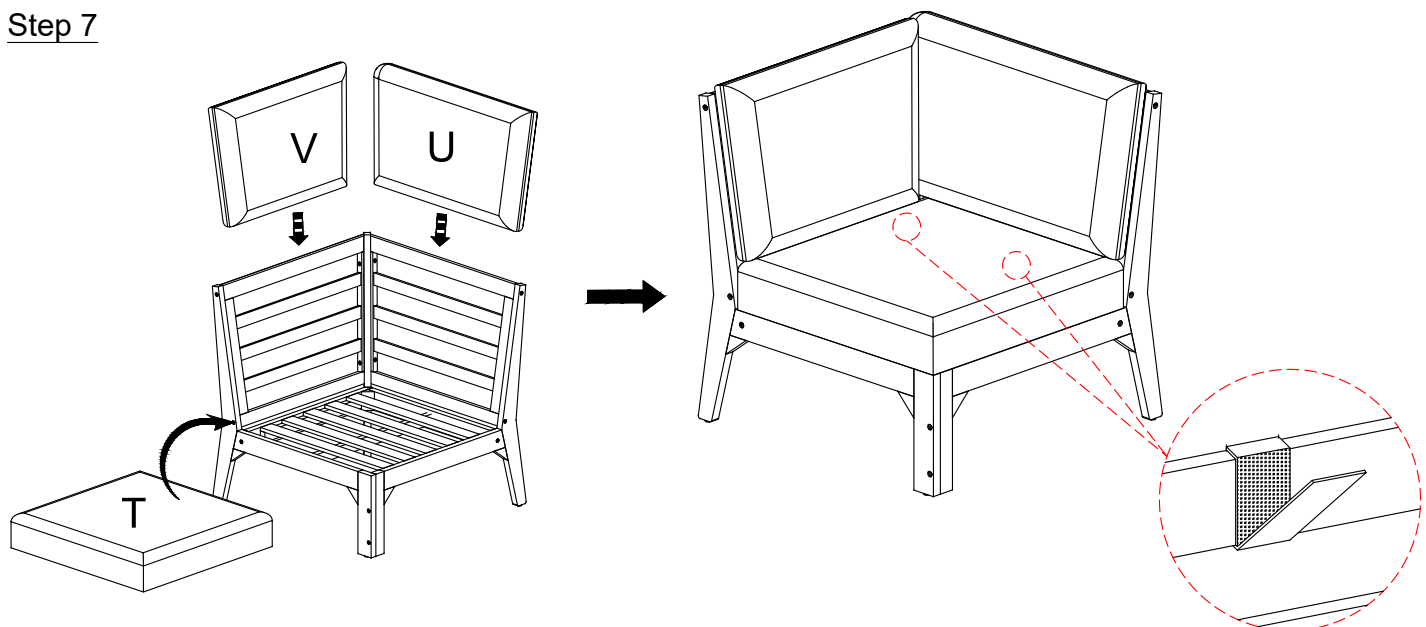

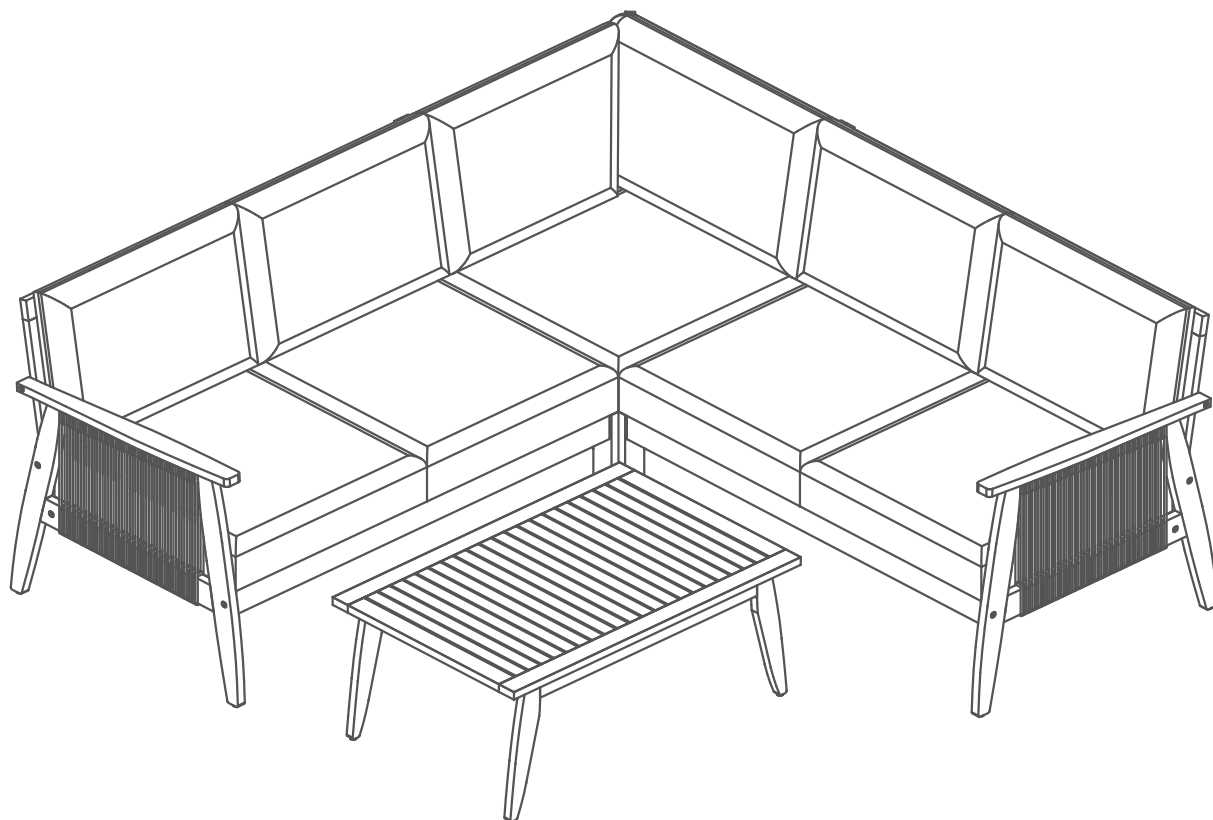

## Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed

chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
