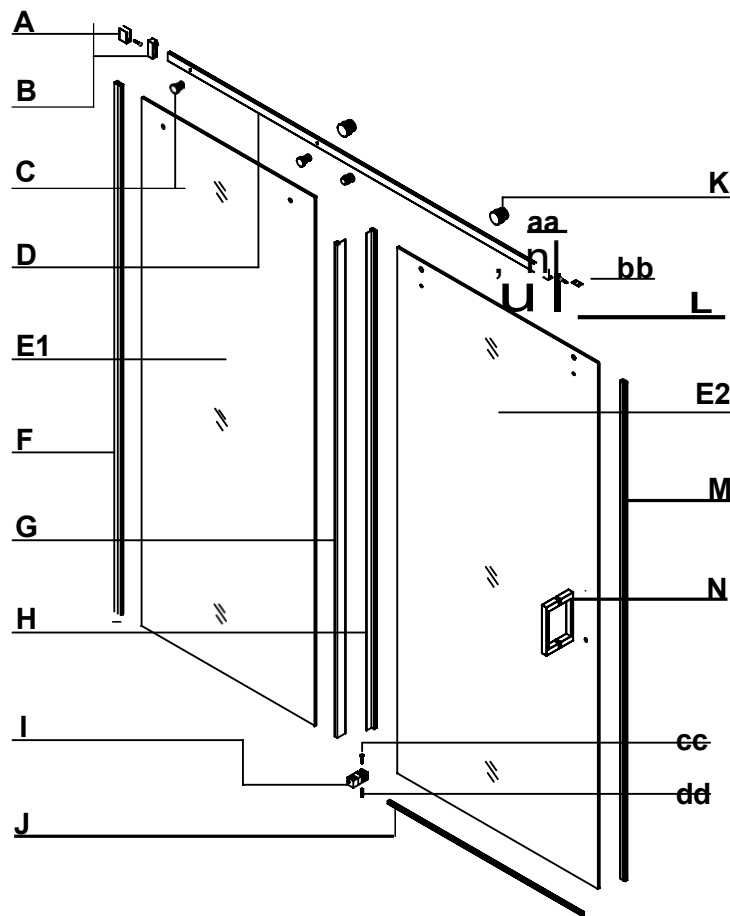


REQUIRED:

Verify that the threshold is level by using a straight edge or a level tool. Adjust the threshold as necessary to ensure it is perfectly horizontal

- Inspect the glass for damage before installation.
- Extreme caution should be taken while handling the glass during installation, as the tempered glass may shatter if it comes into contact with a hard surface.
- Do not cut or modify the tempered glass, as it will shatter if cut.
- Carefully remove the product from its packaging and keep the packaging until the installation is complete.
- Inspect all parts for damage or missing items. If there is any damage or missing parts prior to installation, please contact your seller for help.
- Cover the drain with tape to prevent the loss of small parts.
- The shower base and finished walls should be installed before beginning the shower door installation.
- During installation, protect the shower floor with a drop cloth to prevent damage.
- This product should be installed by two people who are familiar with construction requirements. Professional installation is recommended!
- Keep this installation manual for future reference.

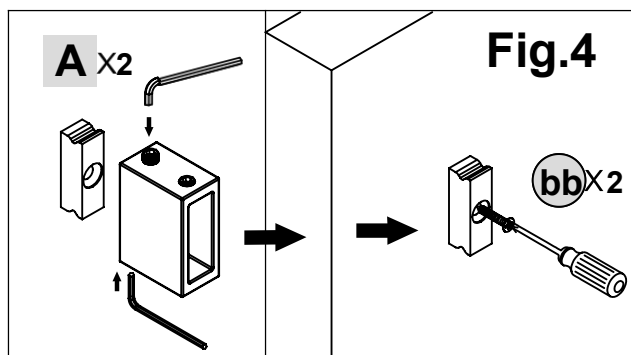
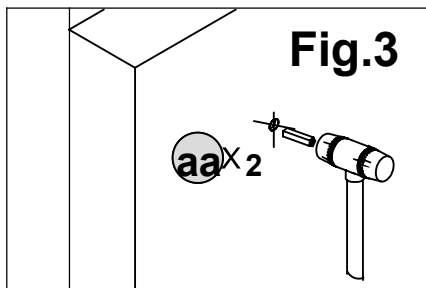
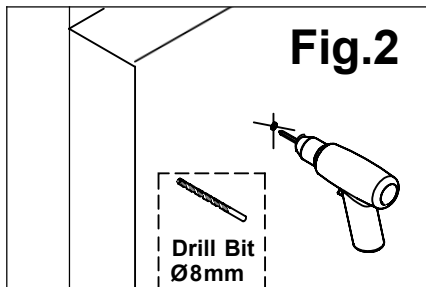
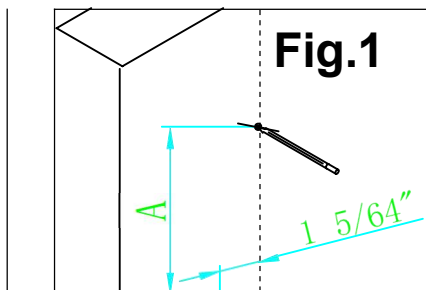

1 Install Rail Bracket (A) Base

NOTE

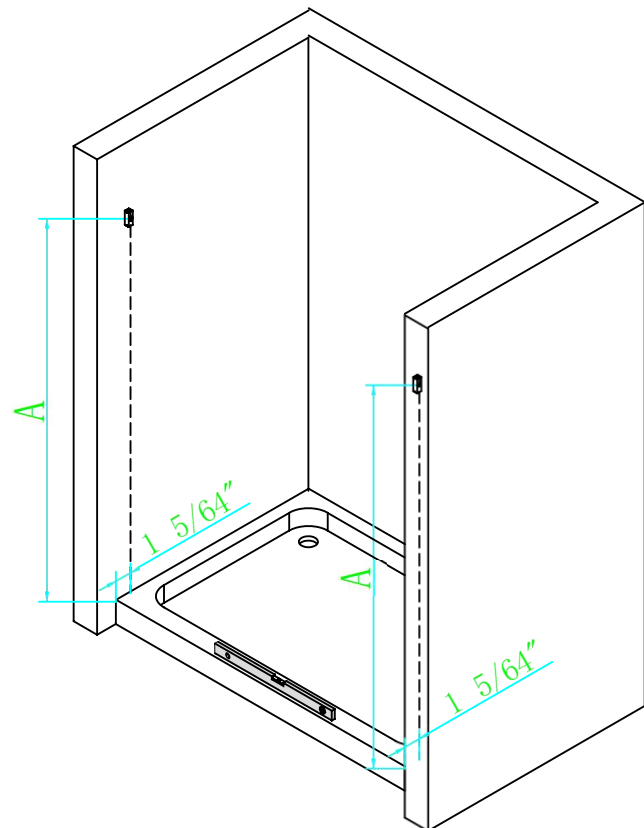
1. Mark position at height [A] (see table), 1 5/64" (27.5mm) from edge.
2. Drill Ø8mm hole at mark.
3. Tap **expansion anchors (aa)** into wall using soft-head hammer.
4. Secure left/right **Rail Brackets (A)** to wall with ST5x45 countersunk self-tapping screws.

2 Top Guide Rail (D) Preparation

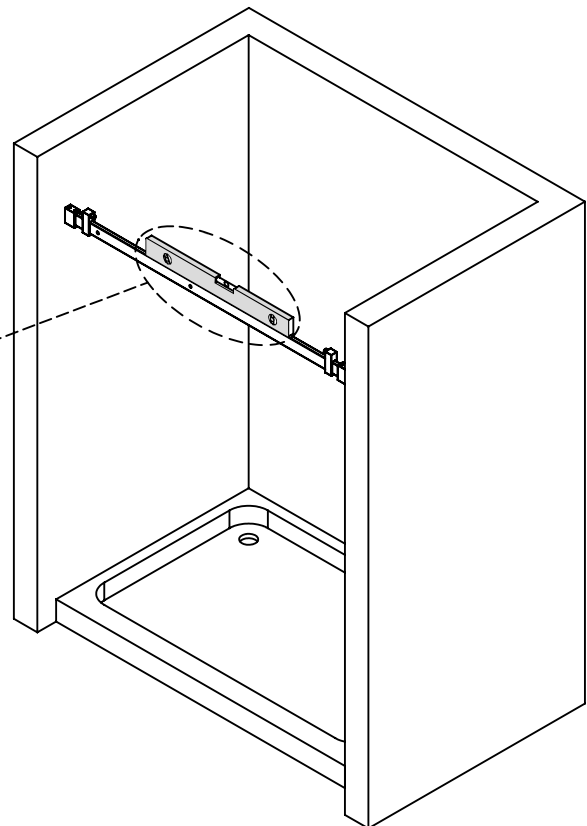
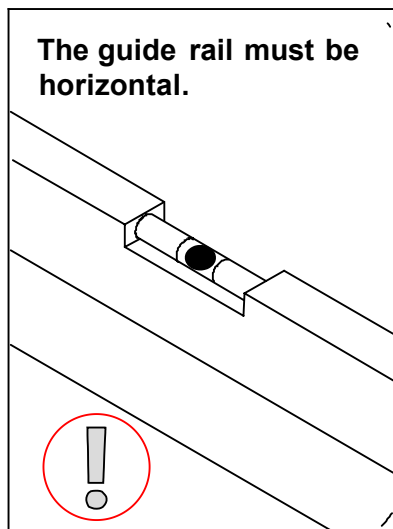
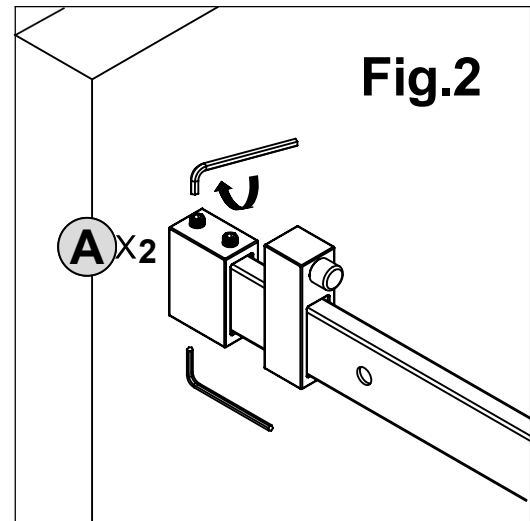
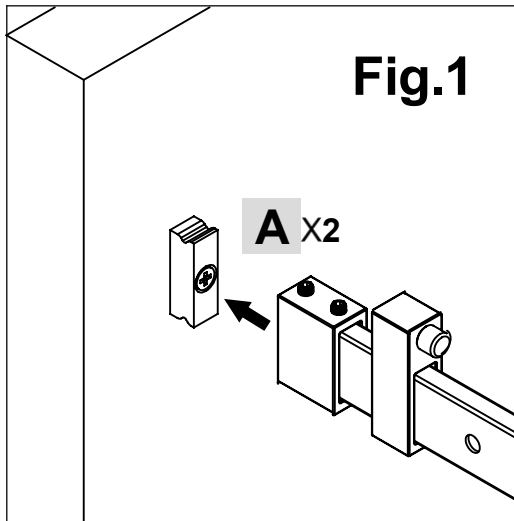
1. Measure and cut excess length from **Top Guide Rail (D)**.
2. Loosen set screws on **Door Stoppers (B)** and slide onto **Top Guide Rail (D)**.
3. Loosen set screws on **Rail Brackets (A)** and slide onto **Top Guide Rail (D)**.



3 Install **Top Guide Rail (D)**

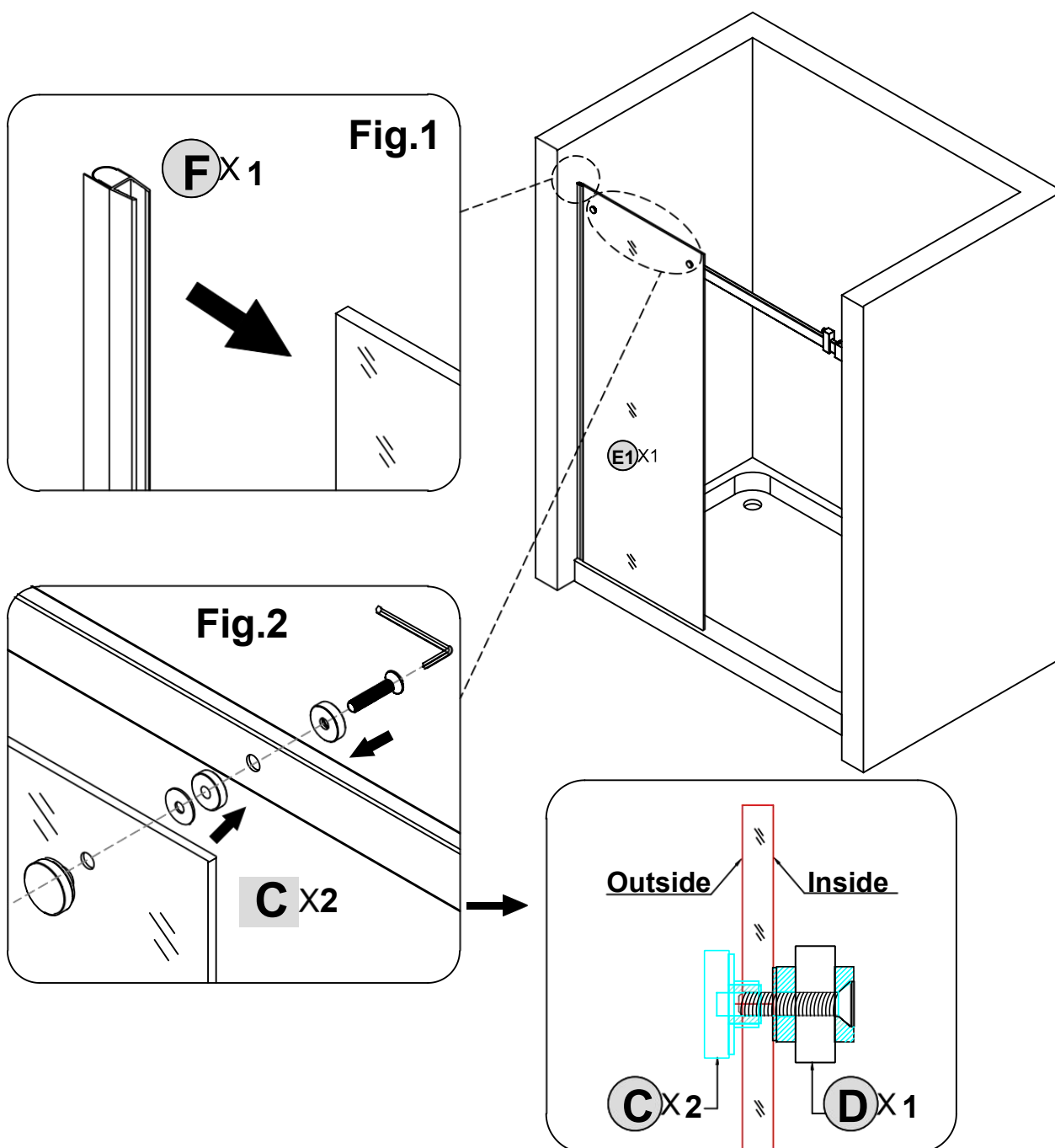
1. Mount left/right **Rail Brackets (A)** onto wall brackets.
2. Tighten all set screws on **Rail Brackets (A)** and **Top Guide Rail (D)** with Allen wrench.



4 Install **Fixed Panel (E1)**

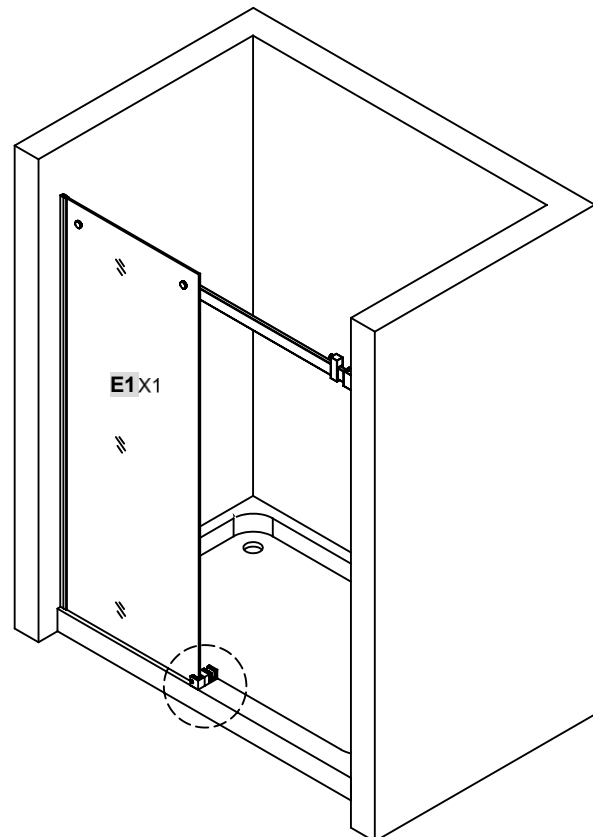
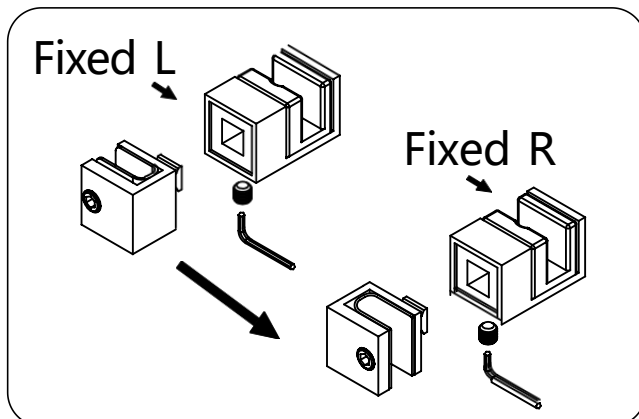
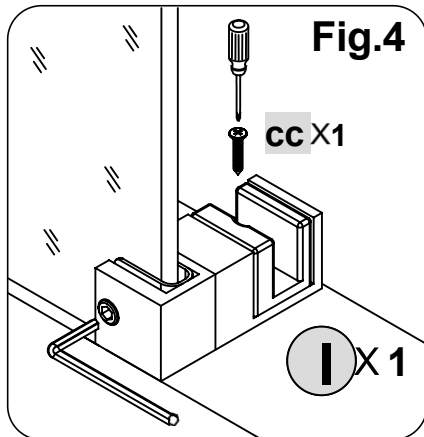
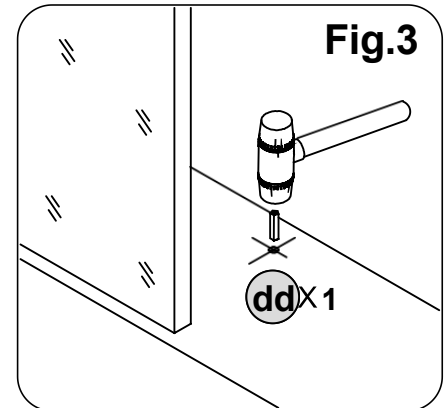
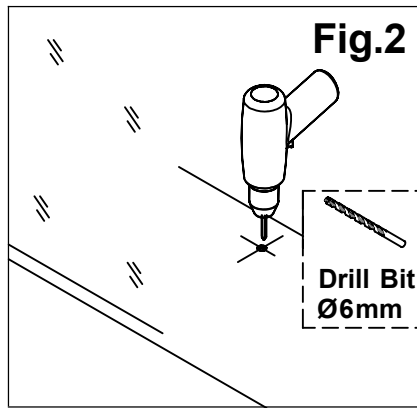
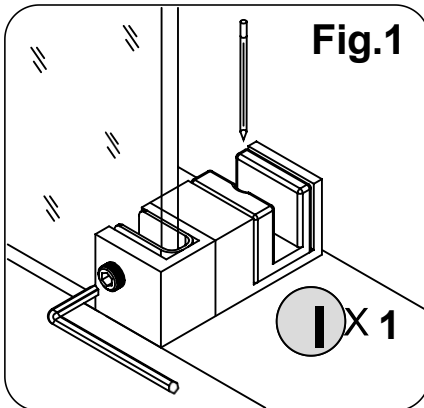
- 1.Clip **Fixed Side Bulb Seal (F)** onto **Fixed Panel (E1)** against the wall.
- 2.Align holes on **Fixed Panel (E1)** with **Top Guide Rail (D)**. Secure with **Glass Railing Stabilizers (C)**.



5 Install **Bottom Guide (I)**

NOTE

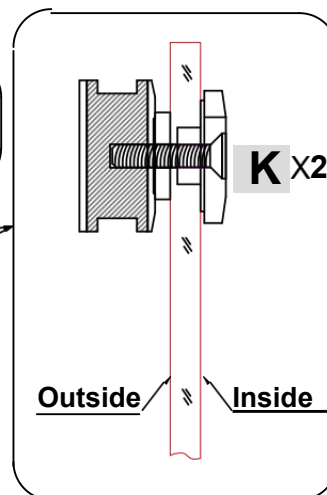
1. Loosen set screw on **Bottom Guide (I)**. Position against **Fixed Panel (E1)** and mark holes.
2. Drill Ø6mm holes at marks.
3. Insert **expansion anchors (dd)** with soft-head hammer.
4. Secure **Bottom Guide (I)** to floor with **ST4x30 countersunk screws (cc)**. Tighten set screw.



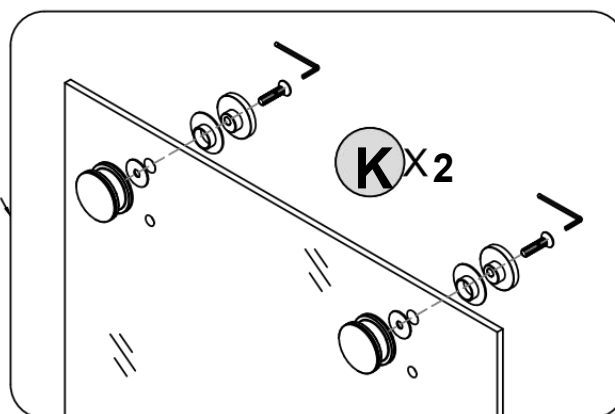
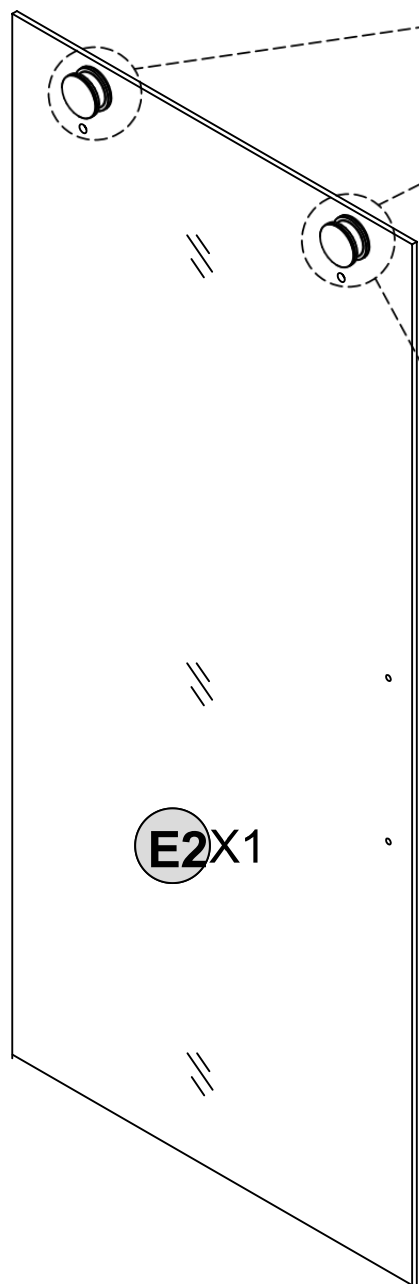
6 Install **Rollers (K)**

NOTE

Wheels facing outside

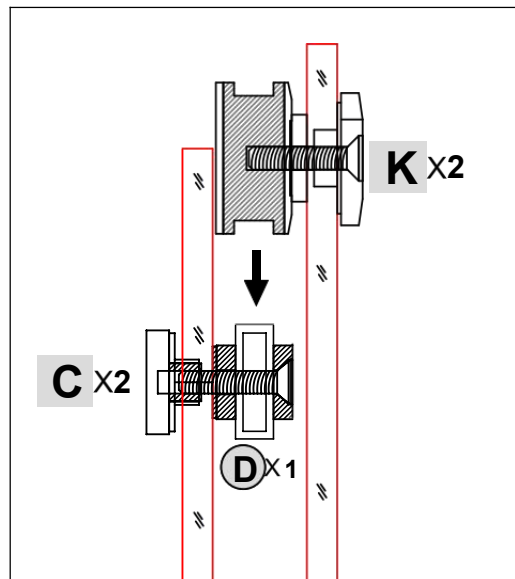


Attach **Rollers (K)** to **Sliding Panel (E2)** with wheels facing OUTSIDE. Tighten with Allen wrench.



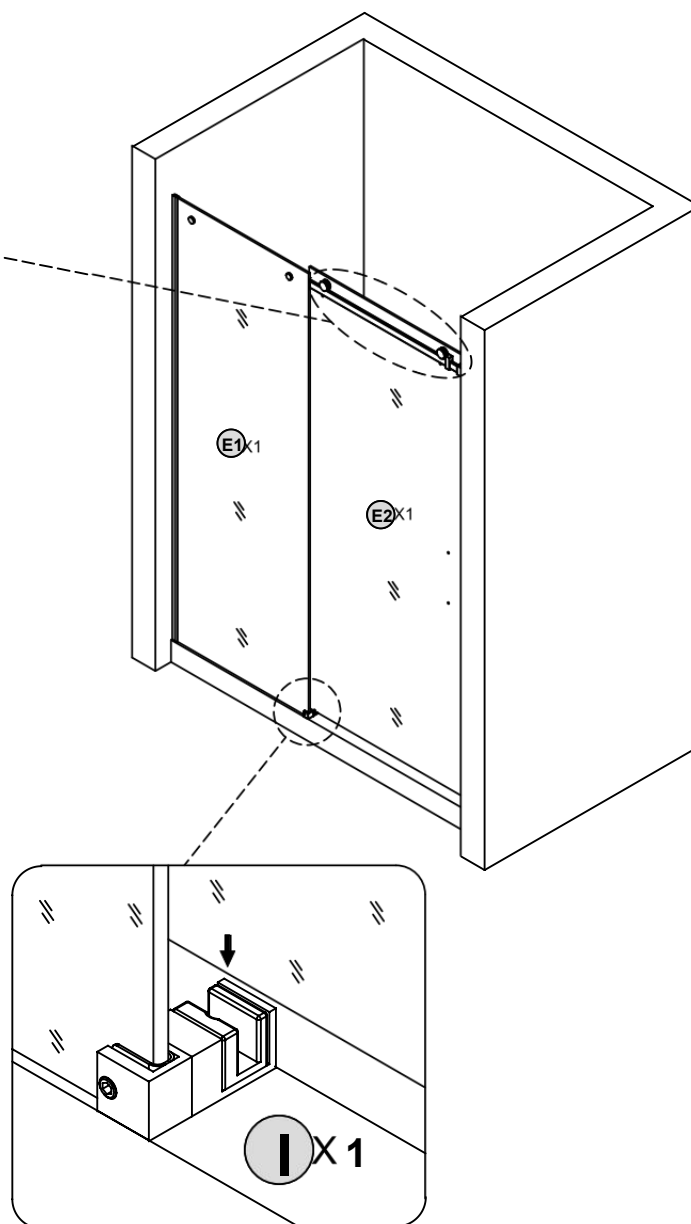
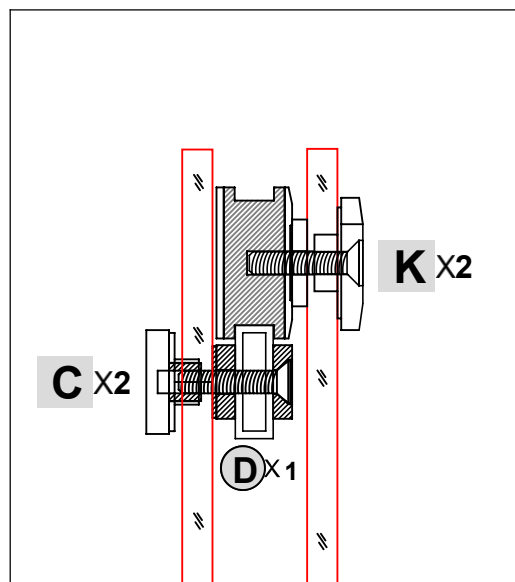

Install **Sliding Panel (E2)**

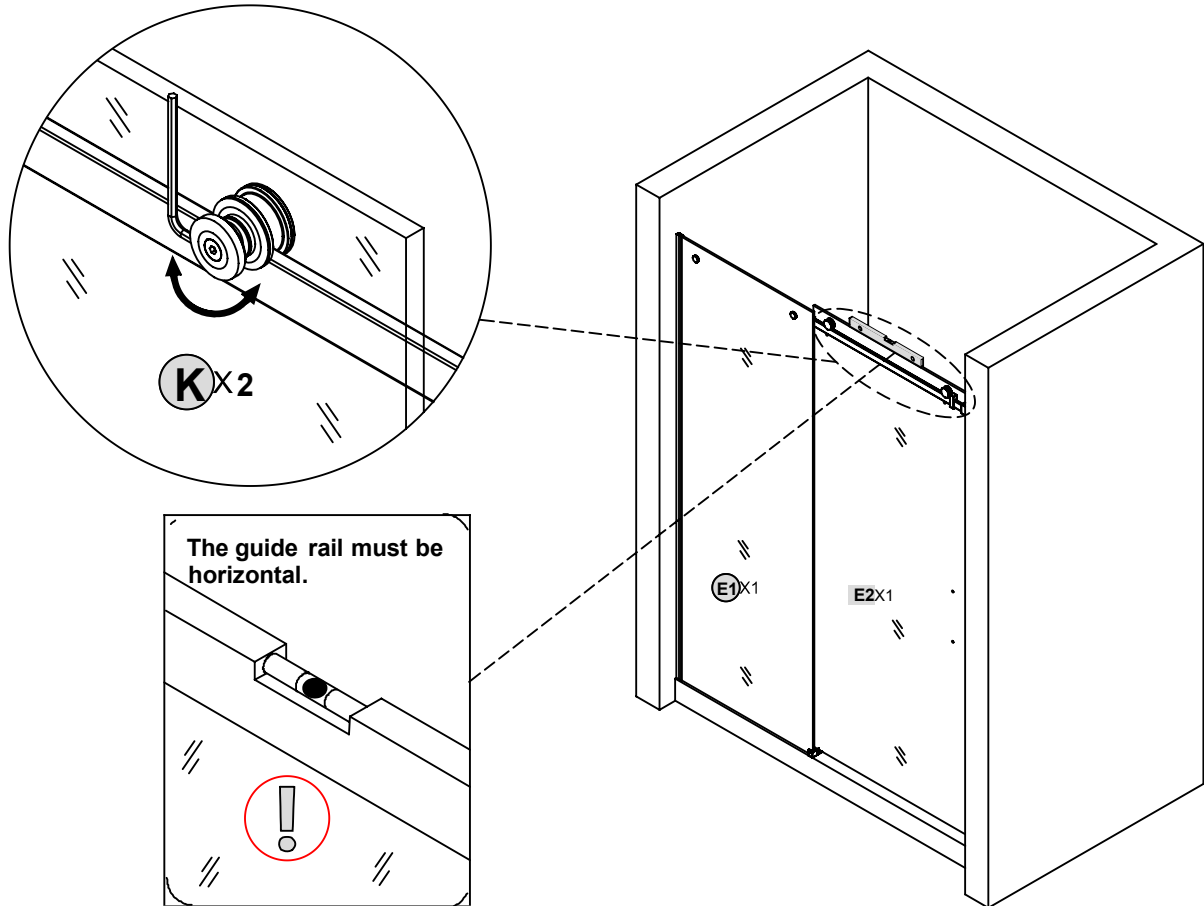
Lift **Sliding Panel (E2)** and engage **Rollers (K)** into **Top Guide Rail (D)**. Insert the bottom of **Sliding Panel (E2)** into **Bottom Guide (I)** slot.



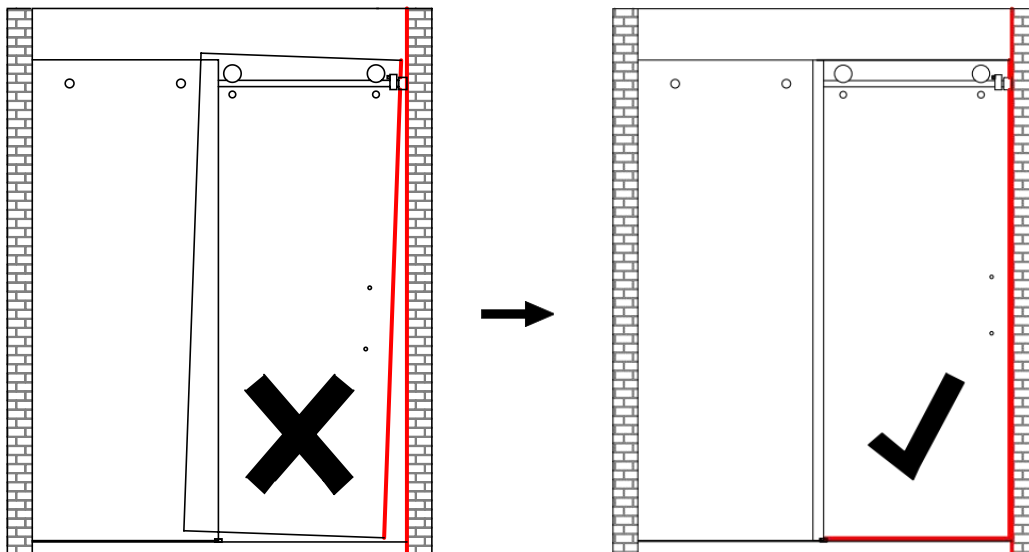
8 Adjust **Sliding Panel (E2)** Height

NOTE

Rotate the **Roller (K)** to adjust **Roller (K)** height to ensure smooth sliding. Align door edge parallel to wall for proper seal when closed.



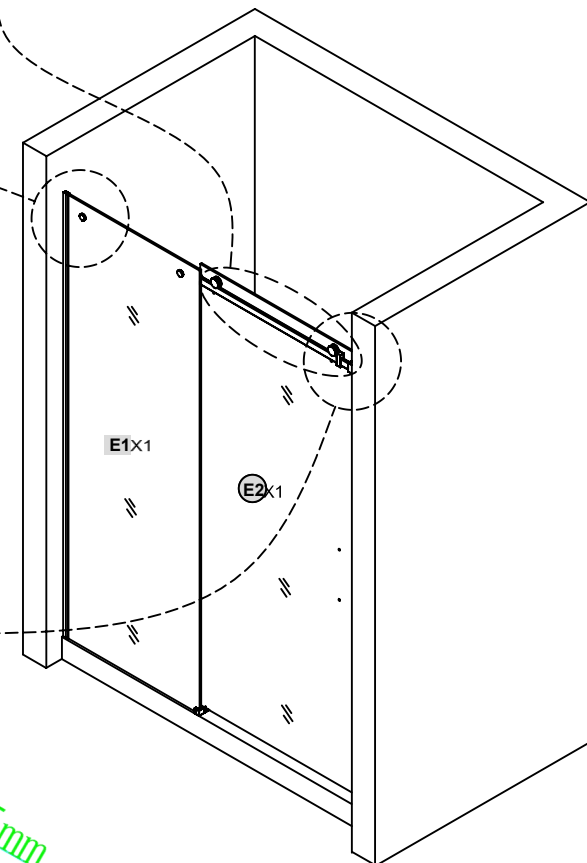
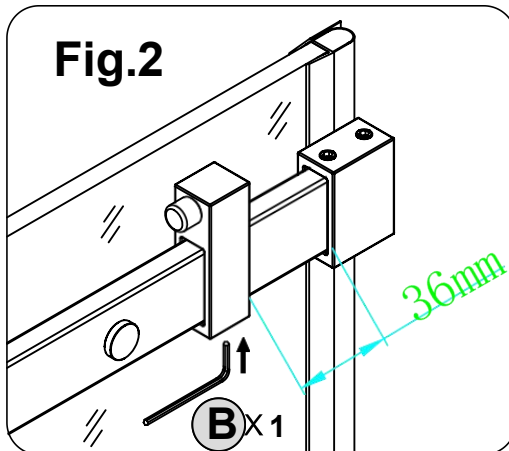
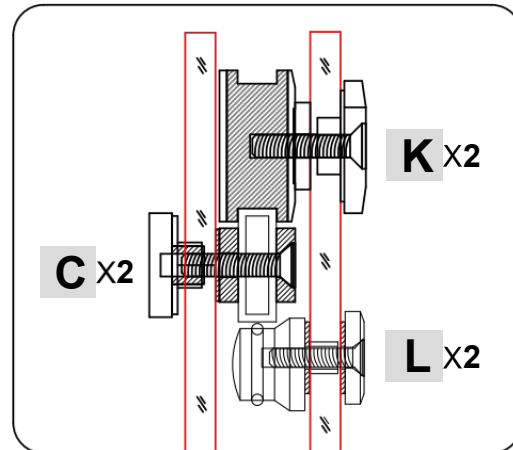
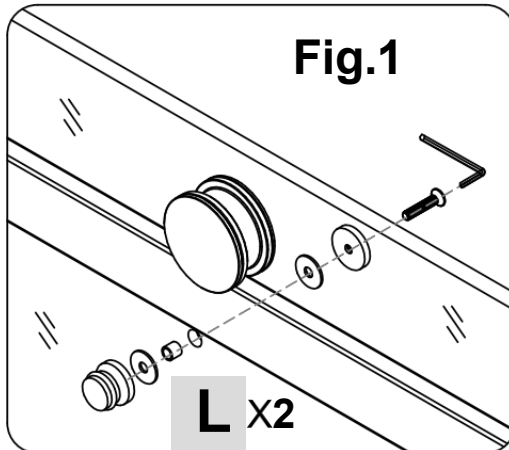

9 Install **Anti-Jump Knobs (L)**

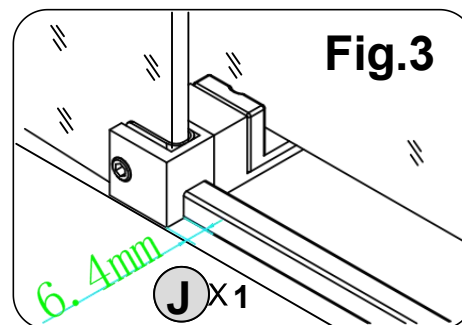
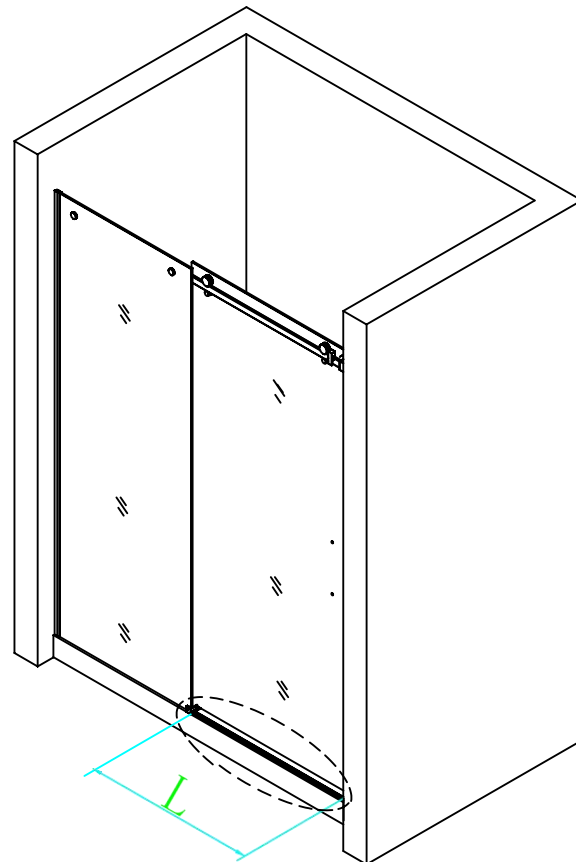
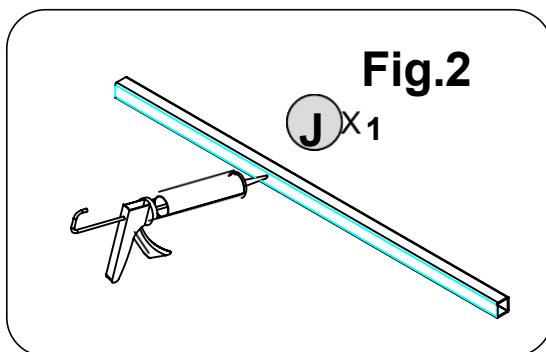
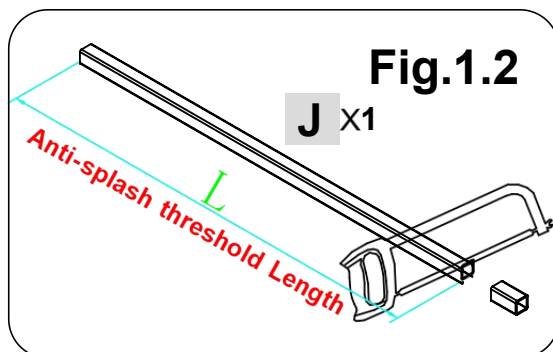
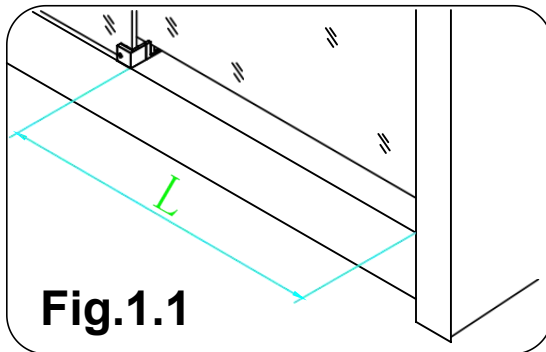
1. Install **Anti-Jump Knobs (L)** on **Sliding Panel (E2)**.
2. Position fixed panel side **Door Stopper (B)** 1 27/64" (36mm) from **Rail Bracket (A)**. Tighten set screw.
3. Position Sliding Panel side **Door Stopper (B)** 1 9/32" (32.5mm) from **Rail Bracket (A)**. Tighten set screw.



10 Install **Threshold Water Dam (J)**

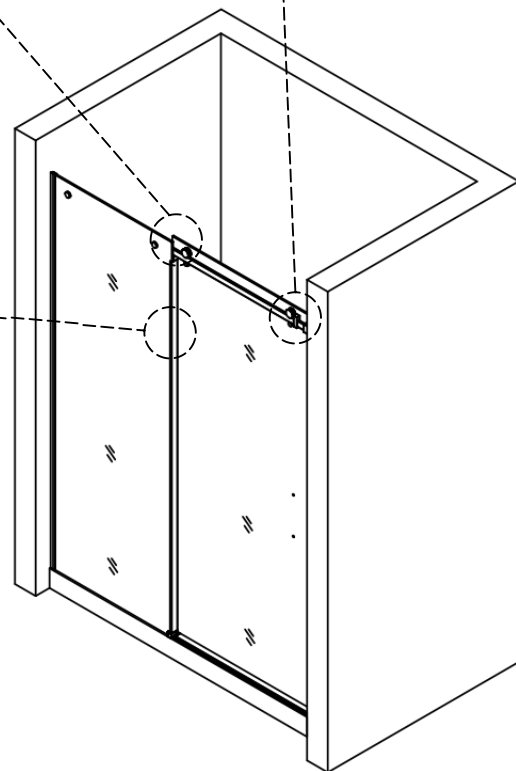
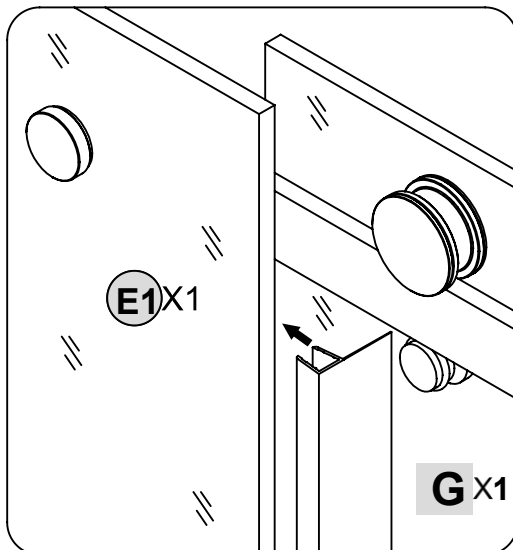
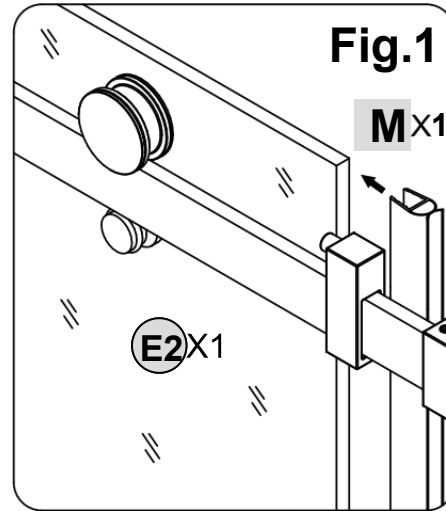
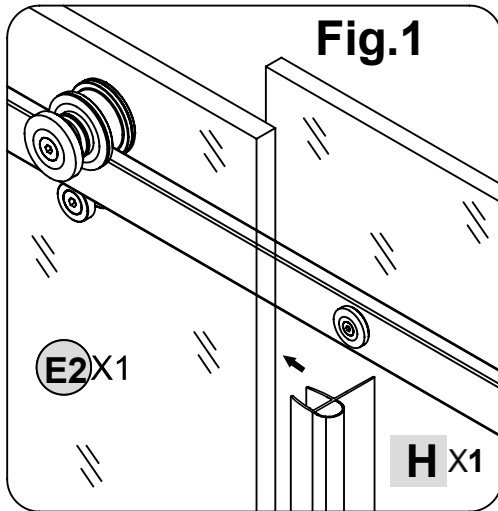
1. Measure the length [L] and cut the excess part of **Threshold Water Dam (J)**.
2. Apply silicone sealant to bottom of **Threshold Water Dam(J)**.
3. Install **Threshold Water Dam(J)** 6.4mm from edge of **Bottom Guide (I)**.



11 Install **Seals(H&M&G)**

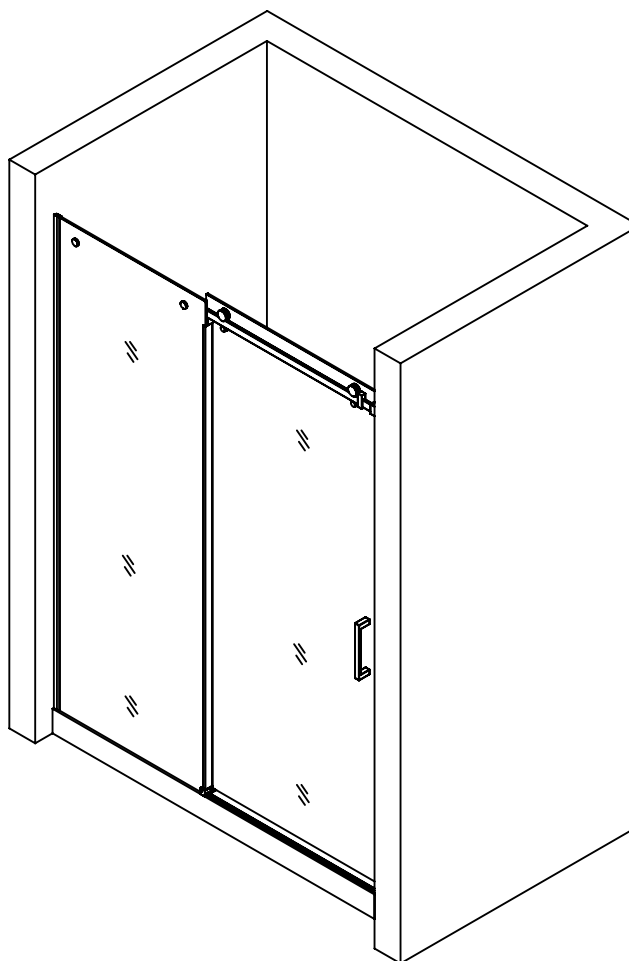
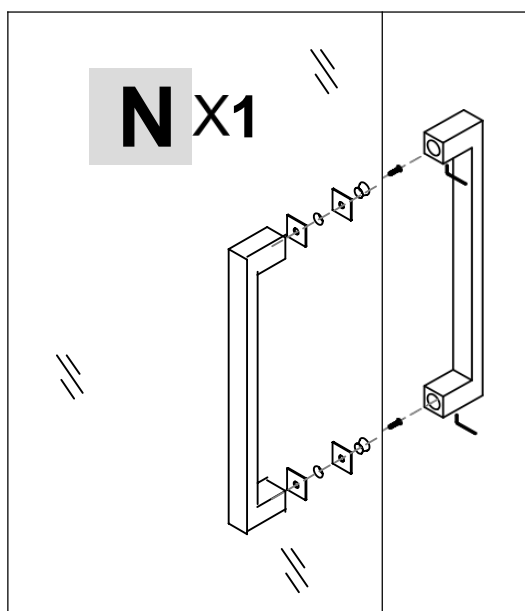
- 1.Clip **F-type Bulb Seal Strip (H)** onto **Sliding Panel (E2)**.
- 2.Clip **Sliding Side Bulb Seal (M)** onto **Sliding Panel (E2)** against the wall.
- 3.Clip **F-type Seal Strip (G)** onto **Fixed Panel (E1)**.

 Install **Handle (N)****NOTE**

Mount **Handle (N)** on **Sliding Panel (E2)**.
Use all provided plastic washers to protect glass.



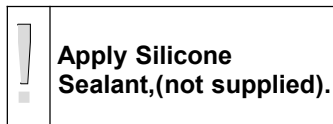
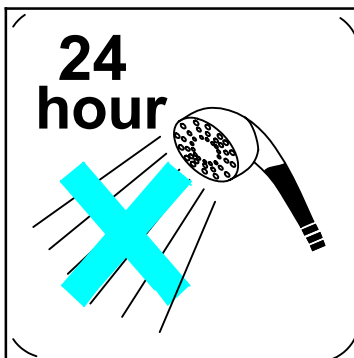
13 SEALING

NOTE The surfaces need to be clean and free of debris before applying silicone.

NOTE Make sure the shower door is tightly closed and opens smoothly. Apply high-quality silicone sealant along the bottom of the fixed glass and the bottom of the lower water barrier.



Allow 24 hours for the silicone to cure before using the shower.



Apply silicone around the fixed glass and the lower water barrier.
