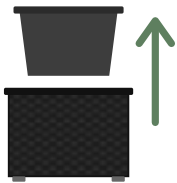
Faux Plant in a Nursery Pot?

Give it a flat, level base in minutes

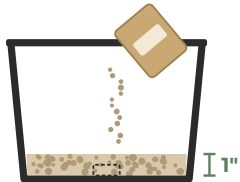
The raised center drain is made for live plants. Pick one easy fix:

OPTION 1 Gravel or Sand

No cutting · about 2 min



- 1 Lift the insert out of the planter.



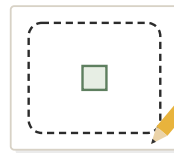
- 2 Pour in pea gravel or sand about 1" deep to cover the drain.



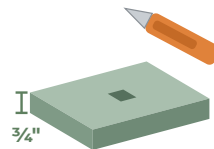
- 3 Set the pot on top and wiggle it level. Extra weight steadies tall trees.

OPTION 2 Foam Plate

About 15 min · utility knife



- 1 Trace the insert floor on paper. Mark a hole $\frac{1}{4}$ " bigger than the drain.



- 2 Cut that shape from a $\frac{3}{4}$ " foam mat tile (or 4 stacked foam boards).



- 3 Drop it in around the drain. The pot now sits flat.

Switching to a live plant? Remove the gravel or plate so water drains.

Gravel, sand, foam and nursery pot not included. Always cut away from your body.
