







Insert and screw 4-Metal Fasteners (n) into each Side Panel. See Diagram above.









Insert and screw 3-**Metal Fasteners (n)** into each Side Molding (c). See Diagram above.












Insert 6-**Cam Locks (m)** into the large predrilled holes (3 per each side), point the arrow on the Cam in the direction of the side edge. Push the Cam into the hole. Then use a screwdriver, to turn each Cam approximately 1/2 turn in the direction of the arrow (clock-wise) to lock it in place. See Diagram above.







Insert 3-**Cam Locks (m)** into the large predrilled holes, point the arrow on the Cam in the direction of the side edge. Push the Cam into the hole. <u>NOTE</u>: For safety, it is recommended to place items on the bookcase shelves starting with the bottom shelf first working your way up the bookcase, shelf by shelf to top shelf. As an added safety feature, we recommend to affix the bookcase to the wall.

Step 15

Installation Instructions:

1. Attach one of the mounting brackets (s) securely to the top back edge of the furniture. Use one of the SHORTER screws (q) to securely attach the bracket (s) to bookcase.

2. Determine where furniture is to be placed and mark location on the wall for the mounting bracket screw hole approximately 2" below the bracket mounted to the edge of the furniture.

3. Drill a 3/16" hole in the wall. Press the plastic anchor (u) into the hole and gently tap until the flange on the anchor is against the wall surface.

4. Position the bracket (s) over the anchor and use one of the LONGER screws (r) to securely attach the bracket (s) to wall.

5. Place the furniture so that the bracket (s) on the back edge is in line with the bracket (s) on the wall.

6.Lace an end of the nylon restraint strap (t) down through each bracket (s). Bring both ends together and slide the end of the strap through the slot in the other end until snug.

(Caution: The rough serrated edge must be to the inside of the loop or it will not lock into place.)

7. Check to make sure the strap is securely laced and locked to the brackets.
