




IMPORTANT

- * After assembly, item must be level to work properly. Use the included adjustable levelers to level.



STEP 8

Loosen slightly the screws pre-installed on the back of the drawer fronts.






STEP 9

Insert the drawer into the unit, then adjust the drawer front panel left or right and up or down until the drawer gaps look proportional.

STEP 10


Pull the drawer open slowly and re-tighten the screws from Step 8. Make sure the front panel does not move and lock the drawer front panel into position with 3/4" Flat Head Screws.






To help reduce the risk of the unit tipping over, the Tipover Restraint <u>must</u> be installed following these instructions exactly!




- Place the unit at desired location.
- Remove Drawers (L,M) from unit.
- Mark wall with pencil to show position of hole in Top (A).
- Move unit.




- Drill a 3/8" hole in wall 1 1/2" below mark.
- Insert Anchor into the wall hole.
- Attach Tipover Restraint to Anchor with 1 1/2" Round Head Screw and Flat Washer.






- Move unit back into place.
- Insert Tipover Restraint into unit through hole in Top (A).




- Screw Tipover Restraint to unit with 1/2" Round Head Screw and Flat Washer.
- Slide Drawers (I,J) back into place.






STEP 1


Attach Drawer Sides (I3) and (I4) and Drawer Supports (I6) to Drawer Back (I2) with 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.

Insert Drawer Bottom (J5) into the groove.


Attach Drawer Front (I1) to unit with 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.









Drawer (M)






STEP 1


Attach Drawer Sides (K3) and (K4) and Drawer Supports (I6) to Drawer Back (K2) with 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.

Attach Drawer Front (K1) to unit with 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.






STEP 3

Attach Handles with Machine Screws.
