- Remove the fixture from its original packaging and remove the fixture mounting plate from within the hardware package. Attach the fixture mounting plate to the electrical junction box on the wall using the two screws provided in the hardware package.
- Now attach the fixture to the mounting plate, which is attached to the electrical junction box on the wall. First attach all wiring with the provided marrets (white to white "N", black to black "L", ground to ground "G"). Push the screws through the holes in the back of the fixture so they are poking through into the center of the fixture.
- Attach the lamp fitting to the mounting bracket and screw it by using thumb screw supplied. and be sure it is firmly secured to the fixture (do not over tighten).
- 4 Attach the metal shade to the fitting and tight it by socket collar.
- Attach the light bulb to the socket.
