

12 Ft 2-Pt Hammock Stand

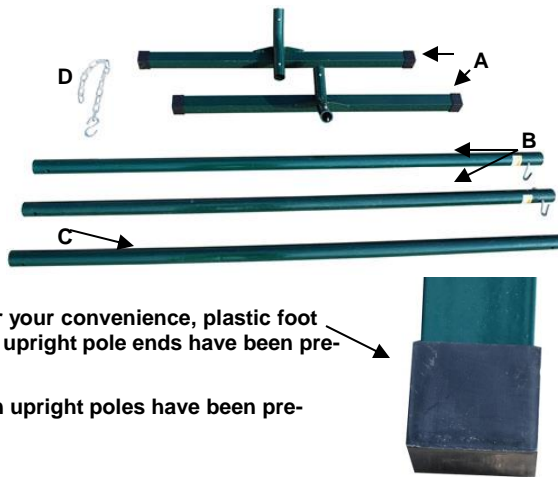
Assembly Instructions

Do not exceed load limit of 350 lbs, or the load limit on your hammock.

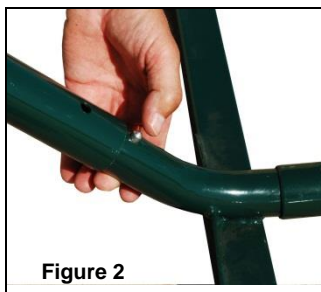
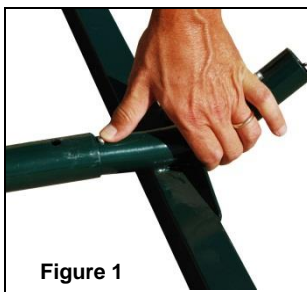
Your carton should contain:

- 2 – Leg assemblies (A)
- 2 – Upright Poles with attached S-Hooks (B)
- 1 – Center Pole (no attached hooks) (C)
- 1 – Hanging chain with S-Hook (D)



No-Tool-Assembly instructions

1. Locate leg assemblies with attached elbow pipes (A) and place on the ground.
2. Locate center pole (C), and insert one end onto the horizontal end of the elbow pipe of one of the leg assemblies by pressing down on the silver lock-pin while pushing the center pole onto the elbow (Figure 1) until the silver lock-pin fully engages by popping into the lock-pin hole on the center pole. Repeat this procedure for the other leg assembly to the other end of the center pole.
3. Locate either of the upright poles with the attached S-hook assembly (B). Place the non-capped end of the upright pole onto the upright elbow pipe of the leg assembly (Figure 2) making sure the silver lock-pin fully engages in the lock pin hole. Repeat this procedure with the second upright pole.
4. Attach the hanging chain with S-hook (D) to one of the attached S-hooks on either upright poles by looping a chain link onto the attached S-hook (Figure 3). The S-hook on the hanging chain is designed to attach to the O-ring on one end of your hammock with the opposite O-ring of your hammock attaching directly to the S-hook on the opposite upright pole. Adjust to desired height by changing the chain link that you loop over the S-hook.



CAUTION:

Before each use, examine the stand to make sure all poles are locked into place with the lock-pins fully engaged.

After moving or adjusting your hammock stand, always inspect to make sure all pieces are properly in place and lock-pins are safely engaged.

Never exceed the weight capacity of 350 lbs, or the weight capacity of your hammock.

The hammock stand should be used on level ground for safe operation.

Try not to drag your stand. Have someone help you carry it by lifting from both ends.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Your hammock stand has a powder coated finish to resist the elements. You can extend the life of your stand by wiping off moisture and not leaving it out in the elements in months you will not be using your hammock. When storing, wipe clean and store in a dry location to prevent rust.
