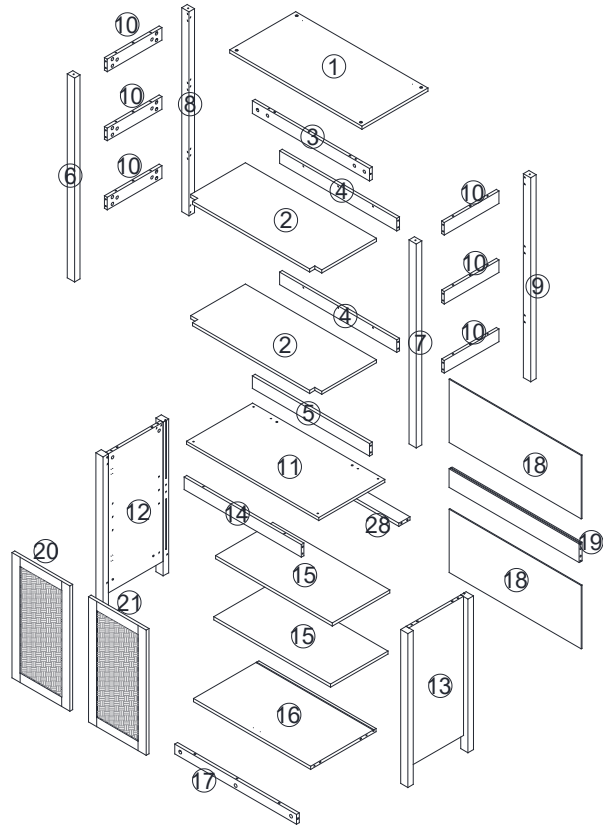
4. Proper Screw Seating:

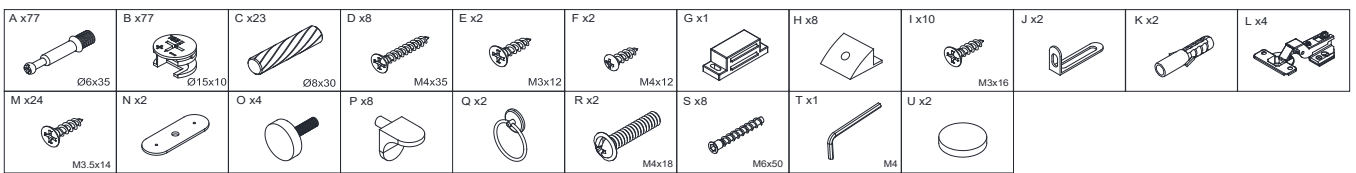
5. Avoid Over-Tightening:

Cabinet Door Adjustment Instructions

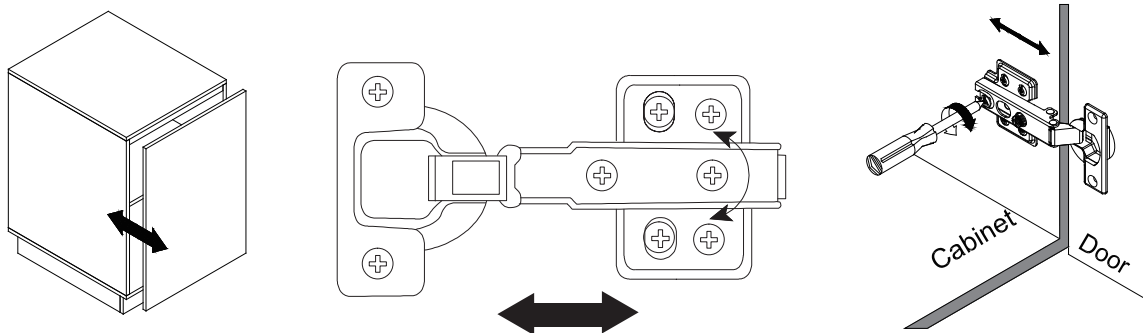
Height adjustment:

- Locate the height adjustment screws on the hinge.
- Use the Phillips screwdriver to either tighten or loosen the screws to raise or lower the cabinet door as desired.



Side-to-side adjustment:

- If the cabinet door needs to be moved closer to or away from the cabinet frame, locate the side-to-side adjustment screws on the hinge.
- Use the Phillips screwdriver to adjust these screws and gradually move the door in the desired direction.



Depth adjustment (if applicable):

- Check if the cabinet door needs to be brought closer to or further away from the cabinet frame.
- For-depth adjustment, locate the depth adjustment screws on the hinge.
- Use the Phillips screwdriver to turn these screws clockwise or counterclockwise accordingly.
