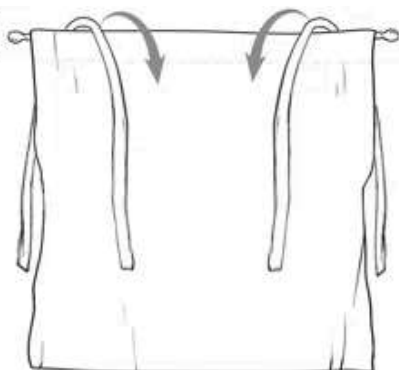
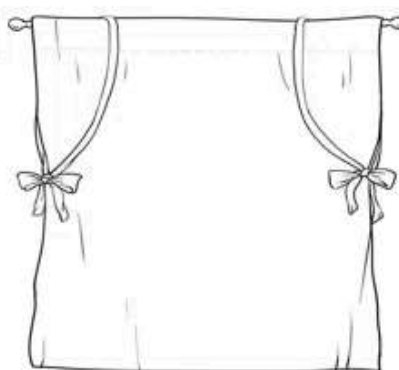


Step1



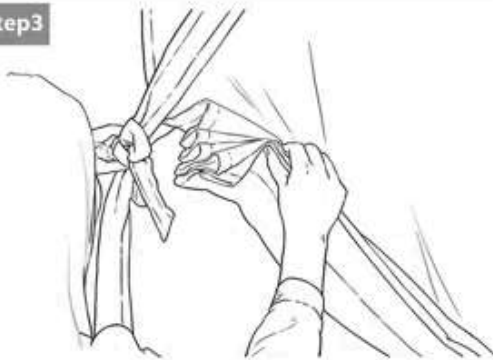
Hang the tie up curtain. There are two ties on the left side of the shade and two ties on the right side of the shade. On each side there is a longer tie and a shorter tie. Keep the shorter one on the back of the shade. Flip the longer one on the front of the shade

Step2



Decide the height you want. Tie the two ties on the left side of the shade together in a standard bow. Make the bow tight and snug enough to hold the shade up. On the right side do the same thing as you did on the left side.

Step3



On the left side, fold the shades up from the bottom to raise them. For the neatest look, make narrow accordion folds back and forth until you raise the shade to the height you want. Insert the fabric to the tie loop. On the right side do the same thing as you did on the left side.

Step 4



Stand back and look at the shade to make sure it is even. If the shade is not even, make some adjustments.
