## **IMPORTANT NOTICE**

- Use only Mattresses - 74" - 75" long and 37 1/2" - 38 1/2" wide on the upper bunk.
- Use only Mattresses - 74" - 75" long and 38" - 38 1/2" wide on the lower bunk.
- Ensure thickness of mattresses does not exceed 7" and mattresses is at least 5" below upper edge of guardrails.
- Check that you have all parts and hardware before assembly. Parts apparently missing are often found in the packing materials.
- Replacement parts, including additional guardrails, may be obtained from any of retailers purchased from.

## **SAFETY WARNING**

- Follow the information on the warnings appearing on the upper bunk end structure and on the carton. Do not remove warning label from bed.
- Always use the recommended size mattresses or mattress support, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls.
- Surface of mattress must be at least 5 in. (127 mm) below the upper edge of guardrails.
- Do not allow children under 6 years of age to use the upper bunk.
- Periodically check and ensure that the guardrail, ladder, and other components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.
- Do not allow horseplay on or under the bed and prohibit jumping on the bed.
- Always use ladder for entering and leaving upper bunk.
- Do not use substitute parts. Contact the retailer or dealer for replacement parts.
- Use of a night light may provide added safety precaution for a child using the upper bunk.
- Always use guardrails on both long sides of the upper bunk. If the bunk bed will be placed next to the wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and wall.
- The use of water or sleep flotation mattresses is prohibited.

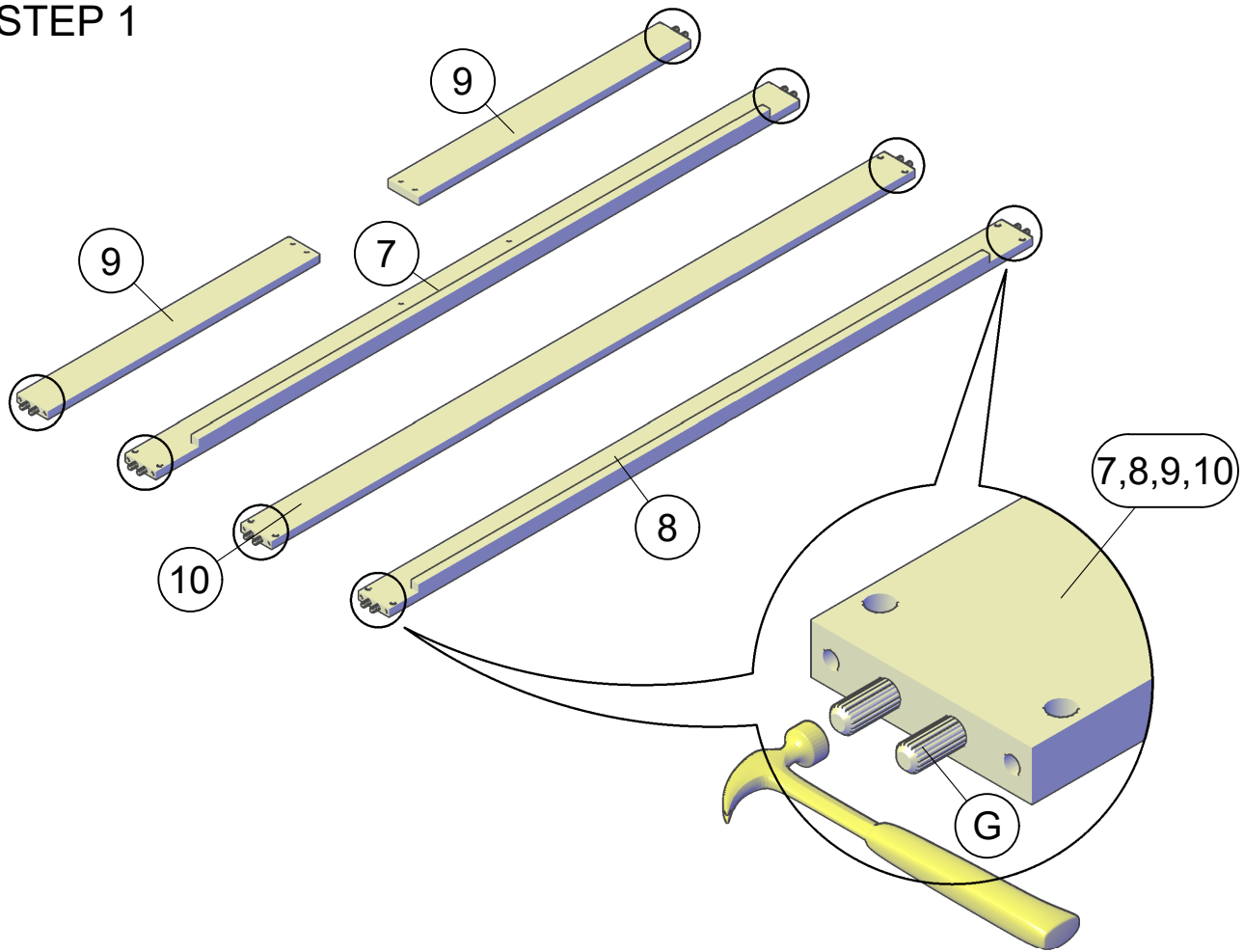
- Do not attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed; for example, but not limited to, hooks, belts, and jump ropes.

## WARNING

### TO HELP PREVENT

serious or fatal injuries from entrapment or falls

- Never allow a child under 6 years on upper bunk
- Use only mattress which is 74"~75" long and 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ "~38 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide on upper bunk
- Ensure thickness of mattress does not exceed 7" and mattress surface is at least 5" below upper edge of guardrails
- Use guardrails on both sides of upper bunk

- Prohibit horseplay on or under bed (s)
- Prohibit more than one person on upper bunk
- Use ladder for entering and leaving upper bunk

### STRANGULATION HAZARD:

Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed; for example, but not limited to, hook, belts, and jumprobes.
