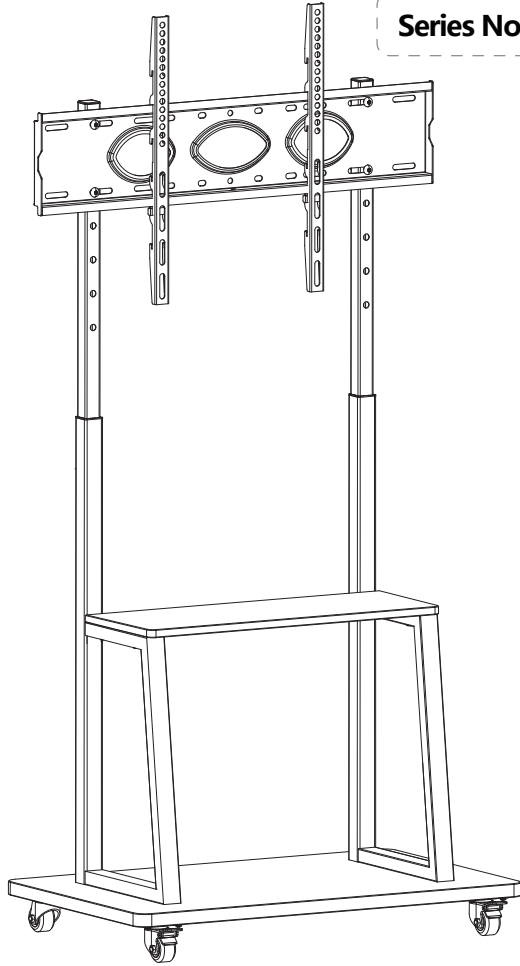

Keep little parts of furniture far away from the children.

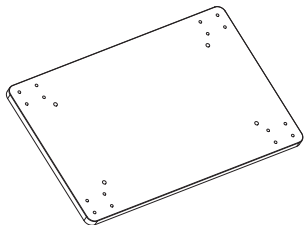
Do not allow children to climb onto the furniture.

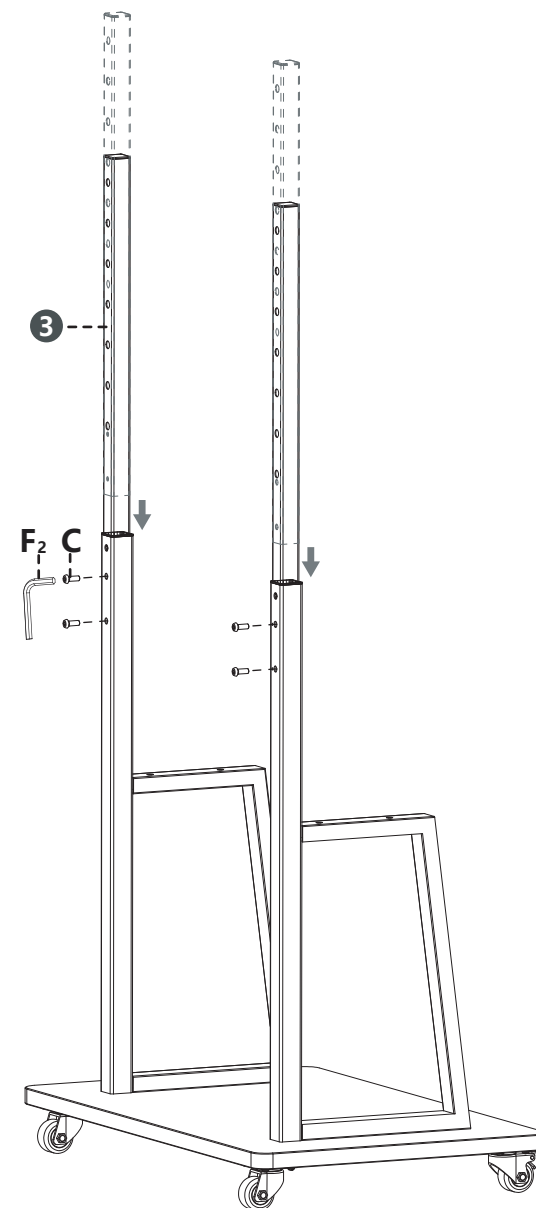


Please note that the wheels **5** with brakes should be installed facing forward.

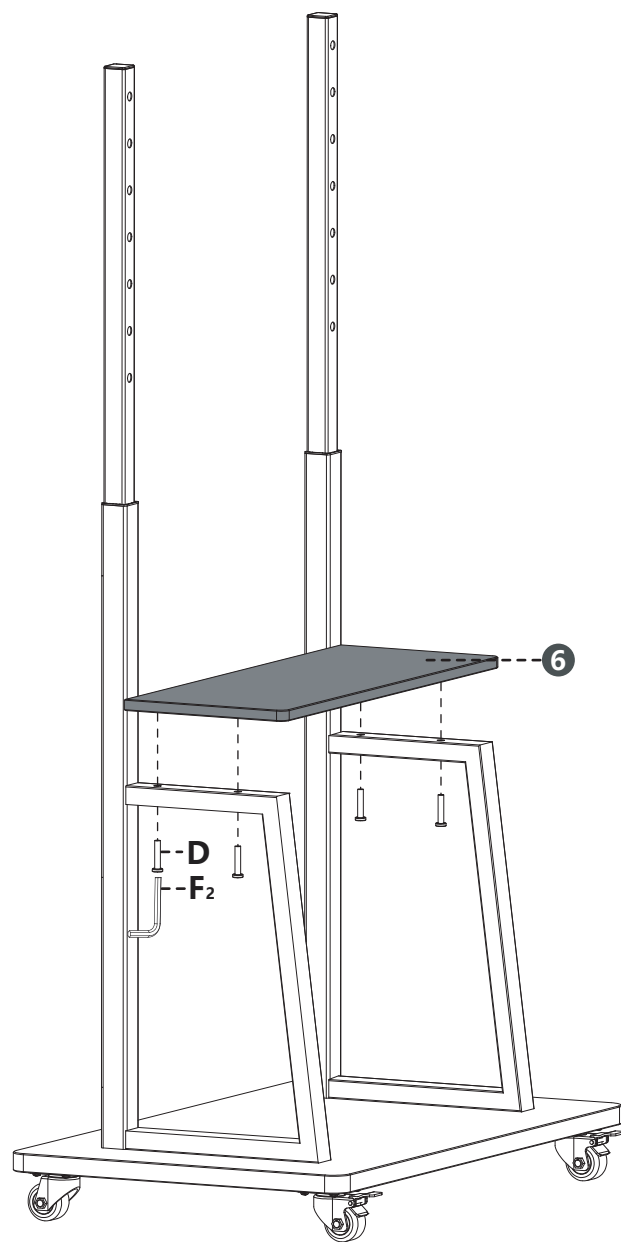

STEP 1

Select TV Screw Diameter

Please make sure the diameter of the screw **S0-S4** are suitable for your TV.



STEP 2

Measure VESA For Your TV

1. What does the VESA standard mean?

The VESA standard is a standard for attaching flat screens / LCD / monitors / televisions to monitor mounts or TV mounts.

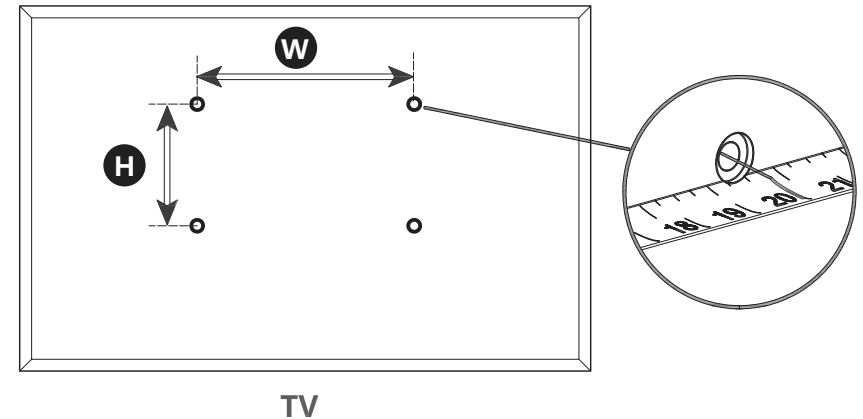
Prerequisite is that both the monitor / TV and the monitor mount have the same VESA standard.

2. Look at the back of your TV/monitor for threaded holes.

Measure the horizontal distance **W** and vertical distance **H** of the screw holes (center to center).

W x **H** should comply with the VESA standard of TV stand listed in below sheet.

Notice: If the TV/monitor is not compatible with VESA, it can still be attached to the desired bracket by using VESA Adapters(not included and should be purchased separately).

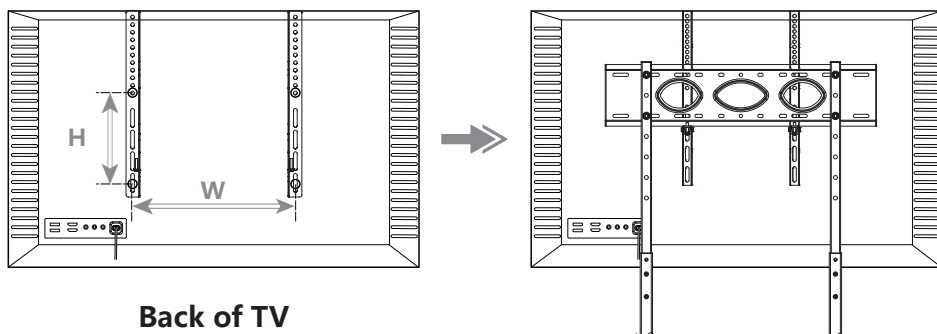
VESA standard of TV STAND

STEP 3

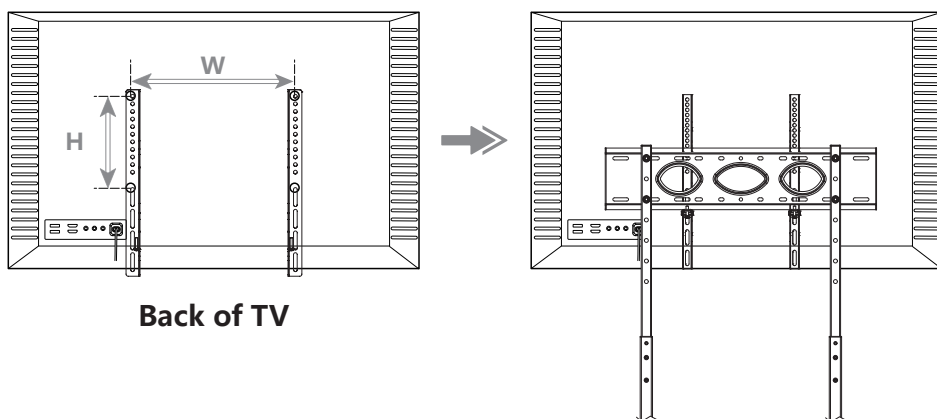
Holes Selection of Brackets

When **H** is shorter than **400mm**, different TV heights can be set based on bracket hole positions, as shown in the following figure.

Choose the lower holes to lower the TV height



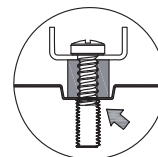
Choose the upper holes to higher the TV height



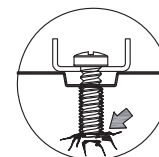
STEP 4

Select TV Screw Length

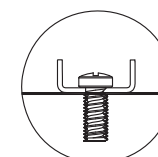
When attaching brackets to the TV, be careful not to over tighten screws and be sure that screws don't bottom out in the mounting holes. Please make sure the length of thread engagement at least 6 turns or 5/16 inch (8mm).



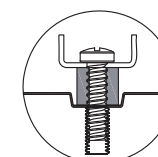

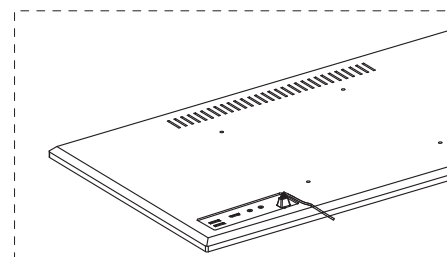

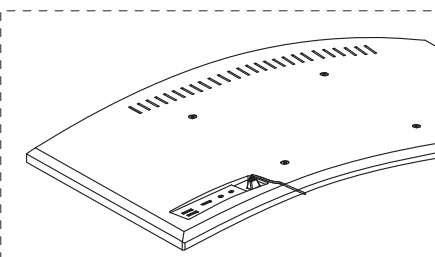

Select installation method according to TV

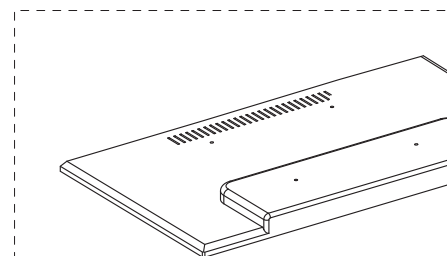

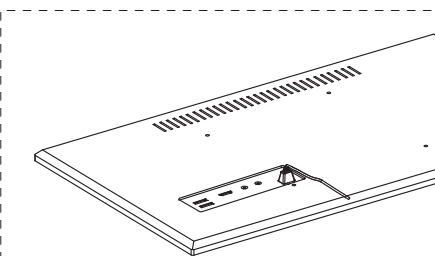
For flat back TV,

Spacers may be necessary for 2 holes ONLY.



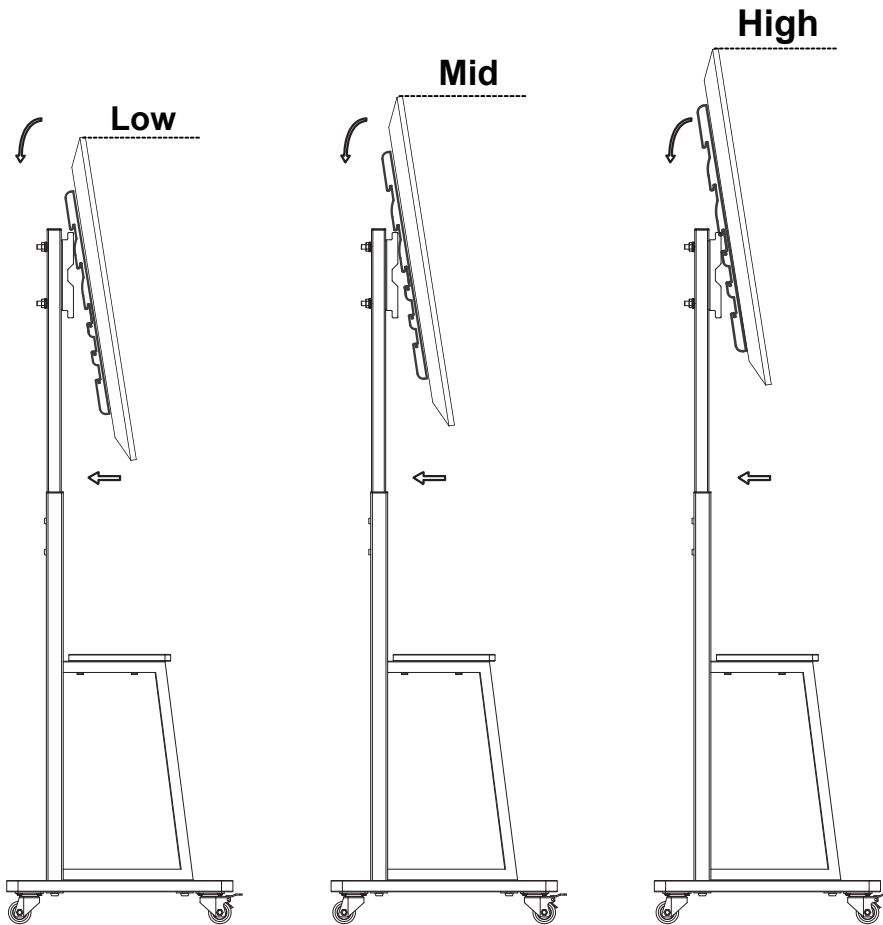
Option 4 (Potential Cable Blockage)

Attach your TV to TV plate 7, select the best height by yourself.

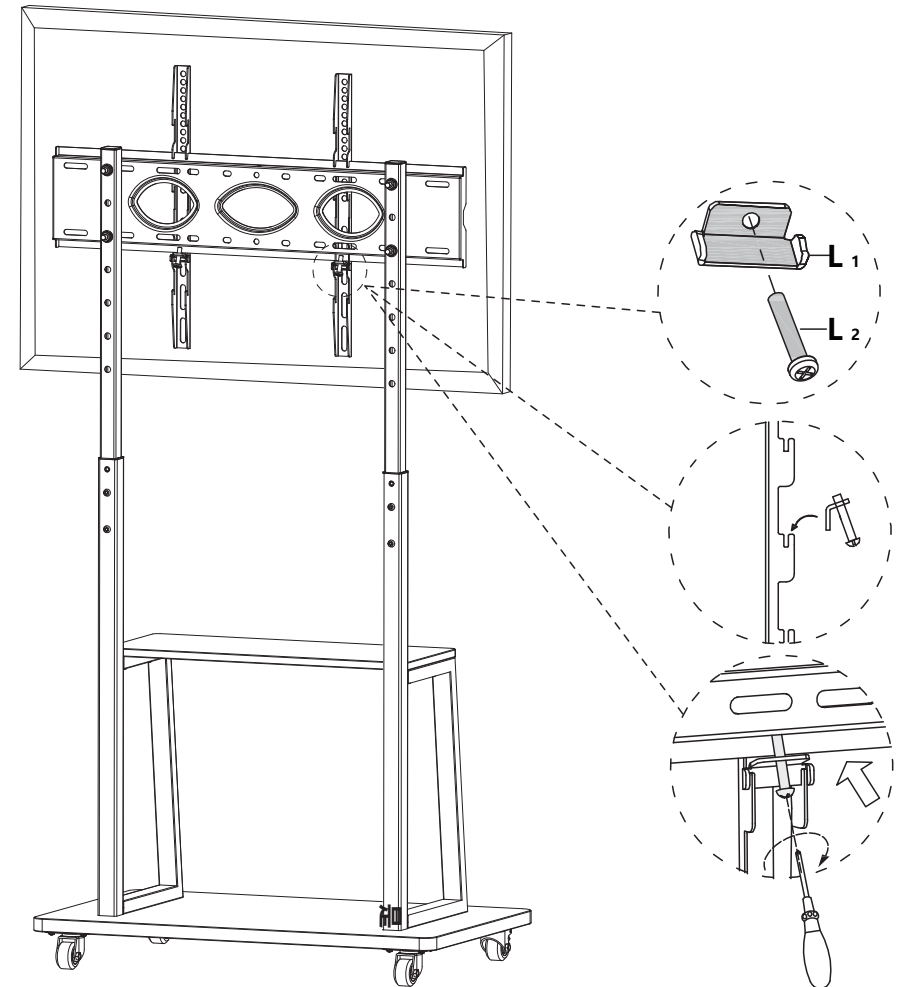

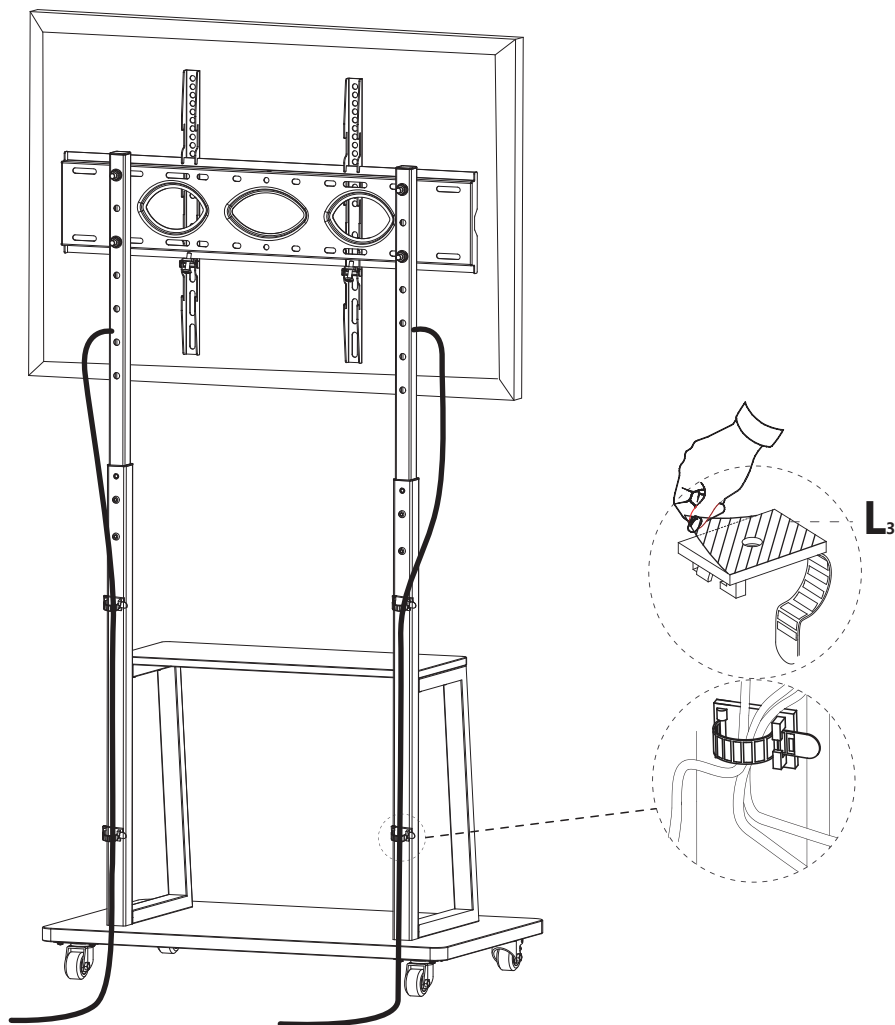

Insert Safety lock L₁ and L₂ in the bottom of brackets 8 and tighten the screws L₂, Please lock your TV before using.

Notice: Please don't over tighten the screw L₂, overtighten may cause L₁ broken.



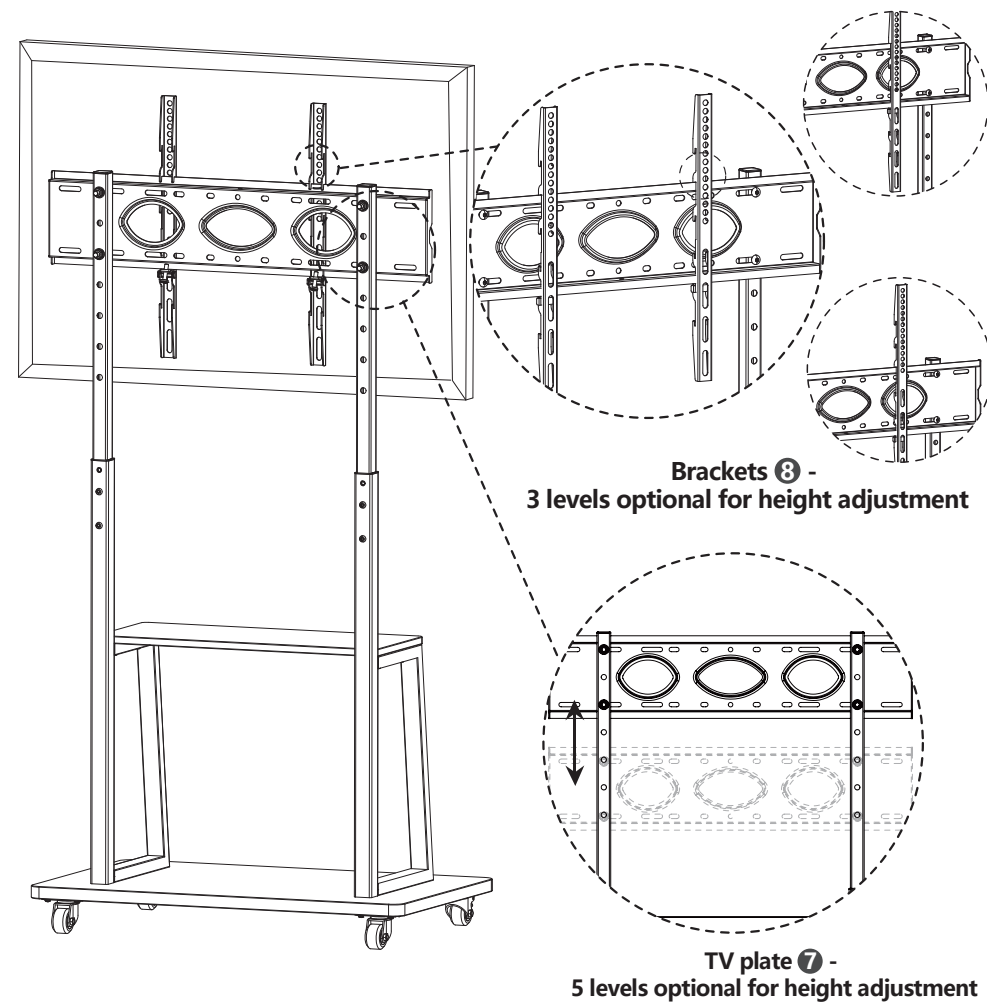
Cable management clips **L₃** lets you easily organize power and AV cords to keep things neat.



USERS GUIDELINE

Stand Height Adjustment - TV Plate/Brackets

1. Please take off the TV from the stand then select the proper height by yourself.
2. Each level adjustment distance in TV plate / bracket is 50 mm (2 inch).
3. Attach the TV to the TV plate **7** again and tighten the safety screws **L₂** on the bottom of brackets to secure the TV to the stand.



EASILY MOVE

You can move the stand around easily, please make sure all wheels are unlocked during the movement, and make sure your hand is on reasonable position as below shown to avoid wrong operation that result the stand falling over.

Please take off the TV and devices If you need to move the stand for long distances.

Please don't move this stand on the carpet or unlevel ground.
