CUTTING

1. Measure and Mark

Measure and mark the back of the tile according to the dimensions required for your space.

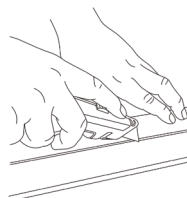
Tip: Double-check your measurements: It's always a good idea to measure twice to avoid mistakes.



2. Score Tile for Cutting

Use a straight edge and a utility/ craft knife to score the tile, making multiple passes if necessary for a clean cut.

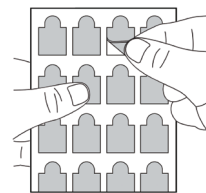
Tip: Make sure to use a sharp utility or craft knife when cutting our felt tiles.



INSTALLATION

1. Peel Tabs

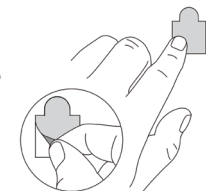
Peel 1 adhesive tab from the sheet.



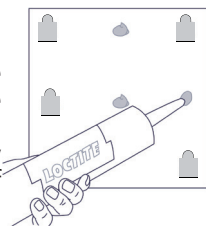
2. Place and Press

Firmly press and rub the whole tab, including the edges, onto the back side of the tile. Place the tabs according to the Tab Placement.

Remove the backing, leaving the adhesive on the tile. Place the tile against the wall and apply pressure for up to 30 seconds for the best results.



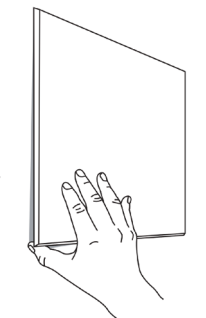
Commercial: For commercial applications, we recommend using our commercial adhesive tabs in combination with a construction adhesive, such as Heavy Duty Loctite. Apply the construction adhesive around the area of the tabs.



REMOVING TILES

1. Pull up Corner

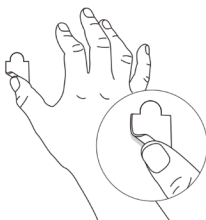
Starting with one corner, SLOWLY peel the tile from the wall, leaving the adhesive behind. Insert your finger behind the tile and slowly add pressure until the tile releases from the tabs.



Tip: Work slowly and steadily, peeling too quickly can cause damage to the tile or wall.

2. Roll off Adhesive

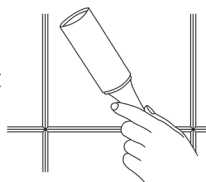
Starting at the corner, roll your thumb across the adhesive to peel it off the wall.



Tip: If tabs don't release, apply heat with a blow dryer or use adhesive remover like Goo Gone to soften and scrape off any leftover adhesive.

CLEANING

Use a lint roller, handheld vacuum, or soft brush attachment to gently remove dust and debris.
