




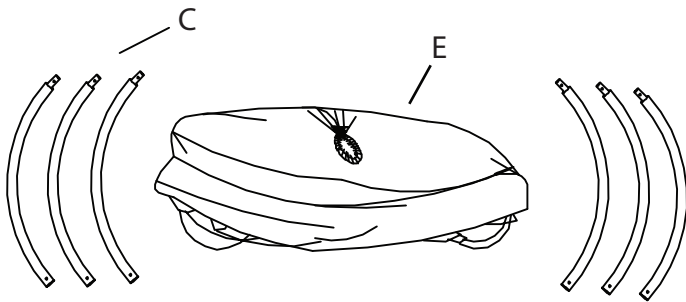


INSTRUCTION MANUAL

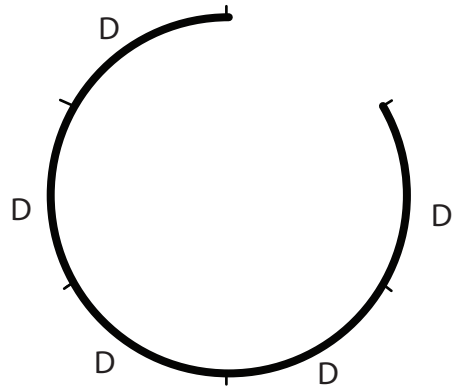
HANGING SWING NEST

A - Fabric Swing		x1
B - Pillow		x1
C - Hex Wrench		x1
D - Curved Support Tube		x6
E - Screw		x6

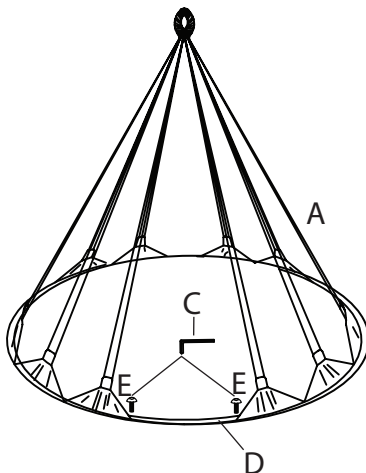
Step 1. Make sure all parts are present and place them side by side for easy identification.



Step 2. Connect 5 of the curved support tubes (D) and secure them by using screws (E) with the help of the hex wrench (C)

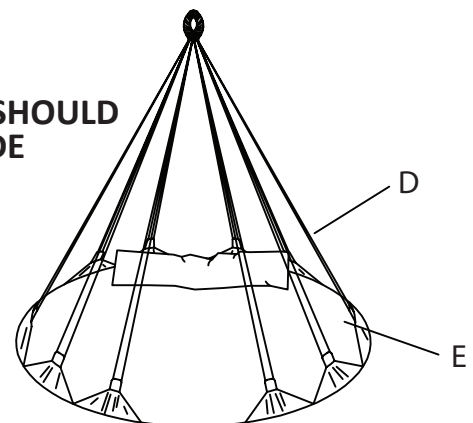


Step 3. Open the fabric swing (A) and proceed to slide in the 5 connected support tubes. Once inserted, connect the 6th curved support tube (D) and secure it by inserting a screw (E) accordingly with the help of the hex wrench (C).



Step 4. Insert the complete circular frame inside the fabric seat cover and zip close. Add the pillow for extra comfort and support. Assembly is complete and your swing is ready to hang!

CHECK FOR SAFETY

After installing, tug firmly on the rope to be sure it holds. Then, place a heavy object in the swing hammock to be sure it remains secure. As a final test, sit in the swing with feet planted firmly on the ground to ensure that it can hold the weight of a person. If the swing holds steady, then sit back and relax! Prior to each use of your swing, inspect the ropes, mounting hardware, and installation points for signs of wear or weakness.

WARNING

Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Avoid wearing any shoes or clothing with sharp or protruding objects that may damage or tangle the swing. It is not necessary to apply any excessive force to achieve any of the above steps. Excessive force will result in damage to the frame or the swing hammock, and is not covered by warranty. Install at your own risk. The hammock owner is solely responsible for the attachment point installation security and safety. The manufacturers are not responsible for any injuries due to the use of this product.
