## Garage Screen Installation Guide

## A. Installation with Hook Eye Strips

1. Peel off the backing of the strips



2. Attach strips to where you want to place screen. Make sure strips are applied on each end and with enough space to cover the full length of the screen.



3. Insert butterfly rods at the bottom of the screen.





4. Attach screen to strips.

## **B.** Attach with Screw Hooks

1. Mark with a pencil where you want screw hooks



2. Screw in hooks



3. Insert butterfly rods at the bottom of the screen.






4. Attach screen

## C. Optional Roll-up Accessory

- 1. Must attach screen via Screw hooks (not hook and eye method).
- 2. Strings are in four sizes Use longest string for the farthest hook
- 3. Tie strings to screw hook on all four middle holes





- 4. Lace strings down the front of the screen, under the bottom rail, up the back of the screen, and through the hook-eye hole.
- 5. Lace all four strings through the hooks, then through the end hook, and let the strings hang down.
- 6. Test the roll-up



- 7. Attach the tie off clip with screws.
- 8. Tie strings together and loop over the hook to tie-off clip.
