
STEP BY STEP

- Apply adhesive to the back of the plinth block and press firmly against the installation surface. Caulk can be used to fill in any gaps around the edges if needed.
- 2. Wipe off any excess caulk with a damp rag.
- 3. Complete installation with small finishing nails.
- 4. Fill nail holes with caulk.
- 5. Apply any necessary touch up paint.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS AND NOTES

- It is highly recommended that you paint/finish the plinth block with 100% acrylic latex paint before installation. Once installed, you can apply any necessary touchup paint/finish.
- Clean installation surface and back of plinth block of all dirt and dust with a clean dry cloth.
- Measure and mark the location where it is going to be installed.
