

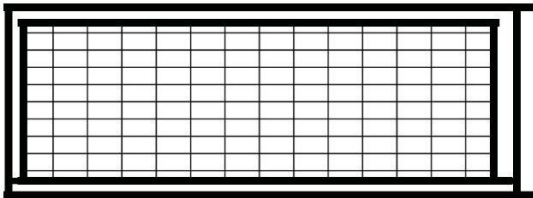

Step-by-Step Assembly Instructions

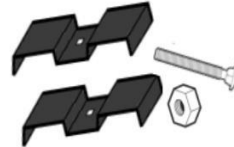

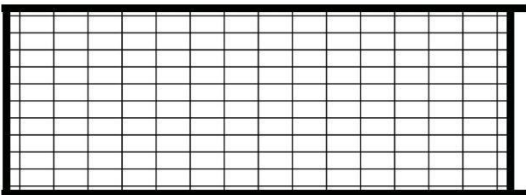
Step 1 Check parts before assembly.

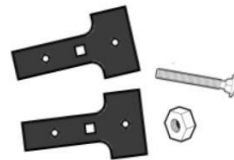

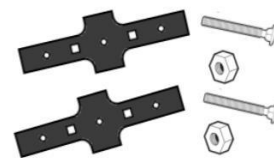

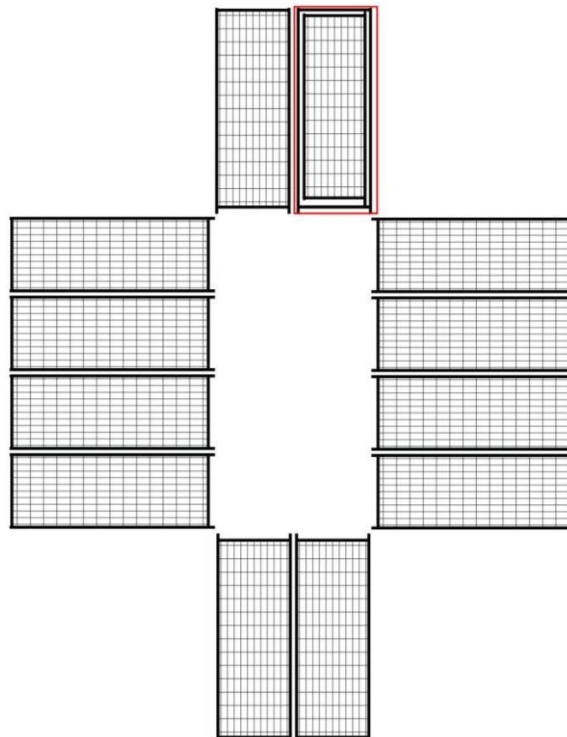
Please note: For quick and safe assembly, 1 or 2 helper would be recommended, since the kennels are too heavy.

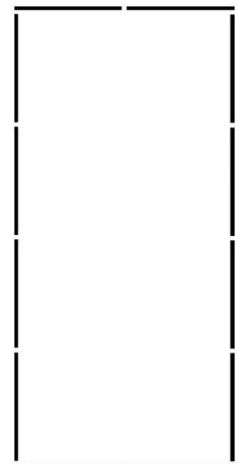
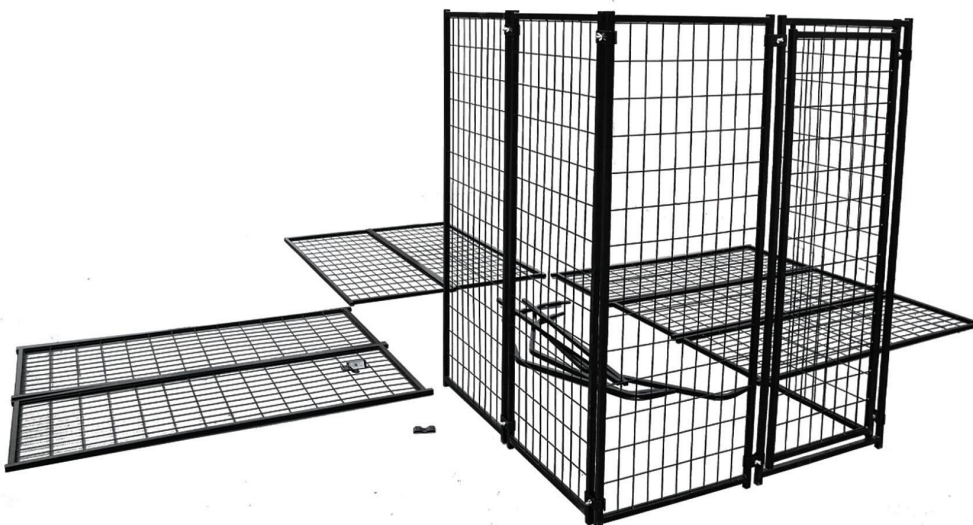
Step 2. Assemble kennel gate and kennel panel on a level surface.

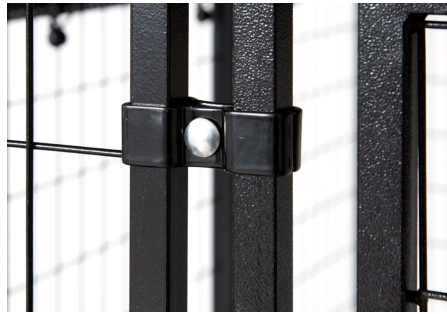
Lay out 1PC of kennel gate and 11 pcs of kennel panel. Kennel gate can be left or right.



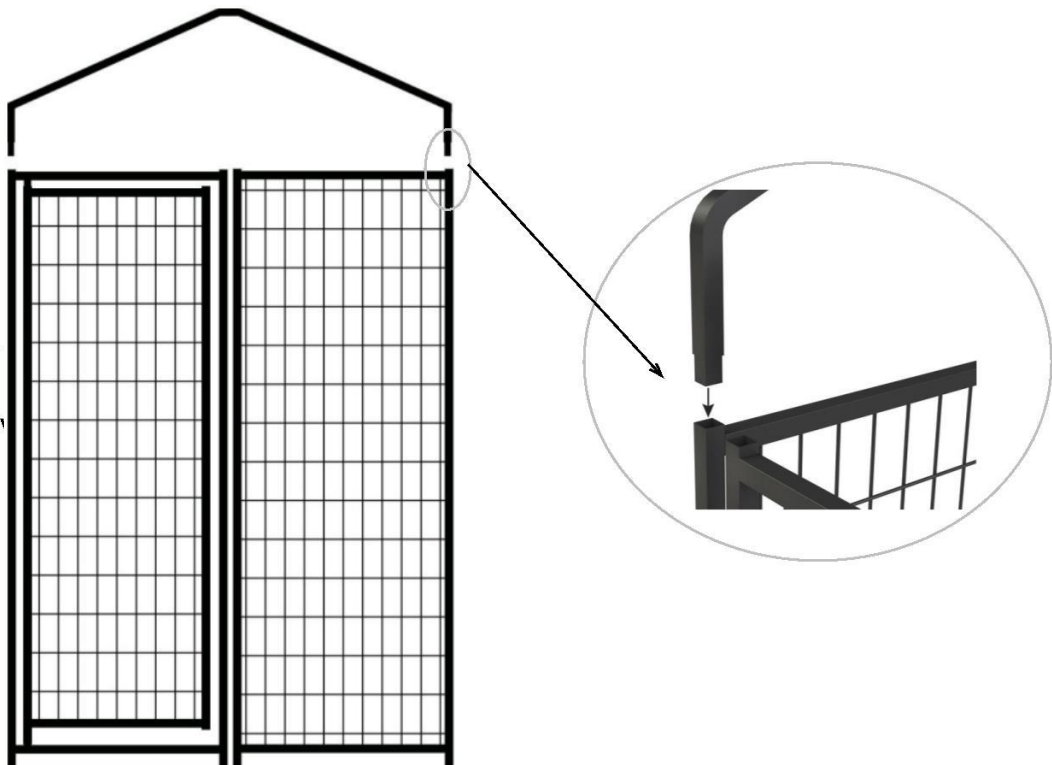
Step 3. Connect the Panels with the 24 units of Panel Clamps. Make sure the front and rear panels are placed to the outside of the side panels so that the roof truss frame will fit. Assemble the gate latch.

Vertical View

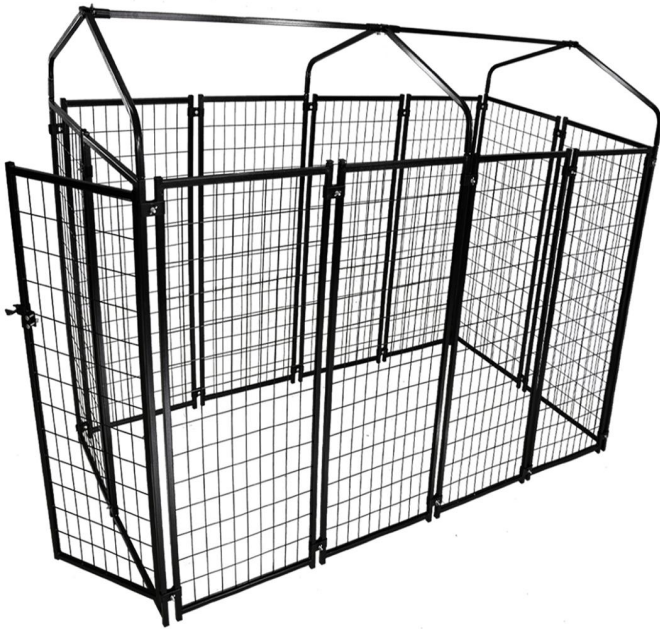
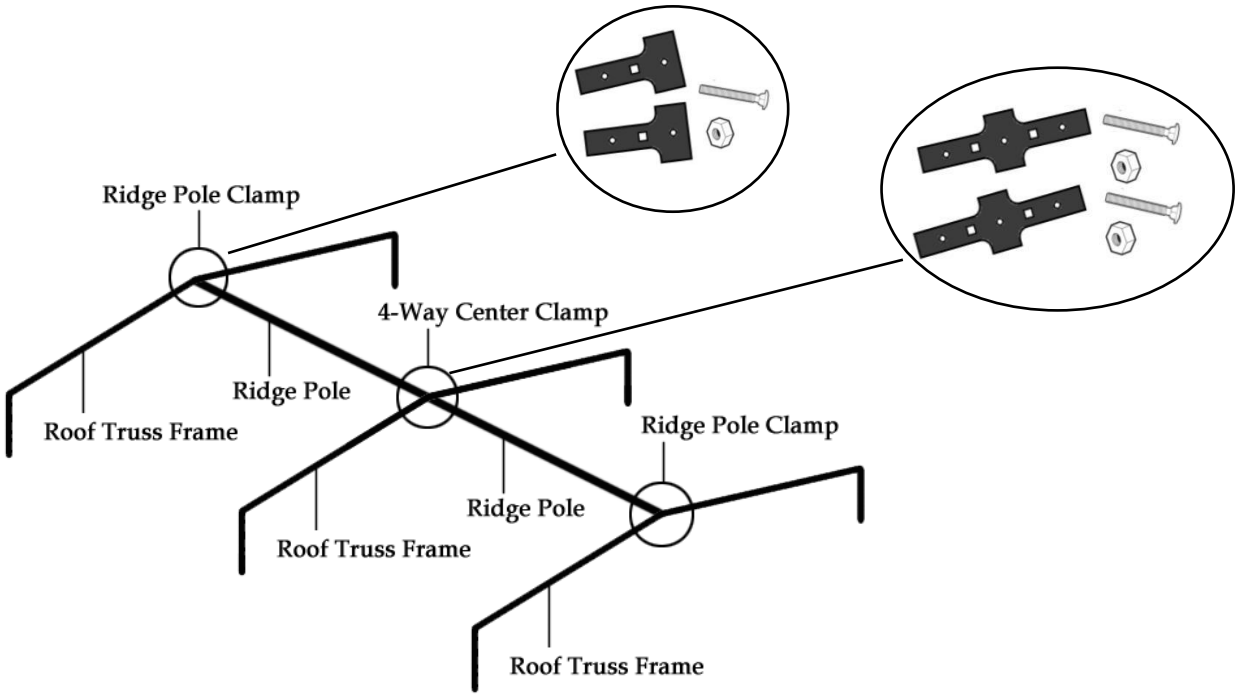




Step 4. Assemble 3 pcs of Roof Truss Frame. Insert ends of the Roof Truss Frame into the corners and the center of the Kennel.



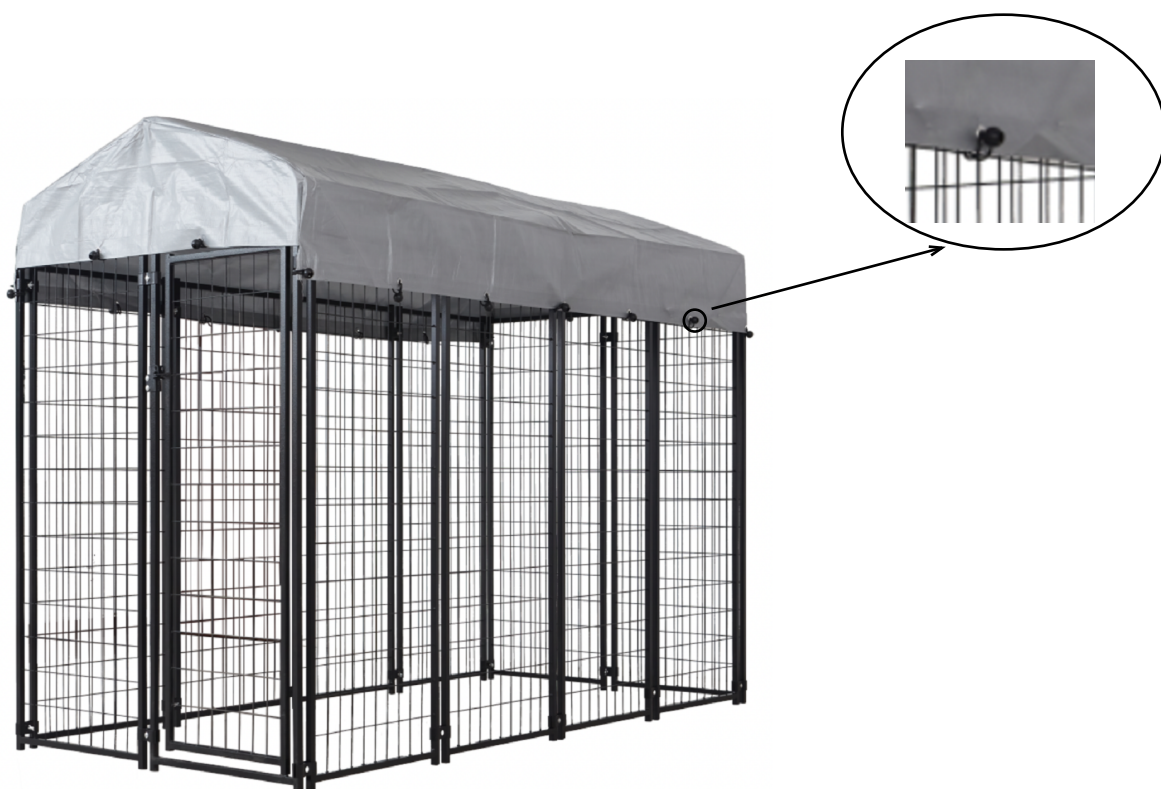
Step 5. Assemble 2 pcs of Ridge Poles, with 2 units of Ridge Poles Clamp and 1 unit of 4-Way Center Clamp.



Kennel gate and kennel panel, the top of tube, assemble 18 pcs of top end cap.



Step 6. Drape Roof Cover over the frame and evenly attach with 18 pcs of Elastic BallStrap.
