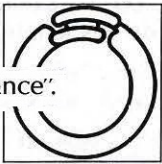


THE CURTAIN AND VALANCE

Today's best-dressed windows are wearing billowing **Curtains** and **Valances**. You have purchased a popular well-made product with the newest fashion window treatment, which is ready-to-hang for the ideal look.

Plastic split rings gather the fabric in soft folds and lock it in place. If you would like to change the height of your curtain and/or valance, the following instructions will help you re-assemble and hang your new "Curtain" and "Valance".



Split ring

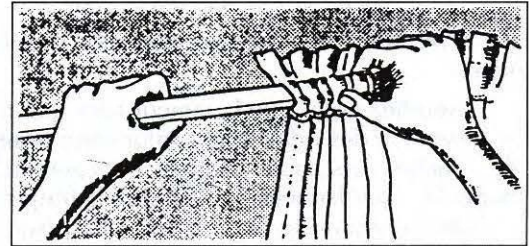
For proper fullness, you should have ordered balloon curtains and valances 1 1/2-2 times rod width; 3 times width gives extra fullness.

HOW TO HANG THE CURTAIN AND VALANCE

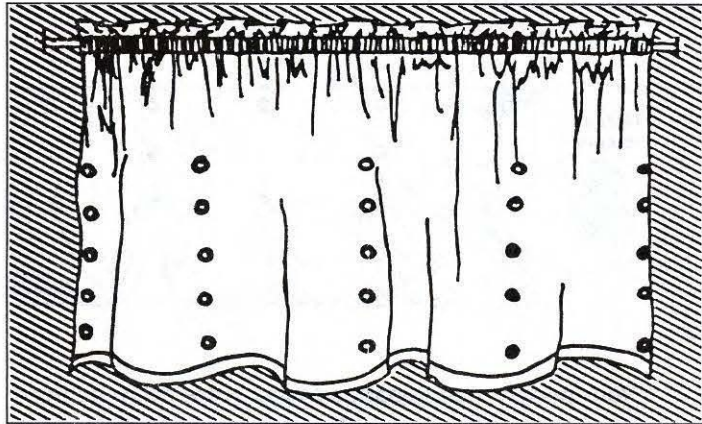
1. Gather top onto a flat curtain rod.

Rod-Pocket Headings... Vary according to Style or Curtain/Valance.

Widths quoted for rod-pocket balloon curtains and valances are measured **BEFORE** curtains and/or valances are gathered onto rod. Curtains and/or valances have **at least 1 1/2"** opening across the top through which the rod slides, creating a heading. For best results, gather evenly onto rod.



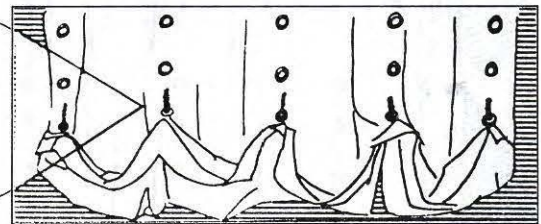
2. Rows of rings are vertically sewn to the back of curtain and valance. These rings are what will give you your desired gathered look.



4. After you have threaded the plastic split rings, your curtain and/or valance should look like the picture below (depending on style and taste). Gathering and height will vary.

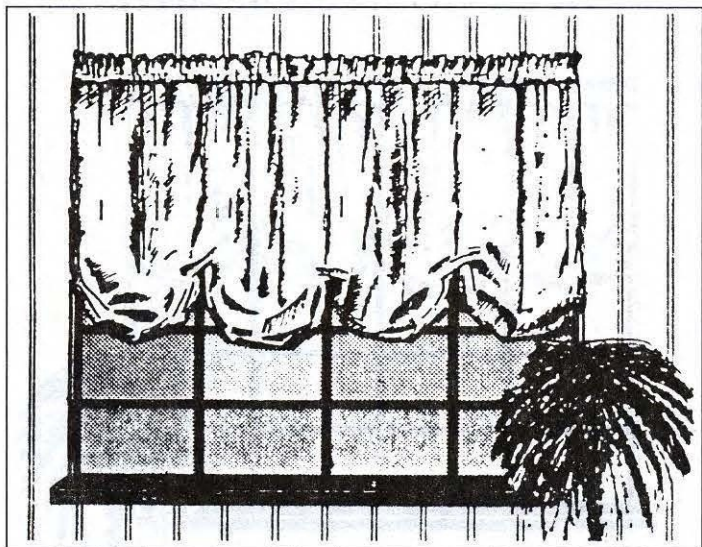
3. Let's make it

Raise curtain and/or valance to desired **fixed length**, by threading plastic split rings included through as many rings sewn on back of curtain as necessary to obtain desired length.

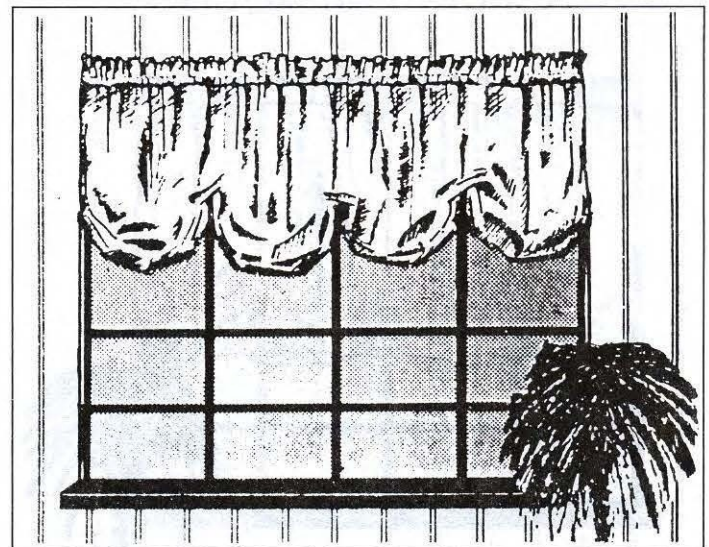
