Guidelines


- We suggest you spend a short time reading through the leaflet before you start
- When you are ready to start, make sure that you have the right tools, plenty of space and a clean, dry area for assembly.
- Unwrap all packing materials and place the components on a clean surface to protect them from damage. We recommend using the product packaging to protect your floor during assembly.
- Carefully check that you have all the parts before beginning assembly.
- Due to the size of this product, we recommend assembly in the room intended for use.
- Make sure the product is fully assembled as illustrated and that all connections are fully tightened before use.
- Wipe occasionally with a soft, damp cloth then buff dry with a soft clean dry cloth.
- The wood will mellow and change color over time. As a result, we recommend that ornaments and items placed on the surface are moved regularly for the first few months to prevent an uneven mellowing.
- Check all bolts and screws every 90 days. As necessary tighten if any are loose.
- Keep small parts and pieces away from children and pets until fully assembled.




- Do not drag or pull your furniture.
- Do not rub or scrub the surface when cleaning.
- Do not use silicone based furniture polish. Silicone in furniture polishes can break down the finish.
- Never allow any kind of liquid to remain on your furniture. Absorption can cause wood to warp or finishes to de-laminate.
- Do not place hot items (e.g. hot drinks) directly on to the wood surface. Please make sure you use a placement or coaster.
- Do not stand on the item or use as a step ladder.
- WARNING:DO NOT LET CHILDREN PLAY IN OR AROUND THE UNIT DUE TO THE POSSIBLE RISK OF INJURY.



Fixtures and fittings supplied (not to scale)




Assembly Instructions



- 1. Make sure all parts have been removed from the carton. Place them on a protected surface or carpet.
- 2. Check all parts and hardware against the "Parts List" to make sure everything is included.
- 3. Attach the Legs (2) and Legs (3) to the Top (1) as shown below. Make sure the Leg positions are correct as indicated on the stickers 2 to 2, 3 to 3. The stickers are shown on the Top (1).
- 4. Connect the Legs (2) and (3) to the Top (1) using Bolts (A) and fasten with the Allen Key (B).

Note: Do not fully tighten the Bolts until the table is fully assembled.

Approx 50% tight





2 STEP One person should hold the shelf while the other person assembles the shelf.

1. Connect the Shelf (4) to the Legs using Bolts (A) and fasten with the Allen Key (D).


Note: Do not fully tighten all the Bolts until the table is fully assembled.


3 STEP 1. Place the Top Glass (5) and Shelf Glass (6) onto the assembled unit.



Assembly Instructions



1. Place the table onto a flat level surface and level the frame. Once the table is level, tighten all the Bolts (A) using the Allen Key (B).



Periodically (every 90 days) make sure that these bolts are still fully tightened. **ATTENTION**: Be certain that all bolts are fully tightened before using table.

Limited Warranty

The product you have purchased is warranted against defects in material and workmanship while owned by the "Original Purchaser." The term "Original Purchaser" is defined as the party or entity that purchases these products from and authorized dealer or retailer as shown by the original sales receipt. The warranty does not apply to "as is" or previously owned products.

The manufacturer warrants its products to be free from defects in materials and workmanship (normal wear and tear, fading and stretching excepted), for one year from the date of purchase, except as provided below under the limited warranty.

This warranty gives you specific rights, and you may also have other rights, which vary from state to state (or country to country). All warranties are limited to the Original Purchaser for normal use by a maximum of two users. Total weight capacity per chair is 250 pounds for a single user.

The exceptions or exclusions to this warranty are:

- Upholstery material and foam cushion material is warranted against defects in material and workmanship for a period of one year, beginning on the date of purchase as shown on the original sales receipt.
- Any warranty claim that is submitted after the limited warranty period, or without proper proof of purchase will not include the cost of parts, labor, or delivery on the warranted parts within a reasonable amount of time. We reserve the right to require damaged parts to be returned to us upon request. Natural markings such as scars, brands, grain variations, wrinkles, color variations, etc. will be considered normal characteristics and not construed as defects.
