Align HB legs (#2R/L) to the headboard (#1), then secure by using bolts (#A) with washers (#B,C).



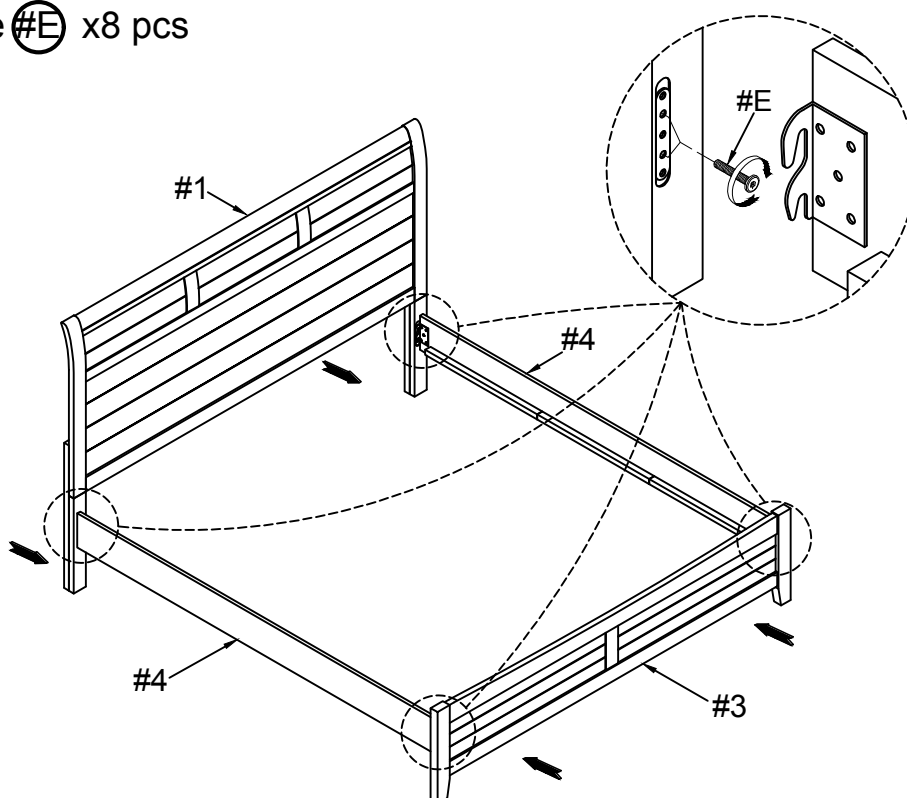

Attach bolts (#E) half way into the headboard (#1) and footboard (#3), then align side rails (#4) to the bolts (#E). Secure bolts (#E).



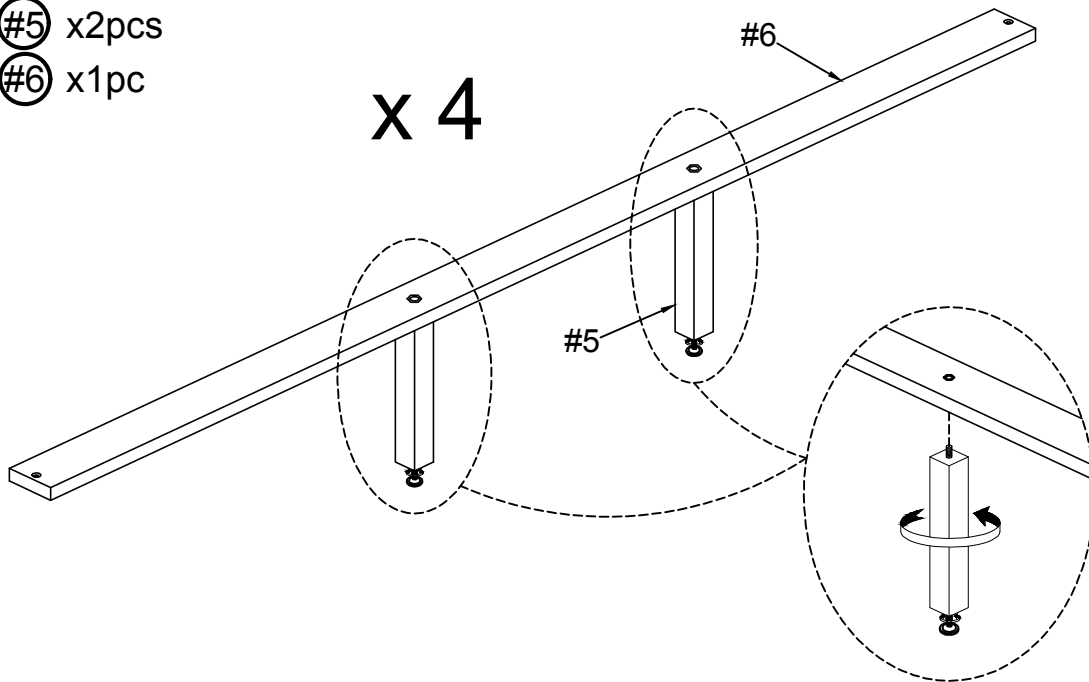

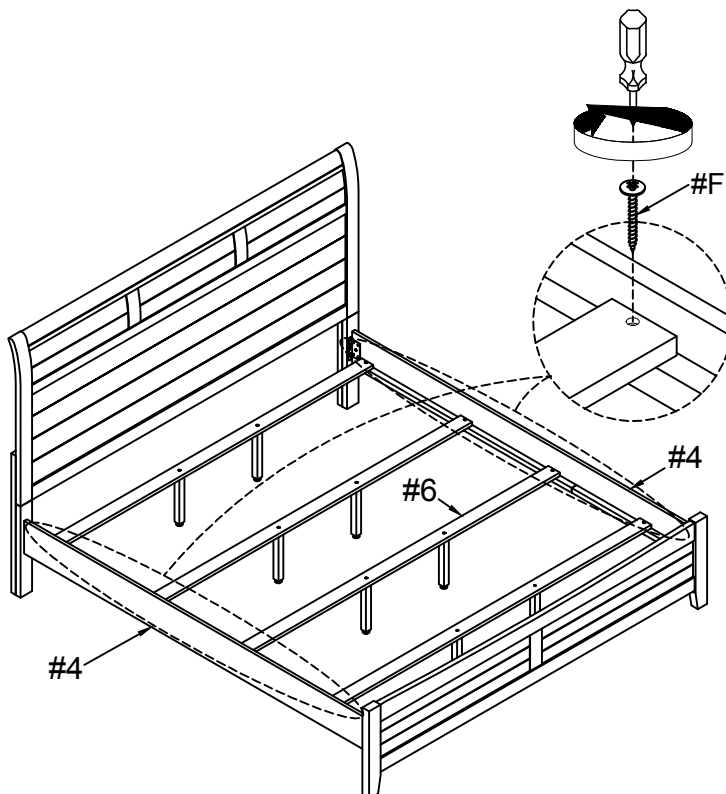
Attach support legs (#5) to the slats (#6). Adjust the leveler of the support legs (#5) according to ground level.

Align slats (#6) to the side rails (#4), then secure by using screws (#F).



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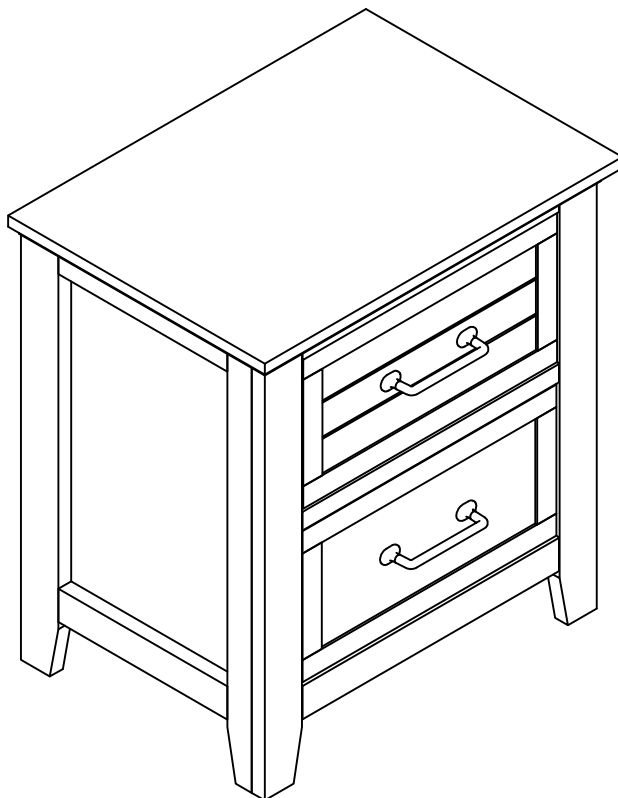

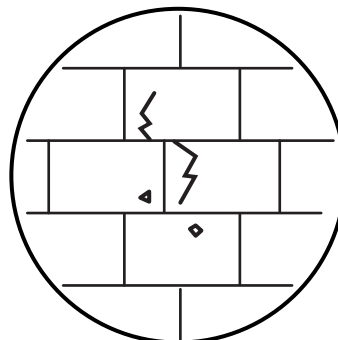
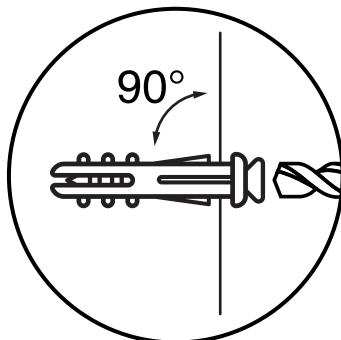
QUICK TIPS

1. If unsure of the proper size, always choose a larger screw and wall anchor.



2. Match the drill bit to the wall anchor and hole size.

3. Only drill horizontally. Do not force the drill or enlarge the hole for the wall anchor.



4. Take extra care when drilling into high walls or ceramic tiles. Wall anchors should be a tight fit for the hole. Never use wall anchors in ceilings.

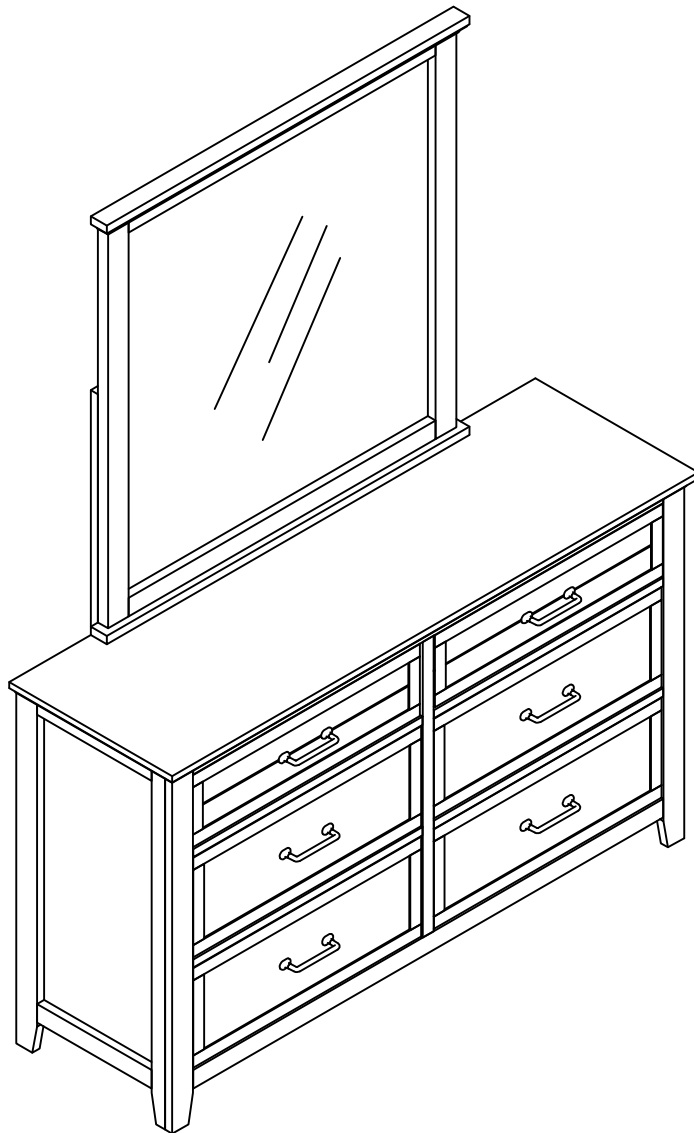


MAINTENANCE
