Hydraulic Elevating Carts

Description

Portable ergonomic elevating carts minimize worker bending and lifting. Materials can be easily loaded onto platform of cart, lowered to safe transporting height, and raised to unload at destination. Moves easily on four polyurethane caster; two swivel with brake and two rigid. All models feature a down speed control valve, internal hydraulic velocity fuse in each cylinder and an exclusive automatic two-speed manual hydraulic foot pump. All steel construction. Powder coated red finish. Failure to follow the proper operating instructions could result in injury.



Unpacking

After receiving a hydraulic elevating cart, visually inspect the frame components and hydraulic unit for damage. If damage is evident, notify delivering carrier immediately and file necessary claims.

Specifications and Dimensions

General Safety Information

- 1. Not a personnel lift. Keep clear when operating.
- 2. Never go under platform if there is weight on the unit.
- 3. Remove weight before working on unit.
- 4. Use only maintenance parts supplied or approved by the manufacturer.
- 5. Do not change pressure relief valve setting.
- 6. Do not clamp cylinder in a vise as you may distort barrel.
- 7. Never operate lift unless you are watching it.
- 8. Load lift as uniformly as possible.
- 9. Consult factory for uneven loading.
- 10. Do not continue to pump if unit is not raising.
- Relieve system pressure by slowly operating pressure release mechanism.
- 12. Consult factory if any modifications are going to be made.
- 13. Do not use brake fluids or jack oils. Use AW-32 or hydraulic oils.

Hydraulic Elevating Carts

Slide the foot pedal in the pedal bracket located below the frame of the cart on the same end as the handle. Align the bolt hole on the left side and install the bolt and lock washer. At this time tighten the bolt. Lift the handle to the upright position assuring that it latches into position with the handle latch bar located just above the foot pedal. At this time your cart is ready for use.

(CART-750, CART-800-D, CART-1000)

TOOLS REQUIRED: Adjustable wrench, 19mm box end wrench or ratchet and socket, adjustable wrench, and metric allen wrench set

After unpacking cart, locate foot pedal, handle, and bolts. Align holes in bottom of handle with handle mounting brackets and install 19 mm bolts in handle. It is important not to kink the cable on the left side as that will cause the release mechanism to fail. Tighten the two handle bolts using 19 mm wrench. At this time located the foot pedal. This will install on the same end of the cart as the handle. Just below the frame you will find a bracket for this to slip into. Line up the bolt hole, install the bolt and tighten it. At this time your cart is ready to use.

ADJUSTMENTS FOR BRAKE LEVER STYLE RELEASE: From time to time small adjustments may be necessary to keep your cart performing at its best. To adjust the lowering cable there are two places to perform this adjustment. The first step is to raise the cart top to access the cylinder. Then if a small adjustment is needed, located the bottom of the hydraulic cylinder, and locate the release lever. In the center of this lever there is an adjustment screw and a lock nut. Insert the correct size allen wrench

into screw head and with wrench loosen the jam nut. At this time turn the screw clockwise until the unit starts to lower, then back the screw off 1/2 turn and retighten the lock nut. If a major adjustment is needed then you will need to located the cable retention assembly. This is on the release lever. Once nut is loose the lever should drop down a little bit. You will need to raise the lever to a point just before the cart starts to lower, pull the cable downward to tighten it and tighten the jam nut. After a coarse adjustment a fine tuning adjustment may be necessary.

(CART-1000-LD)

TOOLS REQUIRED: Adjustable wrench, 19mm box end wrench, small regular screwdriver

After unpacking cart, locate handle and foot lever. To install the handle on the cart place the handle on the mounting brackets with the release knob and linkage on the right side. Install bolts in bottom of handle and tighten them. Locate foot pedal and install it in the pedal bracket on the same end of the cart. Line up bolt holes, install and tighten foot pedal bolt. Raise platform by pumping foot pedal. This will allow you to access the linkage you need to hook up the lowering knob. Locate linkage coming from pump. This should be protruding from the back of the frame. Locate the spring tension holes just under the lowering knob and install one end of the spring in this hole. The other end of the spring will go into a hole in the bottom of the releasee knob. On the lower end of the first linkage there will be a dimple in the shaft. This if for the set screw in the swivel joint to lock into. Turn the lowering knob counterclockwise to put tension on the

spring, until the dimple lines up with the set screw in the swivel joint. At this time tighten the set screw. Now you should be able to lower the deck by turning the lowering know to the left. Your cart is ready to use at this time.

(CART-1500-D)

TOOLS REQUIRED: Adjustable wrench, 19mm box end wrench or ratchet and socket

After unpacking cart, locate the handle and foot lever. To install the handle, line up bolt holes in handle with bolt holes in handle brackets on frame of cart, and install the bolts. At this time tighten bolts. Now install the foot lever in the bracket just below the frame on the handle end of the cart, line up the bolt holes and install and tighten the bolt. At this time the cart is ready for use.

(CART-2000)

TOOLS REQUIRED: (2) 9/16 in box end wrenches

After unpacking the cart locate the handle and the hardware to install it. Line up the mounting holes on the handle with the holes in the frame and install and tighten the bolts. Your cart is now ready for use.

Operation

The load capacity rating as inscribed on the nameplate of your unit designates the net capacity, assuming the load is centered. This capacity must never be exceeded, as permanent damage or injury may result.

Stay clear of moving parts. The platform will rise as long as the foot control is pumped. Operating the lowering mechanism will lower the table.

In the event the table is overloaded, the relief valve will open because of

excessive pressure build up, and oil will bypass into the reservoir.

- 1. Always load the unit uniformly.
- Never use the lift if it is in need of repairs or in the case of a malfunction.
- 3. Notify your maintenance personnel or supervisor in case you notice anything out of the ordinary, such as binding, odd noises, etc.
- 4. Operate lowering mechanism slowly.

Foot Pump Operation (CART-2000 only) Figure 3

Your new lift equipment has been supplied with our exclusive 2-speed foot pump. The initial features of your pump includes a primary pressure relief, pressure compensated return flow control valve, and an integrated lowering valve. Replaceable bushings, valve components, and seals have been utilized in the construction of the pump in the event that replacements are necessary.

Stay clear of moving parts. The platform will rise as the foot pedal is pumped. Depressing the lowering valve will lower the table at a controlled rate of descent.

In the event the platform has been overloaded, the pressure relief will open because of excessive pressure buildup in the hydraulic system. Oil will bypass into the reservoir. NEVER change the pressure relief setting. DO NOT exceed the rated capacity of your lift equipment.

SPEED SELECTION FOR TWO-SPEED PUMPS

This pump offers two "speeds". The low speed setting produces low volume/high pressure. The high speed setting produces high volume/low pressure. The operator has the option of selecting the optimum pump speed for the application at hand. Pump speeds are selected by sliding the "lock collar" (See below) in or out. An occasional drop of oil will keep the collar working freely.

AIR BLEED PROCEDURE

Whether your pump is a new installation, or has been recently serviced, air has likely entered the hydraulic system. The design of this pump includes an "air bleed screw" which will aid in the removal of unwanted air from the foot pump area of hydraulic system. Use the following steps to remove this air from the system.

- 1. Check all fittings to be sure they are tight. Ensure that the oil is filled to within 1" of the top of the reservoir when the lift is in the fully lowered position.
- Locate the "air bleed screw" (see figure 3) and loosen approximately 1/2 turn counterclockwise. As soon as you have loosened the screw, slowly depress the foot pedal. This will force the air out of the pump chamber. Before you let the pump

pedal return to the "up" or "home" position, tighten the air bleed screw. This will prevent air from reentering the pump chamber. Repeat the above procedure until the pump chamber is completely filled with oil and a "spongy" feel is no longer present. If the air bleeding procedure has been successful, the feel the of the pump pedal will be firm and the complete stroke of the pump will produce fluid flow.

Maintenance

All bushings and bearings are of the pre-lubricated type and will last for a long period of time without additional lubrication. To increase bearing life, it is recommended that a few drops of light machine oil be applied at each pivot point every 6 to 12 months.

DAILY

Visually check and do not use if any of the following are visible:

- 1. Oil Leaks.
- 2. Structural deformation of legs or frame.
- 3. Unusual noise or binding
- 4. Check casters for proper operation.

MONTHLY

- 1. Check for oil leaks.
- 2. Check clevis and pivot points for wear.
- 3. Check rollers for looseness and wear.
- 4. Check for unusual noise.
- 5. Make sure all warning labels are in place and in good condition.

6. Clean off dirt and debris.

YEARLY

Hydraulic oil should be changed at least once a year, or sooner if the oil darkens or becomes gritty. Flush reservoir before refilling. Presence of water is indicated if the oil turns milky. Recommended oil: AW-32 hydraulic fluid or equal.

All maintenance work must be preformed by qualified personnel with training in the repair of electrical and hydraulic components.

NOTE: If hydraulic oil is milky white in color, water is in the hydraulic system. Change the hydraulic oil immediately.

TO FILL UNIT WITH OIL

- 1. Raise the platform and block the leg assembly in the fully raised position.
- 2. Remove the upper cylinder pin.

- 3. Loosen the set screw in the lowering rod linkage.
- 4. Release the lowering valve.
- 5. Collapse the cylinder rod back inside the cylinder.
- 6. Remove the oil fill plug.
- With the cylinder horizontal, fill with AW-32 grade hydraulic oil (or equivalent).
- 8. Reinstall the fill plug, and then reinstall the cylinder.

TO BLEED SYSTEM

- 1. Ensure platform is in lowered position.
- 2. Operate the lowering mechanism and pump the foot control several times slowly.

TO FILL WITH OIL LOW OIL CONDITION

- 1. Raise the unit as far as it will go.
- Remove the oil fill plug.
- 3. Add oil 1 oz. at a time.
- 4. Pump the foot control.
- Repeat steps 3 and 4 until the unit's maximum height is achieved.
- 6. Once the maximum height is reached, add 1 oz. of oil and reinstall the fill plug.

IF CART LEAKS DOWN

- Completely lower the platform. By hand, grasp the deck at the hinge end of the leg assembly. Raise the deck as high as possible, then carefully, while standing aside, allow the assembly to drop. This procedure draws oil through the load holding check valve and "washes" debris (if present) from the ball and seat of the device. It may be necessary to repeat this procedure a couple of times to remove all debris from the check valve thus, eliminating table drift.
- 2. Check the oil level in the pump assembly. The oil should be level with the bottom of the hole with the scissor legs in the lowered position. (Deck tilts up).

NOTE: If these steps fail to return the unit to service, contact supplier for further instructions.
