
# **TABLE**

### **ASSEMBLY GUIDE**



#### Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly





#### SAFETY AND CARE ADVICE

- Check you have all the components and tools listed.
- Remove all fttings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- We do not recommend the use of power drills/drivers for inserting screws, as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers and Allen keys.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could cause choking if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Do not overtighten the nuts to avoid causing damage to the threads.

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre







**NOTE:** The quantities above are the correct amount to complete the assembly. In some cases more fittings may be supplied than are required.

### STEP 1

Place the table top [1] face down onto a soft, clear surface.

ATTENTION: Be careful to always insert the threaded rods into the table stopper-end first & don't screw past the stopper





### STEP 2

Place the table top [1] face down onto a soft, clear surface.

Place the pillar [2] over the rods as shown and secure each fixing using a washer (B) and nut (C). Fully tighten the fixings using box spanner (D).

## STEP 3

ATTENTION: With the help of another person, carefully turn the table over to complete assembly. Your table is now ready to use.
