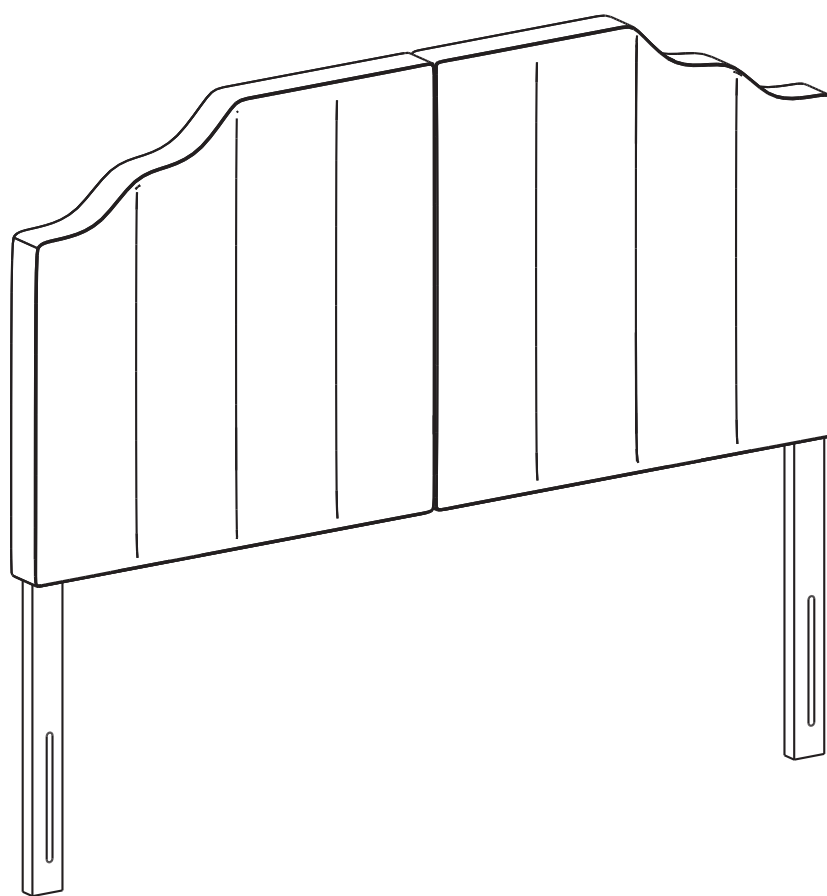


# Assembly Instructions

E-mail us to submit your warranty claim. Please keep your receipt so that we may process your warranty request.

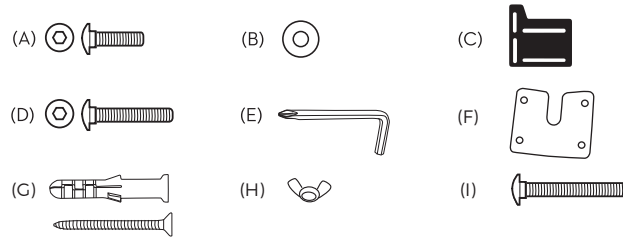
## **HOW STATE LAW APPLIES**

# HEADBOARD ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

## PARTS LIST:

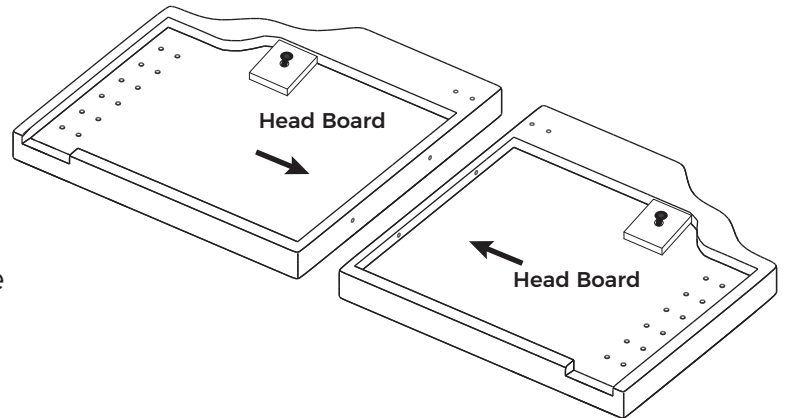
- (A) M6x35 bolts x8
- (B) Washers x2
- (C) Adapter x1
- (D) M8x55 bolts x2
- (E) Hex key x1
- (F) Pendant x2
- (G) Expansion screws x8
- (H) Butterfly screw cap x4
- (I) M6x60 bolts x2



## STEP 1

Remove the headboard from the box and Lay the two headboards face down flat on the ground. Remove both legs and hardware from the straps on the back

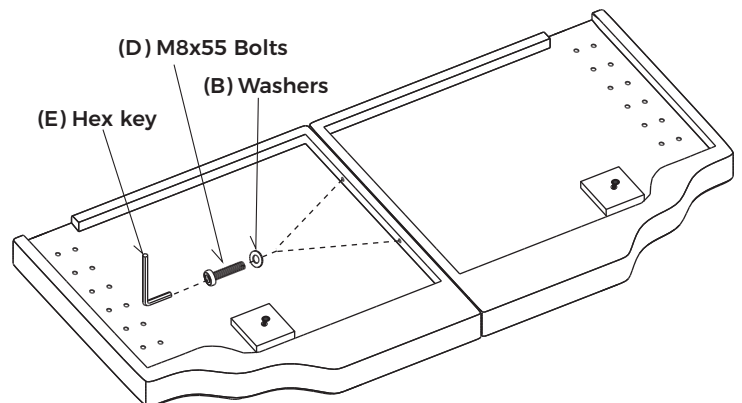

## STEP 2

Align the two headboards, use (C) metal connector, 4 (A) short bolts, 4 (B) washers to secure the upper end; And then fix the middle wood strip with 4(D) M6x35 bolts and 4 (B) washers. (see Figure 1 and 2)

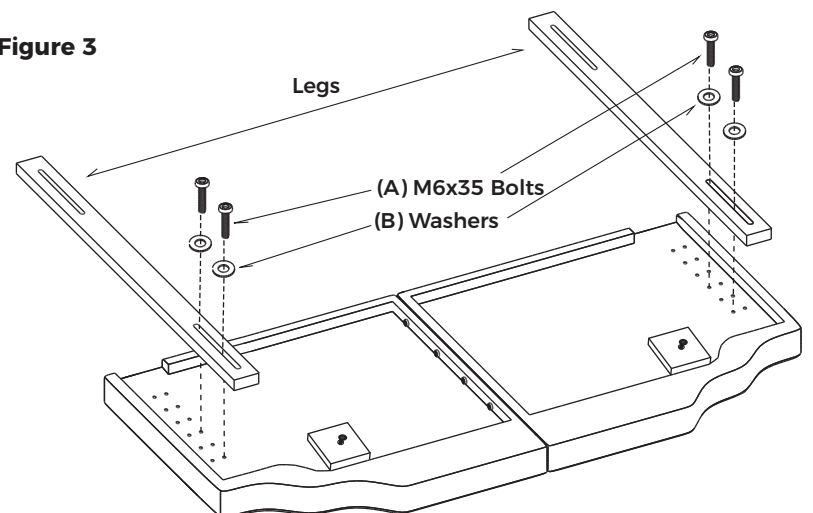

## STEP 3

Use two (D) M6x35 bolts, two (B) washers and, depending on the holes provided, attach each leg to the headboard using (E) Hex key at your desired height (see Figure 3)

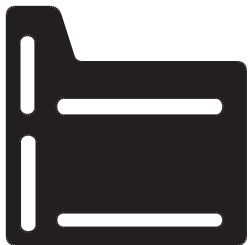
# ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

### STEP 1

Place assembled bed frame in front of head-board and position Adapter to determine which slots will line up with bed frame and headboard. Use provided lock nuts, small washers, and M6X35 bolts to attach Adapter to bed frame as shown in figure

### STEP 2

Use provided lock nuts, small washers and M6X80 bolts to attach headboard to bed frame Adapter

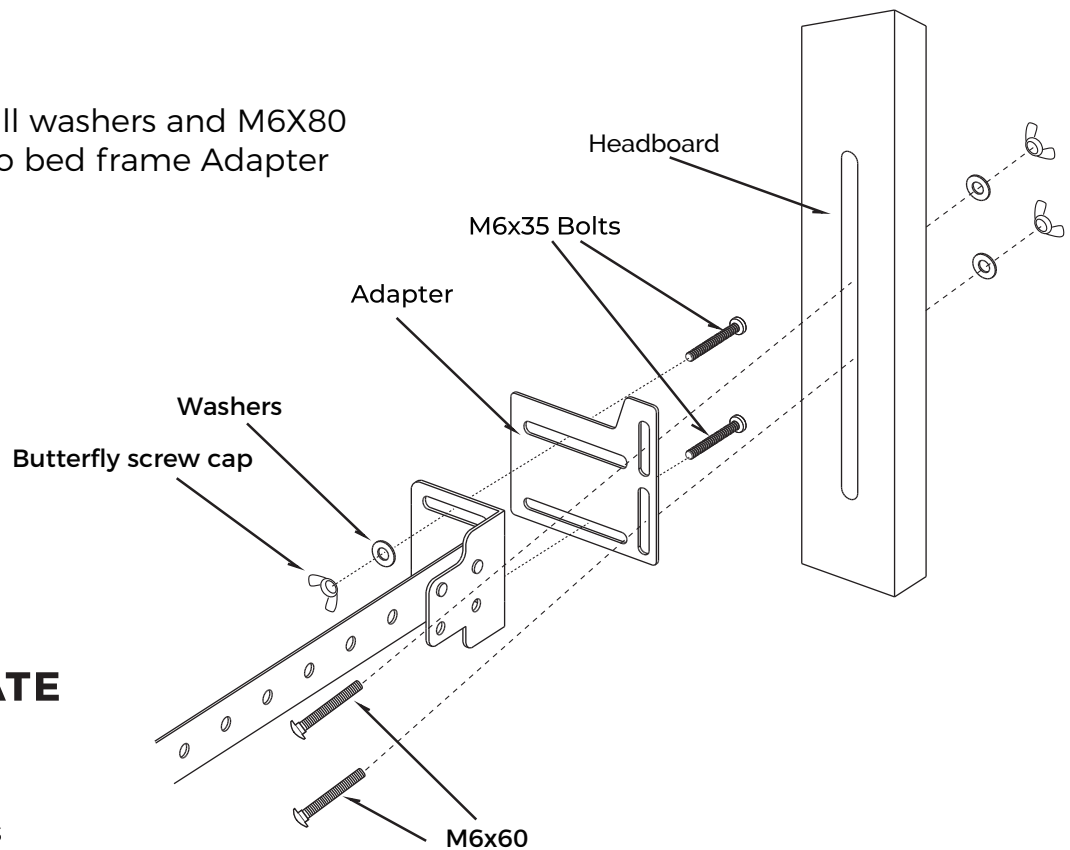

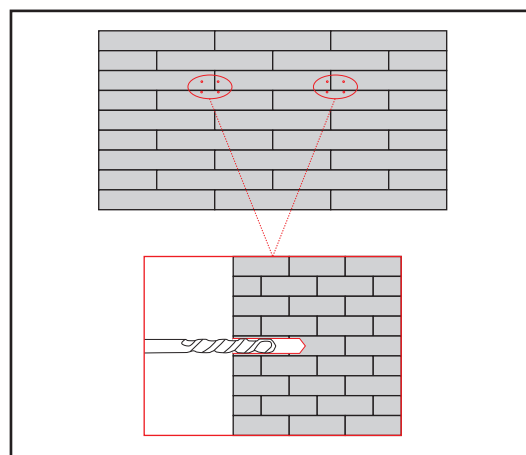

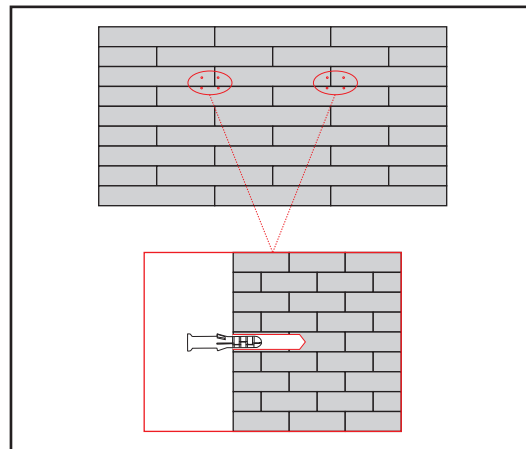
### STEP 1

Electric drill drilling.



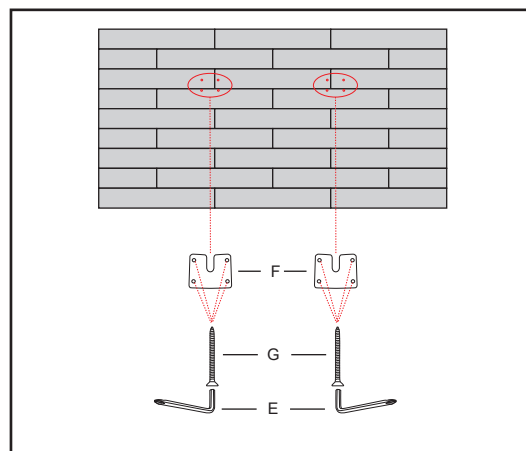
### STEP 2

Knock the Expansion screws plastic into the hold.



### STEP 3

Connect the pendent F with expansion screws G.

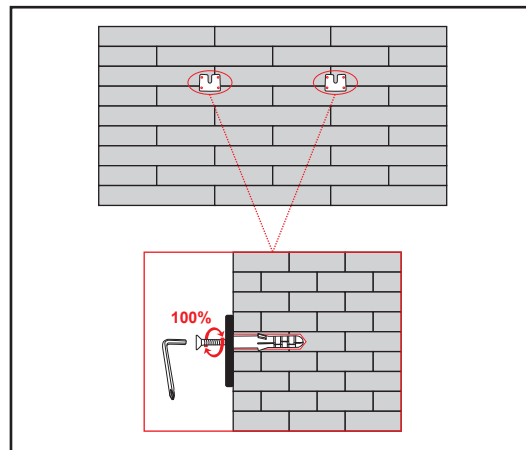

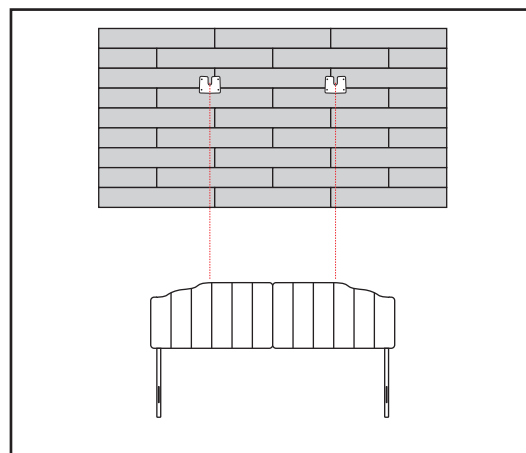
### STEP 4

Ensure that the screws are 100% tightened.



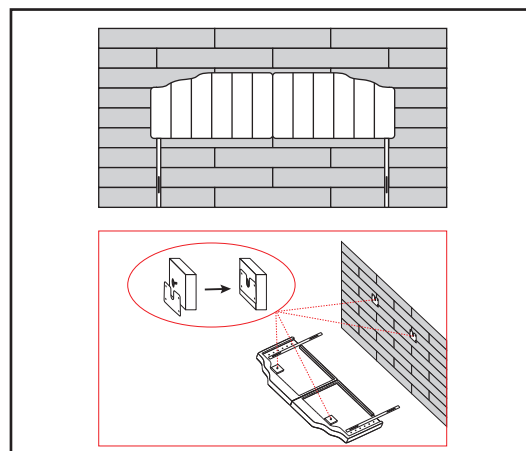
### STEP 5
