

# FEATHER MAGNETIC CURTAIN TIEBACK

## Installation Guide

---

### What's Included

#### In Your Package:

- 1 or 2 × Feather magnetic tiebacks (depending on selected quantity)
- Elegant feather design elements (6.8" long, 2" wide)
- Strong magnetic closure system
- Available in your selected color: White, Gray, or Black

#### Your Color Selection:

Your feather tieback(s) come in the sophisticated color you selected. Each color features the same premium construction and powerful magnetic system.


- **White:** Clean, minimalist elegance - perfect for light and airy spaces
- **Gray:** Modern, sophisticated tone - complements contemporary decor
- **Black:** Bold, dramatic statement - ideal for high-contrast and elegant designs

#### Tools Needed:

- None required - no drilling or hardware installation needed!
- Clean, dry cloth (for initial cleaning if desired)

#### ⚠ Important Safety Information

- Keep away from children under 3 years - contains strong magnets

- Do not use near pacemakers or electronic devices sensitive to magnets
  - Avoid pinching fingers when magnets snap together
  - Check curtain weight capacity before use

# Step-by-Step Installation

## 1 Prepare Your Curtains

Ensure your curtains are clean and properly hung. The feather tieback works best with light to medium weight curtains that complement elegant decor.

*Tip: If curtains are new, let them hang for 24 hours to settle before installing tiebacks.*

## 2 Determine Tieback Position

Choose where you want the tieback positioned on your curtain:

- **High position:** 1/3 from the top - elegant, sophisticated drape
- **Middle position:** Center of curtain - balanced, classic look
- **Low position:** 2/3 down - relaxed, casual elegance

## 3 Gather the Curtain Fabric

Pull your curtain to one side and gather the fabric at your chosen position. The gathered fabric should be no more than 2 inches thick for optimal magnetic connection.

**Elegant Advantage:** The feather design adds organic beauty while the strong magnets ensure secure hold.

## 4 Position the Front Feather

Place one feather element on the front-facing side of your gathered curtain where you want it to be visible. The organic feather shape becomes an elegant design accent.

Consider the angle - the feather can be positioned to follow the natural drape of the curtain.

## 5 Bring Around the Back

Carefully bring the second feather element around the back of the gathered curtain fabric. The compact 6.8" length is perfect for most curtain gatherings.

## 6 Connect the Magnets

Bring the magnetic feather elements together behind the curtain. You'll feel the strong magnetic pull as they approach each other - let them snap together securely.

**Caution:** Keep fingers clear when magnets snap together to avoid pinching.

## 7 Adjust and Perfect

Adjust the curtain draping and the position of the front feather until you achieve the perfect elegant look. The tieback should hold securely while allowing natural curtain movement.

Ensure the feather element is positioned for maximum visual appeal and follows the curtain's natural lines.

### Pro Installation Tips

- For optimal hold, ensure curtain gathering is under 2 inches thick
- With a set of 2, install tiebacks at the same height for perfect symmetry
- For wide windows with multiple panels, use one tieback per panel
- The feather can be angled to complement your curtain's natural drape
- Consider the feather as part of your room's organic design elements
- The compact 6.8" length is perfect for lighter, more delicate curtains

## Daily Use Instructions

### Opening Curtains

Simply pull the curtain toward the tieback. The magnetic connection will hold the gathered fabric securely in place with elegant style.

### Closing Curtains

Gently separate the magnetic connection and allow the curtain to fall naturally back into position. The feathers will reconnect easily when needed.

## Maintenance & Care

### Regular Care:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe feather elements with a soft, damp cloth as needed
- **Magnetic Care:** Keep magnets free from metal debris and dust
- **Storage:** When not in use, keep magnets connected to maintain strength
- **Inspection:** Check for any chips or damage to the decorative surface
- **Color Care:** Clean gently to preserve the color finish
